

# 1. A Summary of 2023 Nowon-gu Senior Survey

## 1) Overview of the Survey

- Subject : 802 people aged 65 or older living in Nowon-gu in 2023
- Methodology : Face to Face Interview with constructed survey form
- Sampling : Allocation according to the proportion of resident registration population
  - Seniors in Nowon-gu : 3way group(Local/Sex/Age)
- Period: 2023. 1. 11 ~ 2. 3.
- Analysis : Descriptive Statistics, Interferential Statistics  
(used stata 13.0, SPSS 21.0 programs )
- Investigation Items

〈Table 1〉 Investigations Items for Nowon Senior Survey for Cycle 2 of Nowon-gu Age-Friendly City

Part	Items
I. Subject Information (8)	Area, Age, Sex, Marriage, Education, Religion, Benefits, Family Members, Living Expenses per Month
II. Health and Care (23)	Health awareness, health-related institutions, necessary public support medical services, health-related information acquisition routes, desired residence according to health status, home-care services, long-term care insurance, disability-related, loneliness and alienation, etc.
III. Employment, Economic environment (21)	Job status, type, satisfaction, willingness to work in the future, experience in participating in public-type jobs, employment status and difficulties after the age of 65, economic difficulties, living expenses, retirement preparation, etc.
IV. Living Environment (15)	Residential conditions, type of residence, Residence-related importance, Regarding housing for the elderly, the number of times in outside, inconveniences outside, public transport, safe of the living environment, driving, fall experiences, etc.
V. Entertainment and Civic Participation (11)	Daily routine (based on 24 hours) types of leisure activities on weekdays and weekends, Place, Frequency, Companion, The time, Average monthly cost, Satisfaction, Restrictions on leisure activities, Awareness of facilities for providing leisure services by Nowon-gu, Intention to use or participate in leisure service facilities, reason for not using, interpersonal satisfaction, degree of dependence, etc.
VI. Information (13)	Information needs, A method for approaching to information, Possession and utilization of electronic devices, Difficulties in life due to the development of information devices, Solutions for difficulties in obtaining information, Internet usage, Participation in informatization education, satisfaction, reason for absence, etc.
VII. Awareness of life in old and policy demand (10)	Aged Recognition, difficulty or problem, Required service areas, priority on expanding welfare services, important areas in creating an Age-friendly City, necessary services, Lifelong Education Program, Residential Satisfaction, etc.

