Japan is the most ageing country in the world, and Hakone Town is not an exception to this trend. As of May 31, 2017, the town's population ratio of people aged 65 and over is 35.7% (and 43.21% of over 60). In 2020 the ratio of over 65 is estimated to exceed 37%.

To cope with this trend, Hakone Town has implemented various projects collaborating with local communities so that older people can age in place, can live a long and healthy life in their town.

We are also establishing a community-based integrated care system which provides the elderly with medical and nursing care, prevention, housing and living support in an integrated manner when they become in need of support.

In order to accelerate our efforts and raise international awareness of Hakone Town's advanced programs, I agree with WHO values and approach to creating age-friendly cities and communities, and also I assure that Hakone Town, which has sectors implementing welfare programs and services for the elderly, will commit to an approach consistent with the WHO four steps to create age-friendly environments and participating in the global network of Age-friendly Cities and Communities.

I also commit myself to making Hakone Town more age-friendly, by realizing a society where the older people can enjoy healthy, safe and active lives and receive appropriate support in an environment fit for their individual status and needs.
