Strategy or action plan to make our community more age-friendly

To conduct a baseline assessment of the age-friendliness of the district:

In 2017, a pilot baseline assessment of age-friendliness was conducted through the collaborated service learning project with HK PolyU to identify suitable indicators and methods in the measurement of age-friendliness in the local context that also allows for benchmarking with other regions/ cities. Through the collaborative service learning project with HK PolyU, baseline assessments of AFC will be conducted year by year. AFC ambassadors will be invited to participate in the elderly committee for sharing the views and recommendations in Yau Tsim District Council and/or working group meetings, which involves local governmental departments, professional and/or local leaders so as to recognize the voice of the elderly.

Action plans will be formulated in the second half of 2017, which are based on the findings of “Building Age-Friendly Community in Yau Tsim Mong”, which is supported by Yau Tsim Mong District Council and launched by the working group of AFC.