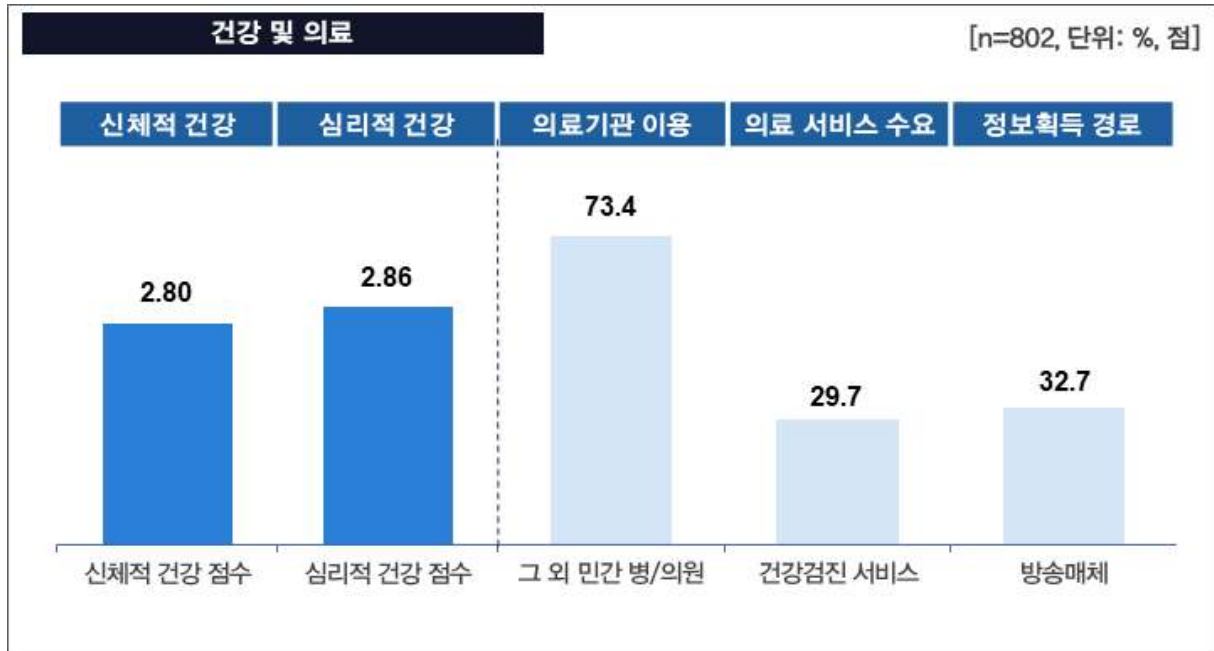

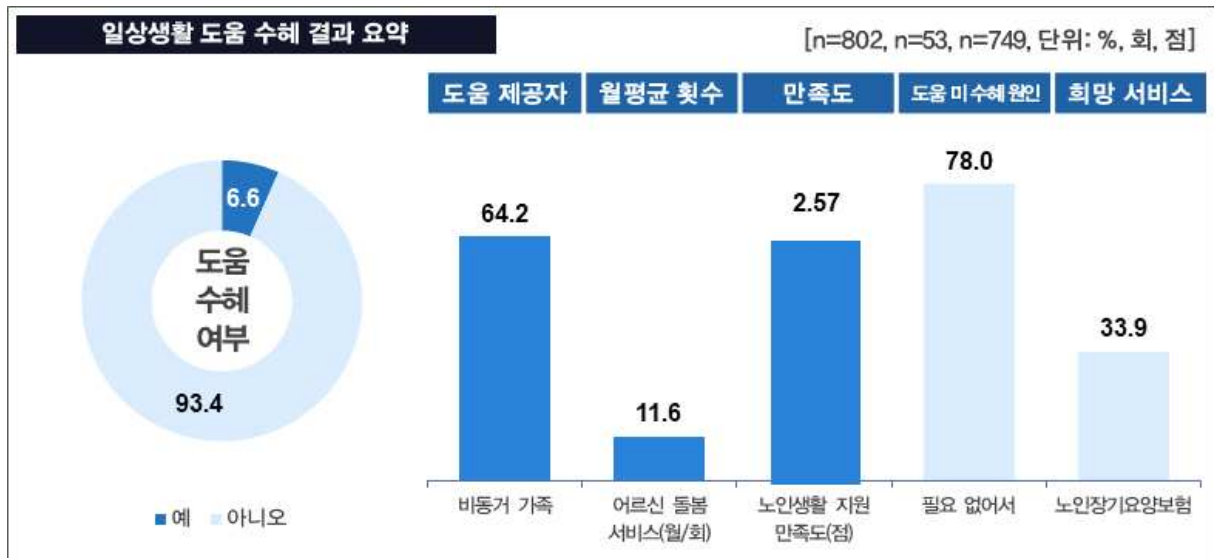

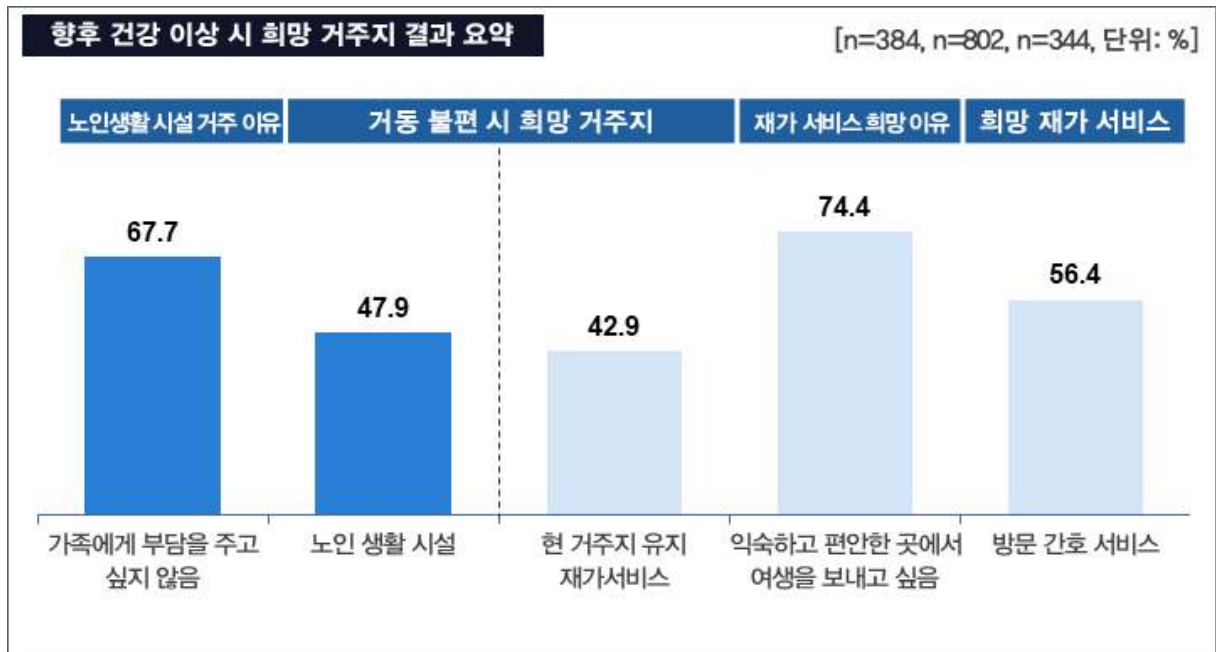
[Figure 1] Statement of Physical and Mental Health Medical Services in Nowon-gu



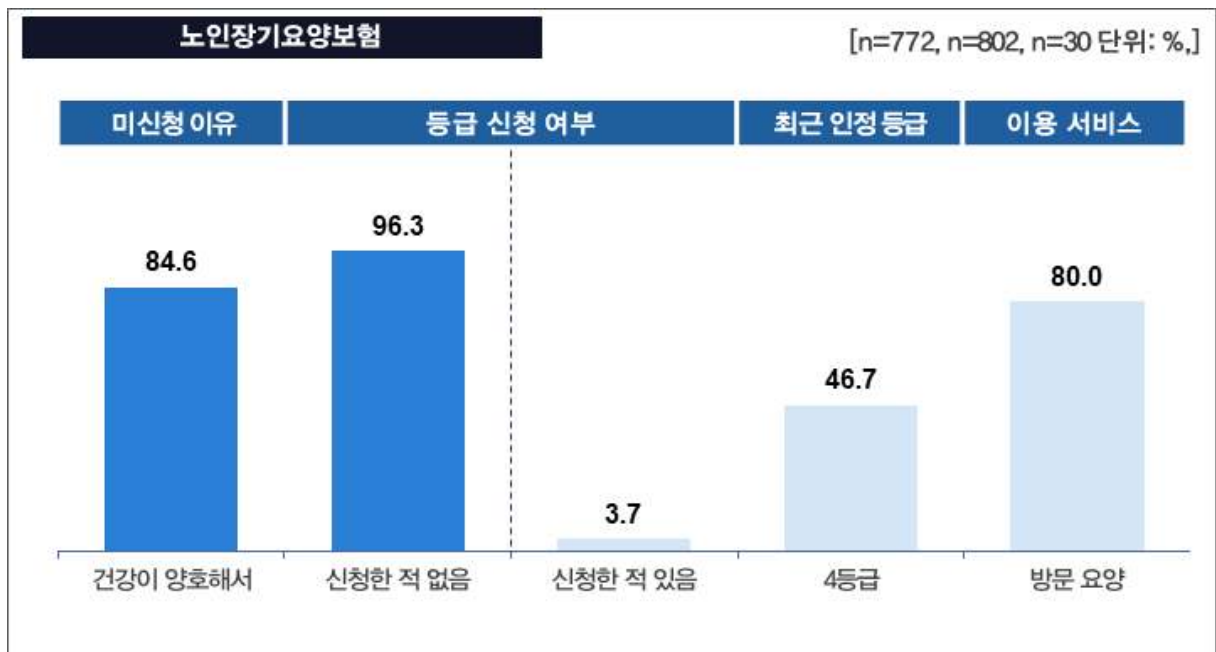
[Figure 2] Statement of Getting Help in Daily Life



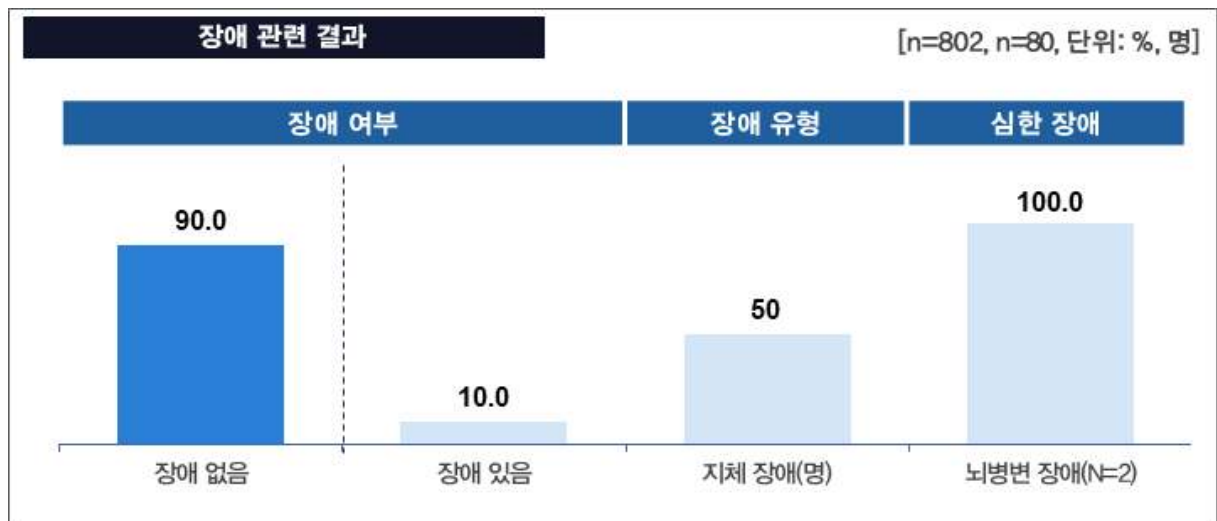
[Figure 3] Preferred Residence in the Statement of Health Problems



