Evaluation Report of the 1st Age-Friendly City Action Plan of Dong-gu District, Gwangju Metropolitan City (2017–2019)

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Overview of the Evaluation of the 1st Action Plan

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In 2017, Dong-gu established a three-year action plan by diagnosing the age-friendly degree of Dong-gu, FGI for senior citizens, and deriving issues and strategic tasks. Dong-gu submitted applications for membership to WHO and joined the WHO International Network(GNAFCC). Afterwards, the first three-year action plan was implemented from 2017 to 2011 to build the infrastructure as a age-friendly city. In response, a self-evaluation report is prepared for the first three years of the action plan.
