Nonsan City joined the WHO Aged-Friendly City Network in 2018 and promoted the three-year Aged-Friendly City Project from 2018 to 2020. A five-year plan from 2021 to 2025 was established and implemented by the City as part of the second WHO Age-Friendly City Promotion Plan. Regular evaluation and planning stages are being conducted in Nonsan City. In the 1st and 2nd Nonsan City Aged Friendly City Projects, Nonsan City promoted the Aged Friendly City Strategy with results through the creation of an Aged Friendly City in Nonsan City, continuity of projects for the elderly, and effective policy management.



The objective of Nonsan City's plan for a city that is age-friendly is to create a city where residents can live a life of vibrant old age. First, the goal of implementing an elderly-friendly city in Nonsan City is to keep a people-friendly environment. Second, it is a city where individuals are able to safeguard their identities and live in a secure environment. Third, in this city, anyone can be involved in society and play an active role. The implementation strategy is to strengthen self-sustainability by expanding services that are elderly-friendly in the first stage. It is to establish an environment that is elderly-friendly in the second stage. The third stage is to complete a city network that is elderly-friendly, where all citizens work together. Our objective is to create a secure city where the elderly can live with confidence, a lively city where the elderly are active, and a warm city where the elderly are respected and healthy.

Nonsan City is a member of the WHO Aged-Friendly City Network and plans to continue to actively promote the strategy of promoting an aged-friendly city based on the WHO Aged-Friendly City Guidelines in the 3rd Aged-Friendly City Project.