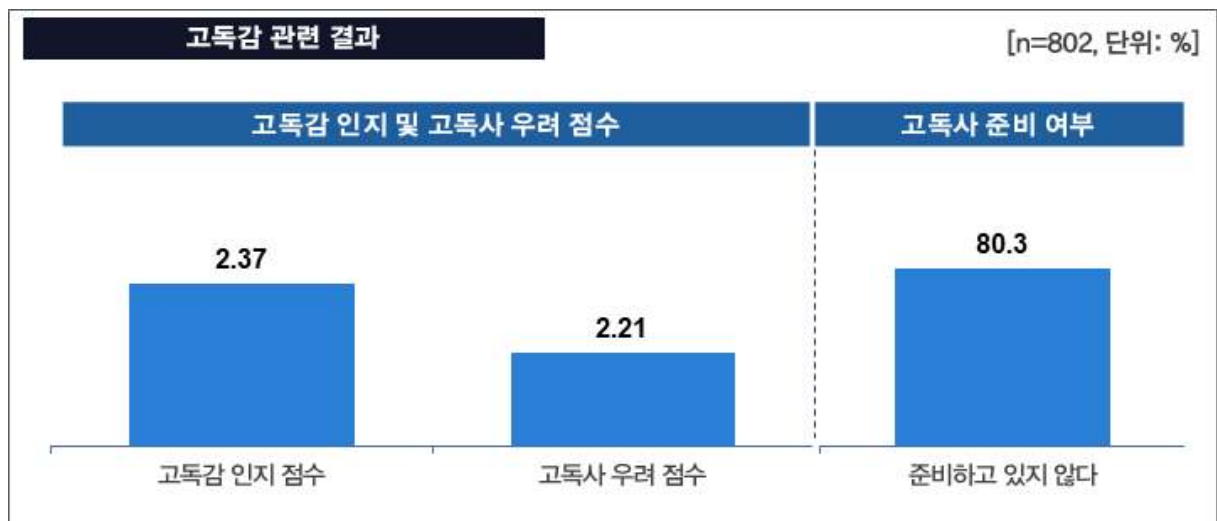
[Figure 4] Statement of Long-term Care Insurance for the Elderly in Nowon-gu



[Figure 5] Statement of Disabilities aged more than 65 in Nowon-gu

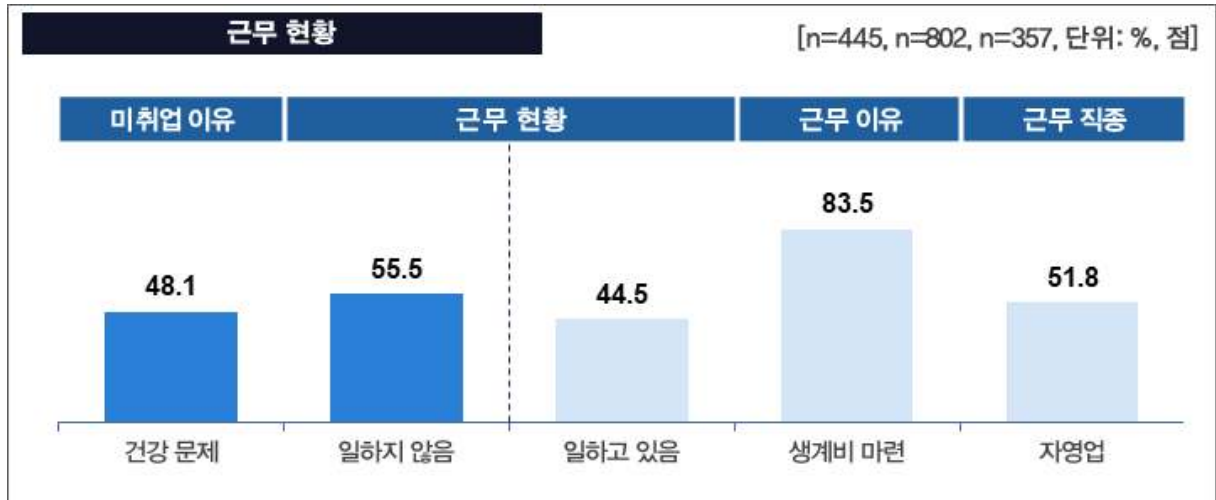


[Figure 6] Lonliness Statement and Preparedness on Solitary Death

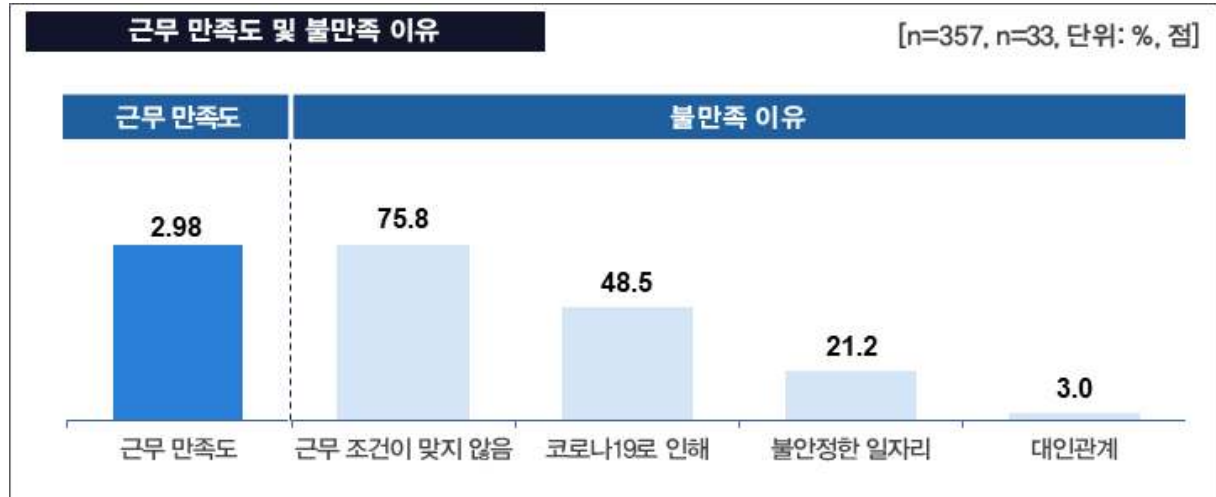

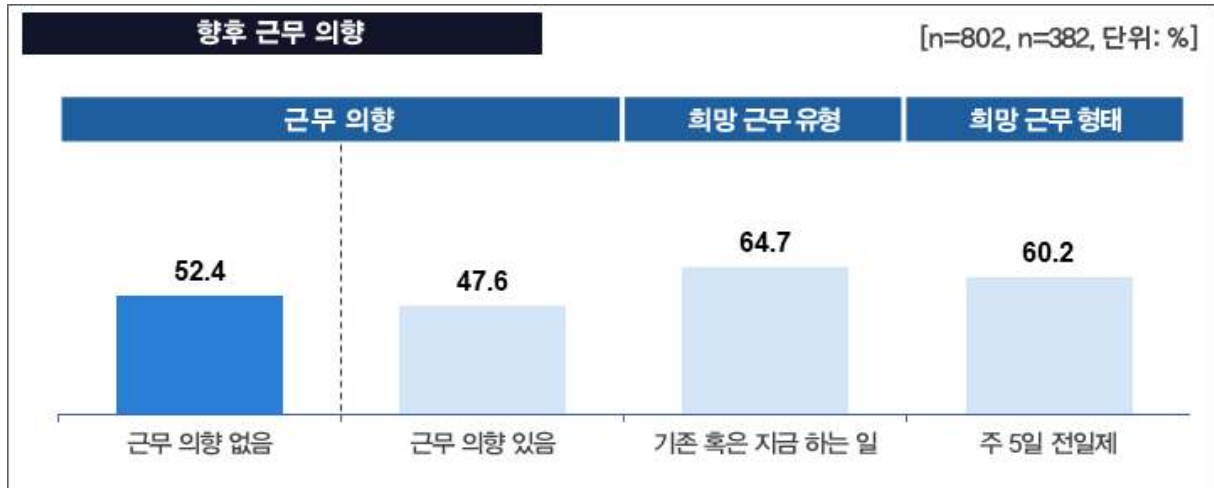
[Figure 7] Result of Employment Statement



