- Winter maintenance to prevent falls
- Keep scooters out from cycle tracks
- Safe and easy operability of ATM machines

Professionals:

• Well-illuminated streets and pavements without obstacles

2. Transportation

The Haque senior citizens:

- Good maintenance of cycle tracks and pavements
- Wider cycle tracks
- Sufficient bicycle parking spaces in the city centre
- Public Transport (OV): senior-friendly staff, high frequency of public transport in the evening, accessibility of stops and vehicles, stops close to home, free public transport for people over 65, 70 or 75+
- Local bus: shorter waiting time and a areater distance