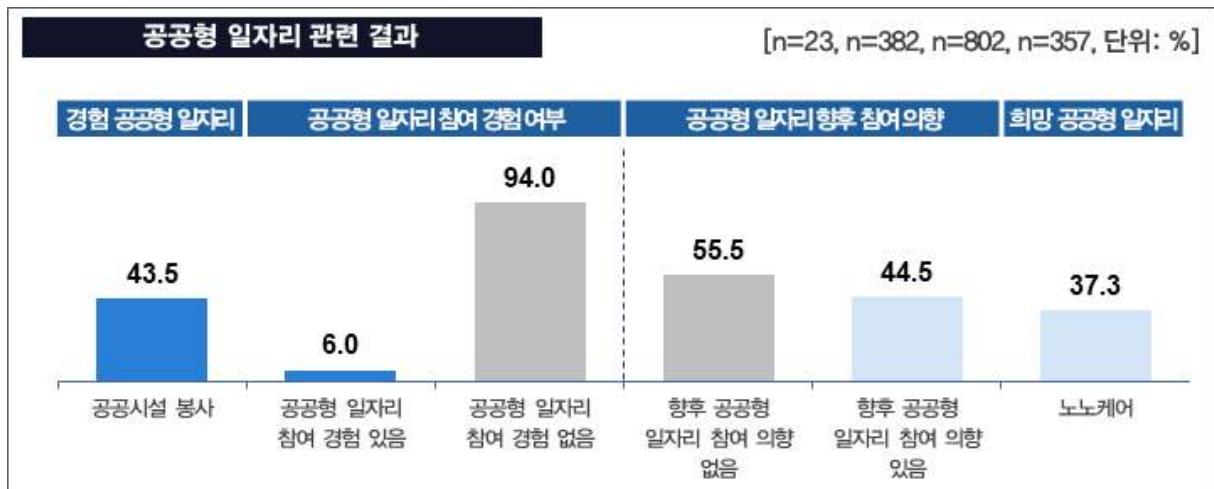
[Figure 8] Work Satisfaction and Reasons for Unsatisfaction



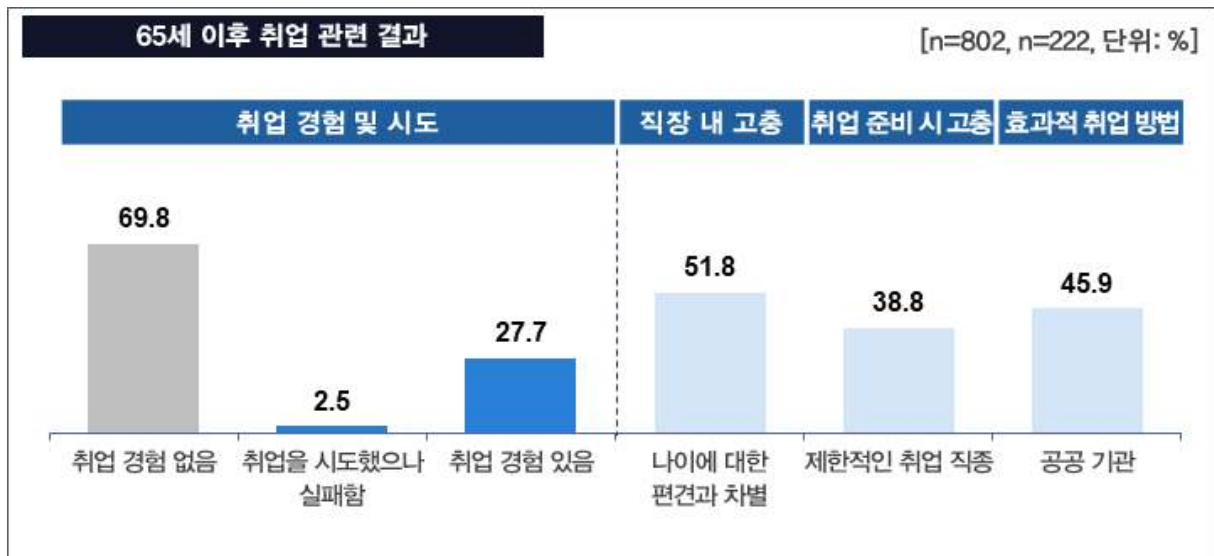
[Figure 9] Intentions on Work and Preferred Type of Employment



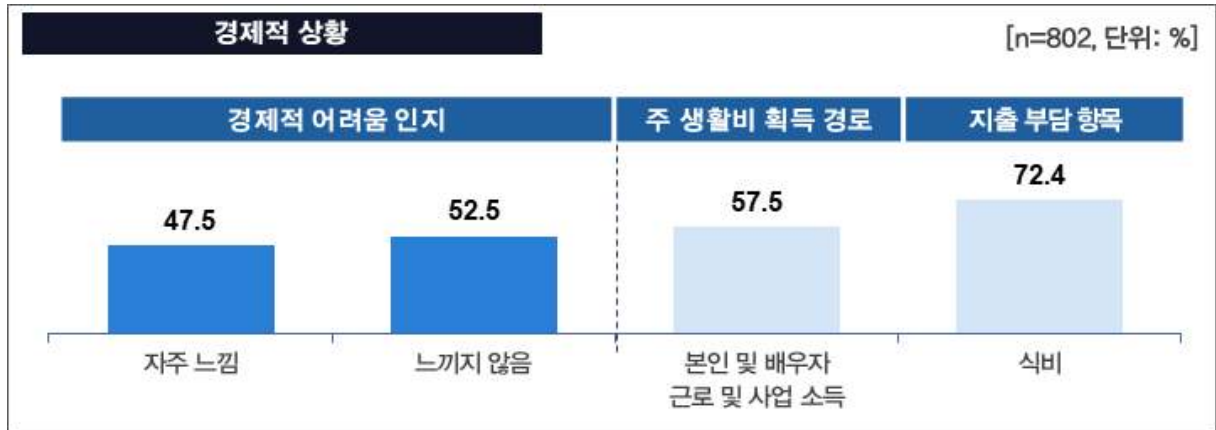
[Figure 10] Statement of Public Employment Program



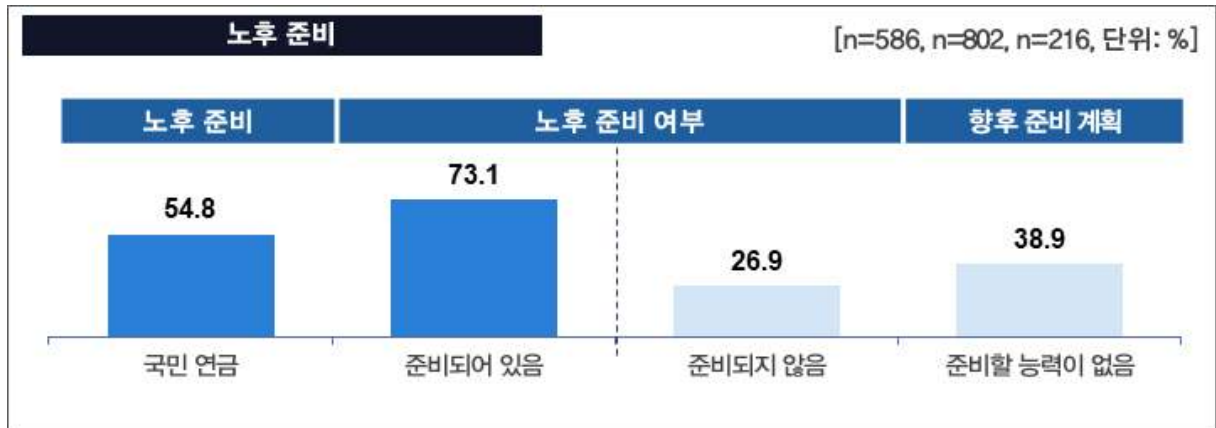
[Figure 11] Experiences on a Job Search after aged 65

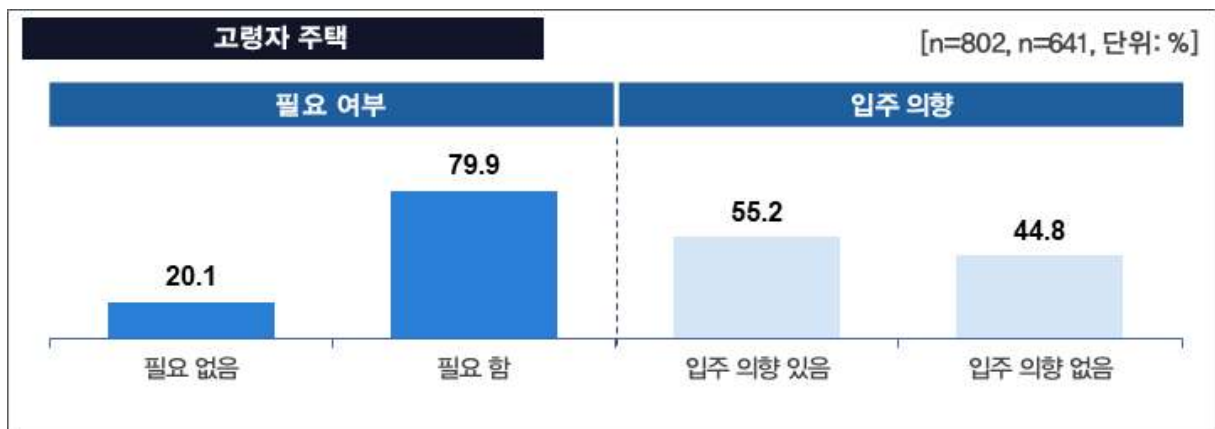
[Figure 14] Statement of Housing



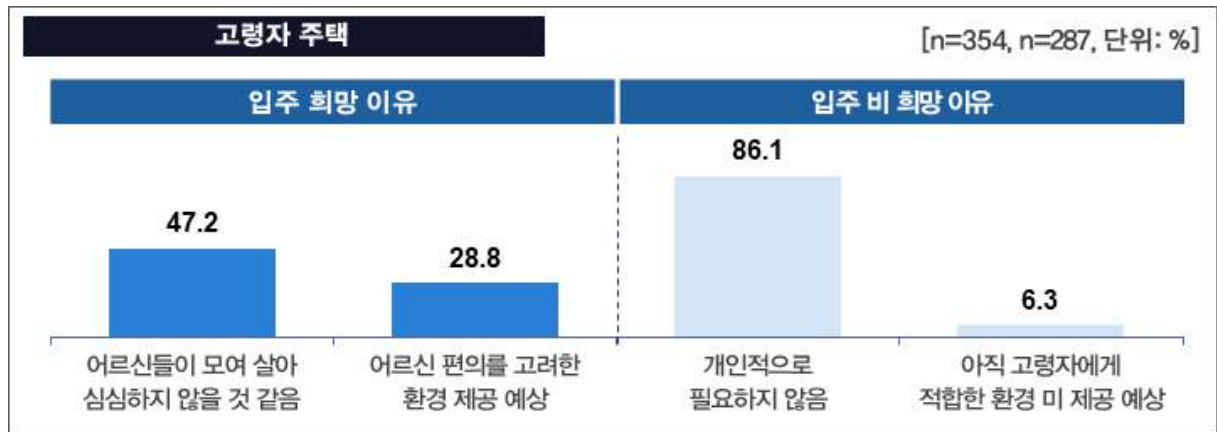
[Figure 15] Important Elements for Housing



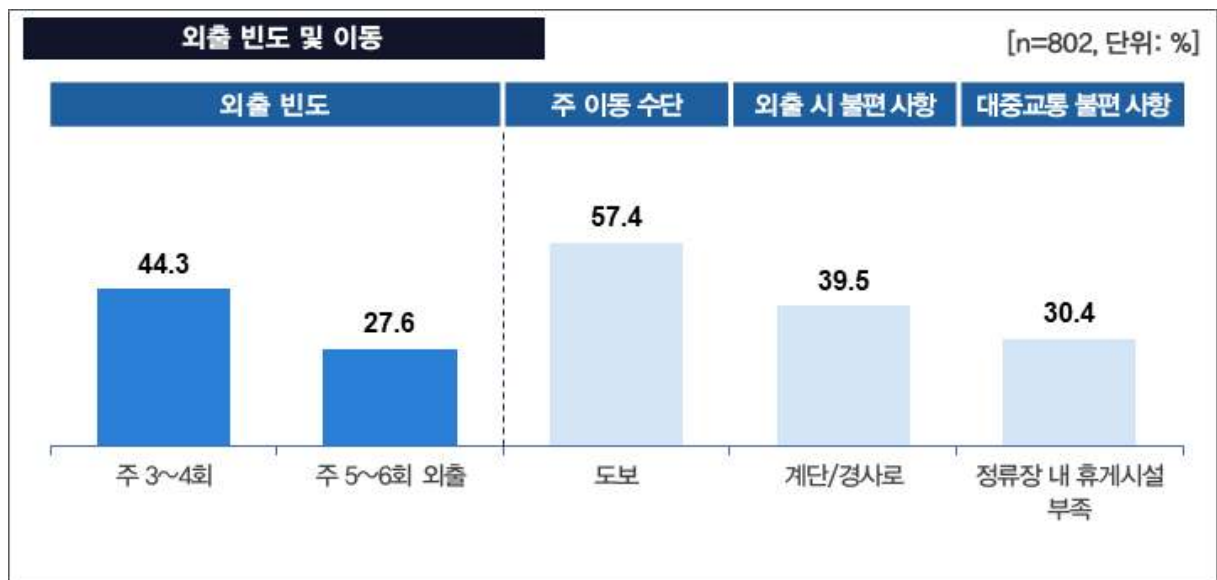
[Figure 16] Needs for Housing for the Elderly in Nowon-gu



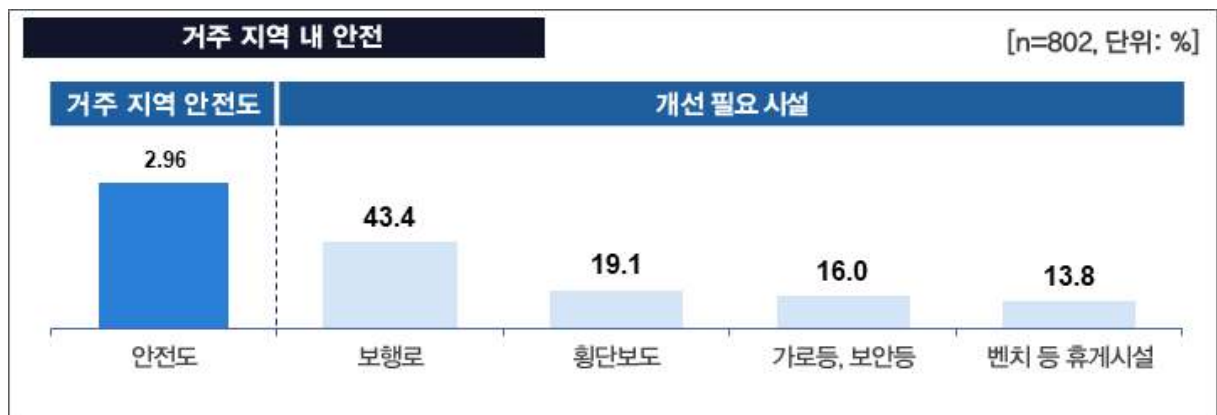
[Figure 17] Intention on Living in House for the Elderly and Reasons for not living in House for the Elderly



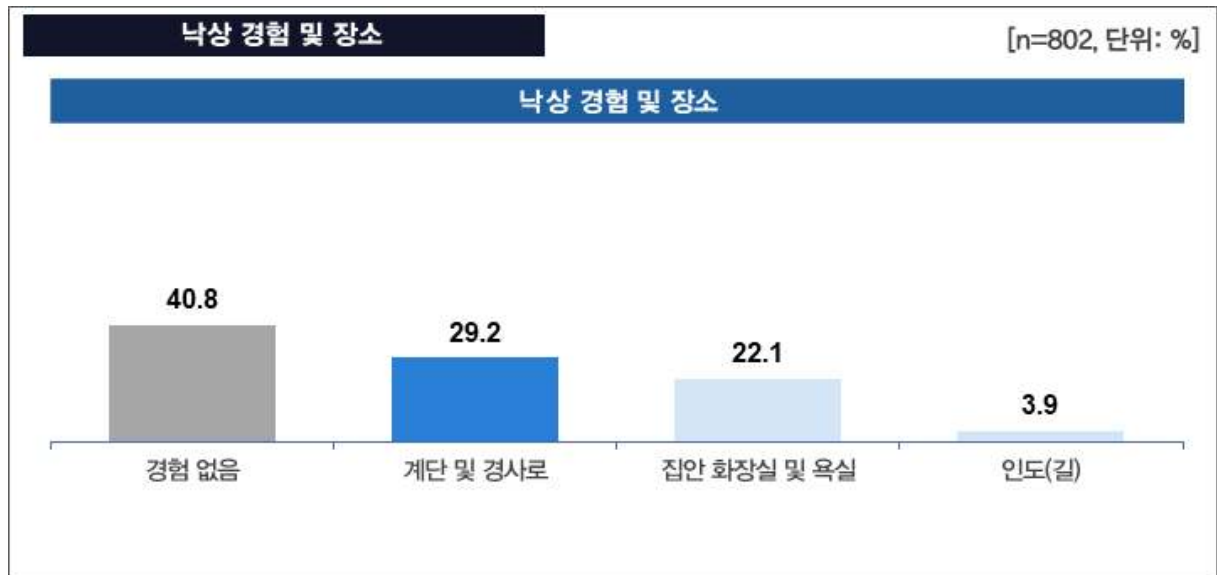
[Figure 18] Statement of Going out and Moving Methods

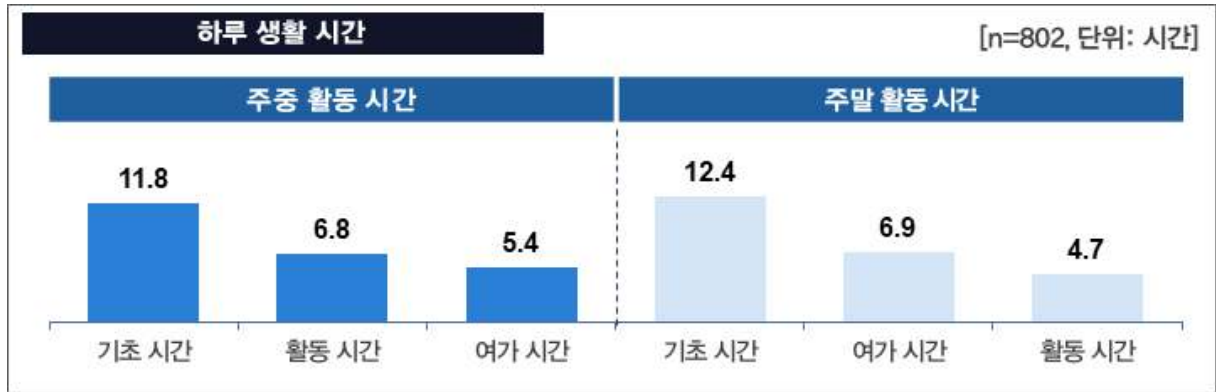


[Figure 20] Statement of Falling Down

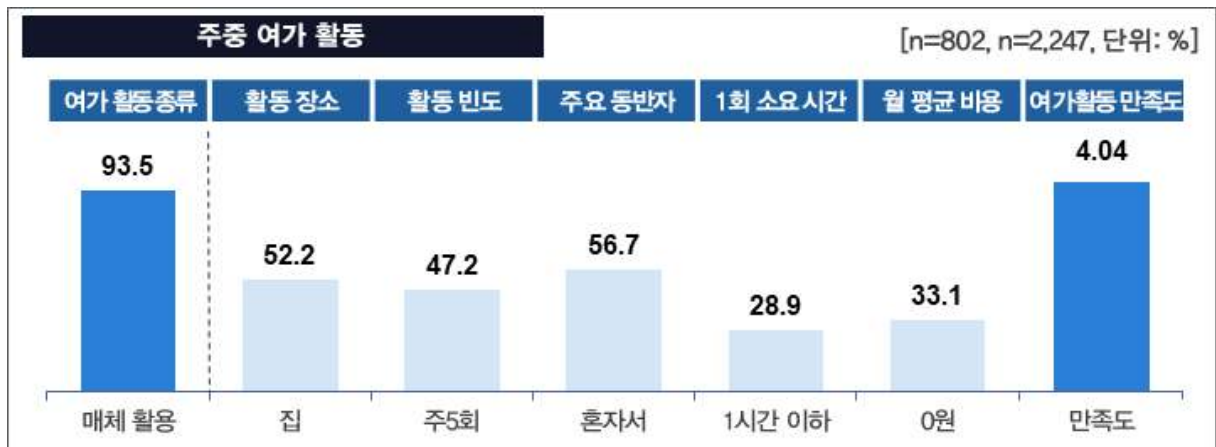

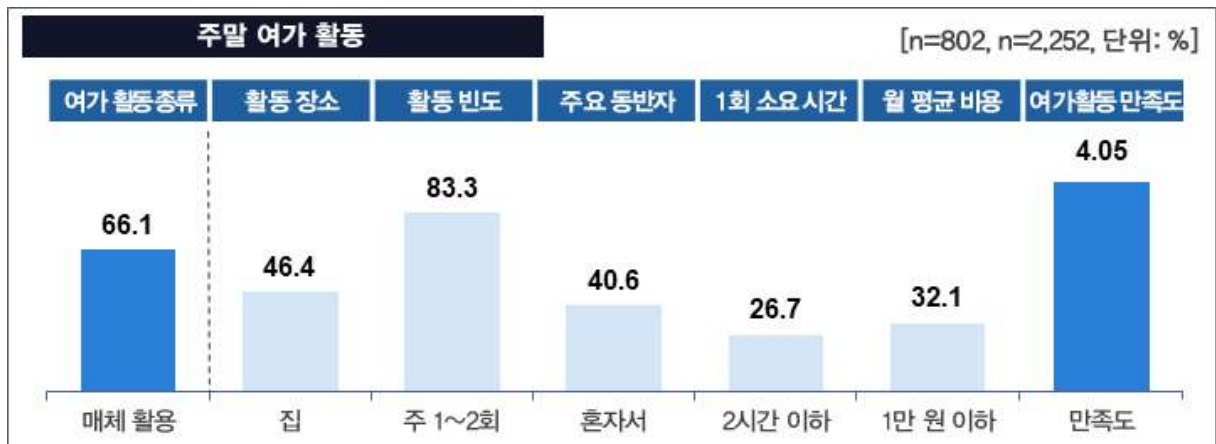
[Figure 21] Daily Routines(Weekdays/Weekends)



[Figure 22] Statement of Weekdays Activities for Leisure



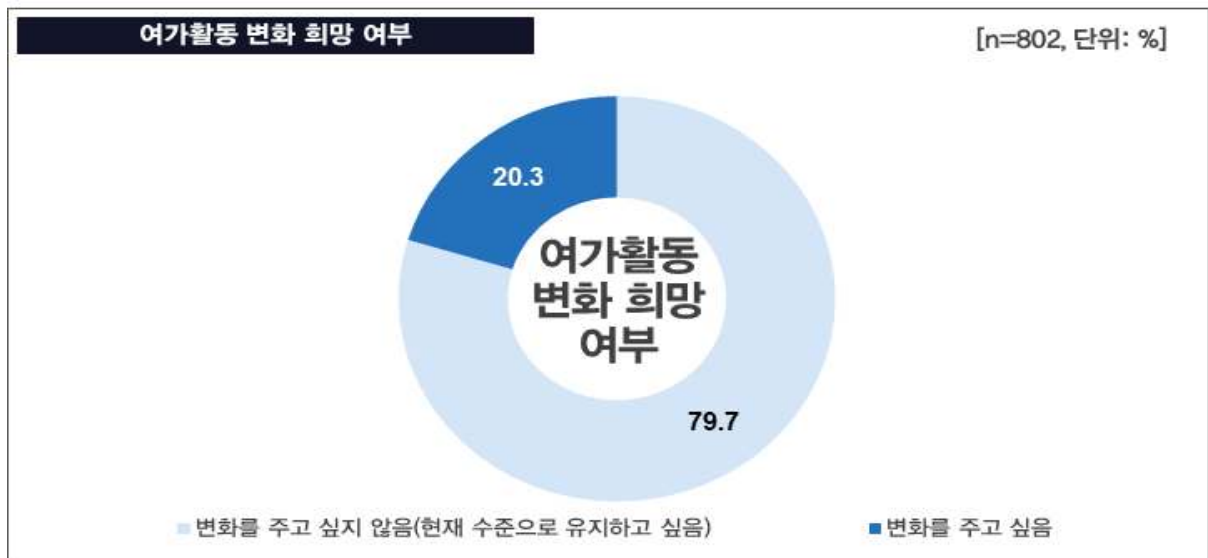
[Figure 23] Statement of Weekends Activities for Leisure



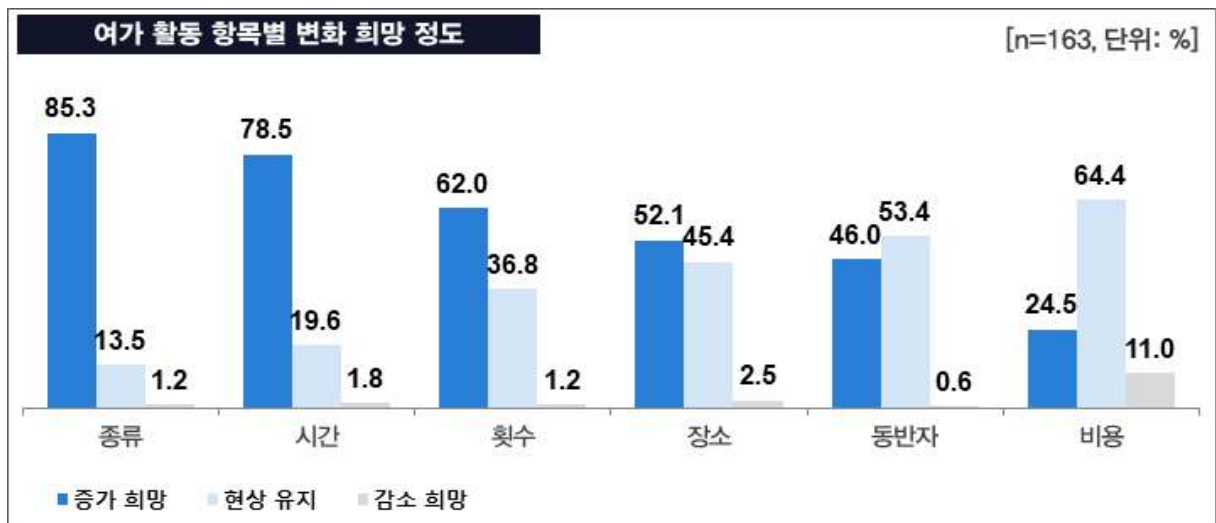
[Figure 24] Satisfaction and Limitations on Activities for Leisure



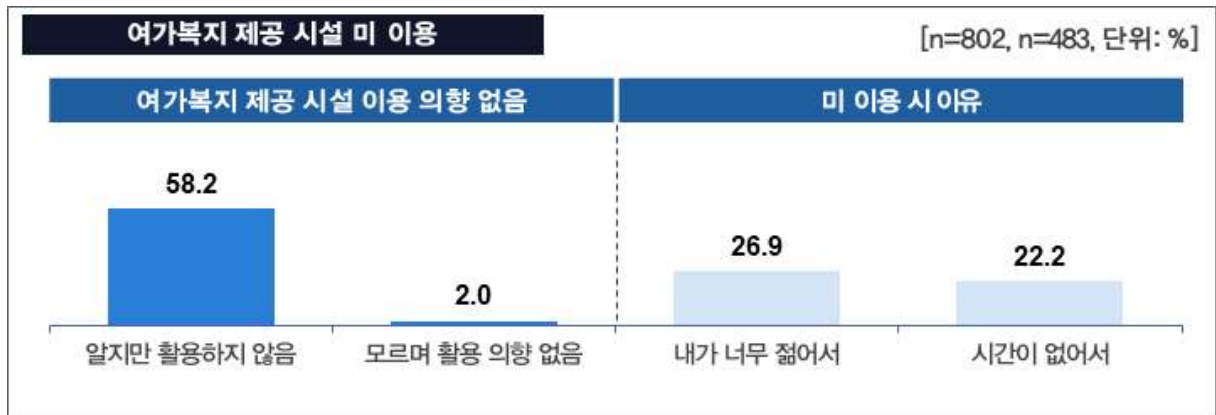
[Figure 25] Statement of Developing Activities for Leisure



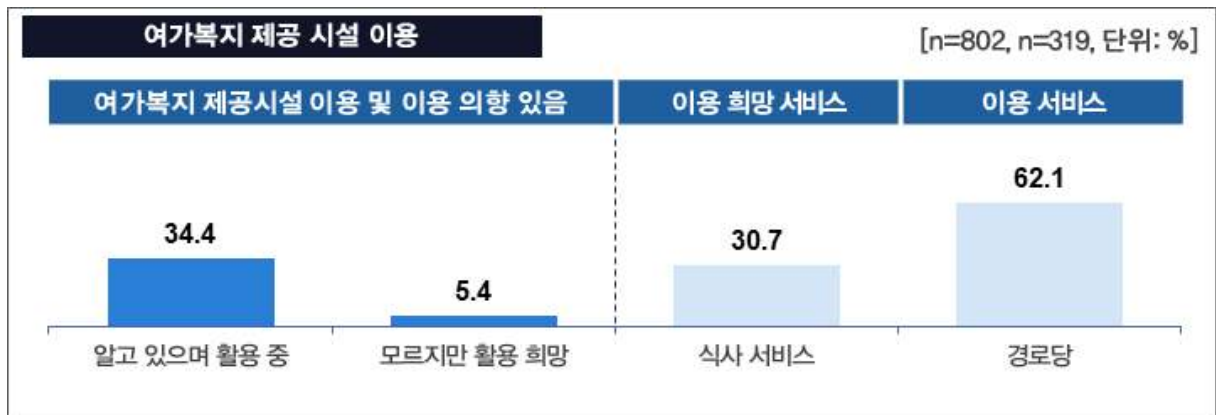
[Figure 26] Demands for Developing Activities for Leisure by Contents



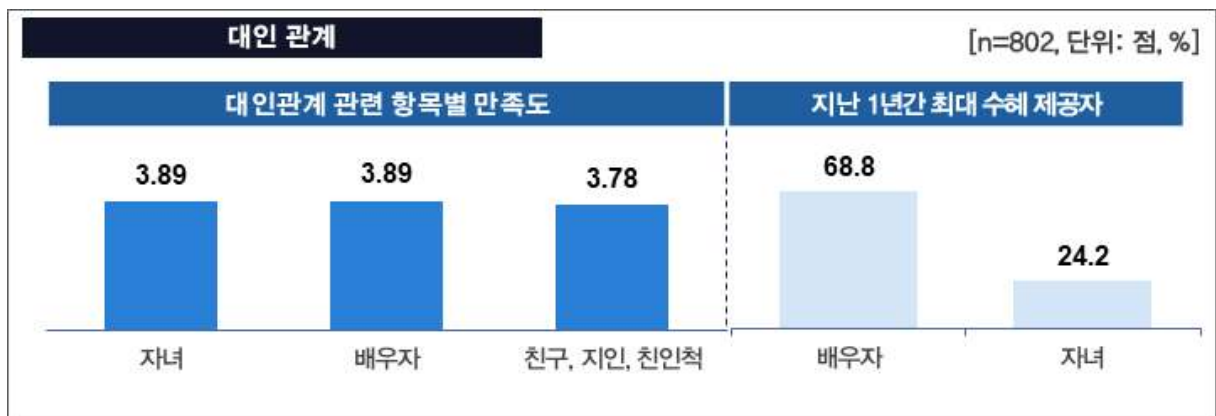
[Figure 27] Reasons for Not Using Leisure Facilities in Nowon-gu



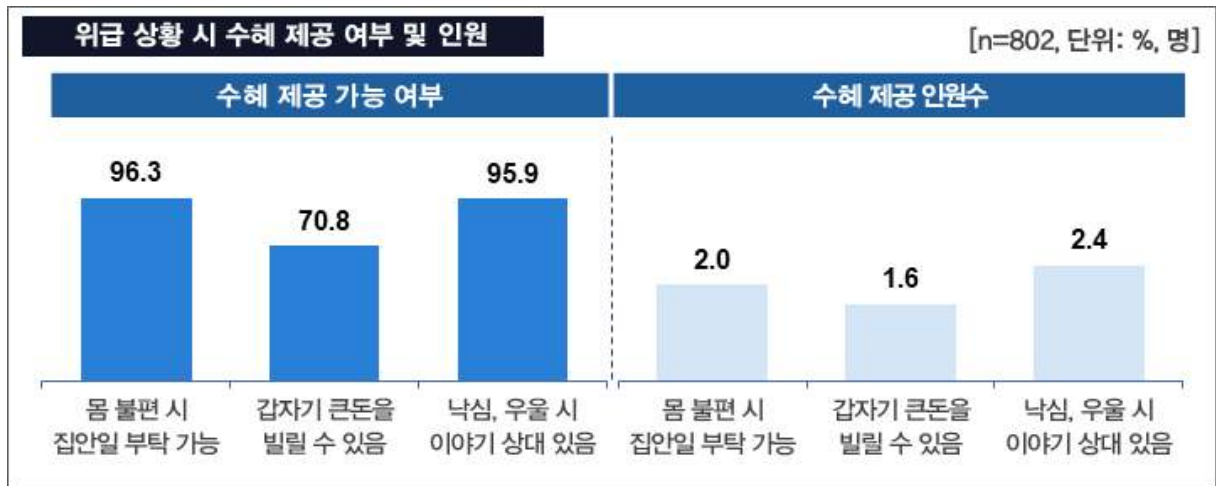
[Figure 28] Facility types Intending to Visit

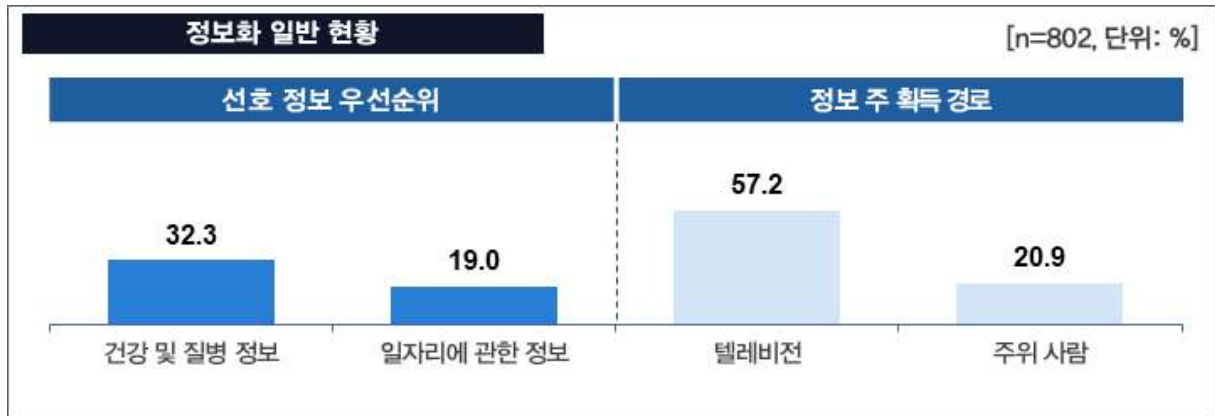


[Figure 31] Statement of Interpersonal Relationship by Case

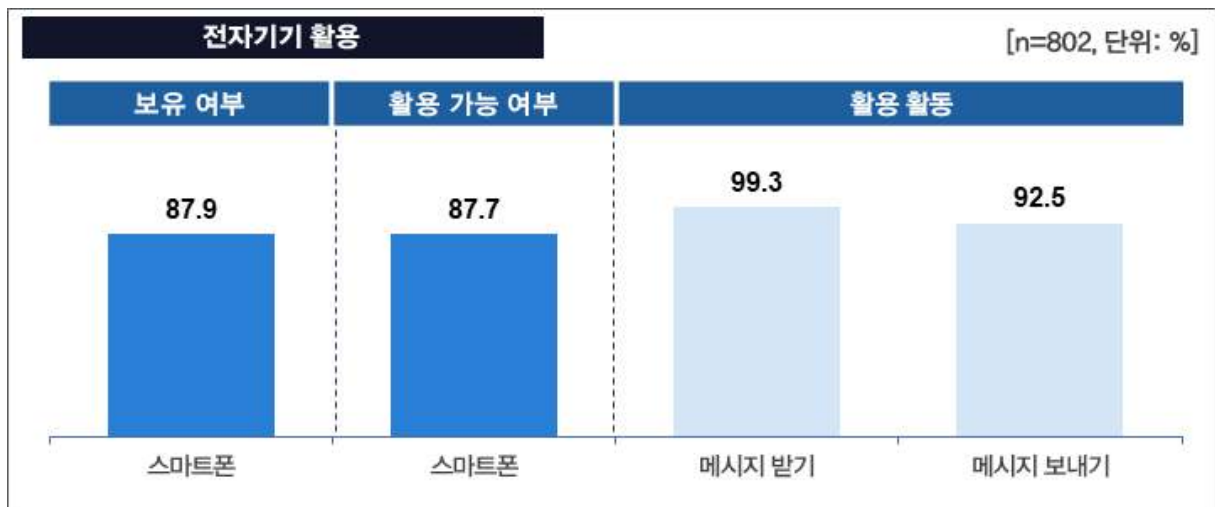
[Figure 32] Preferred Information Area and Methods

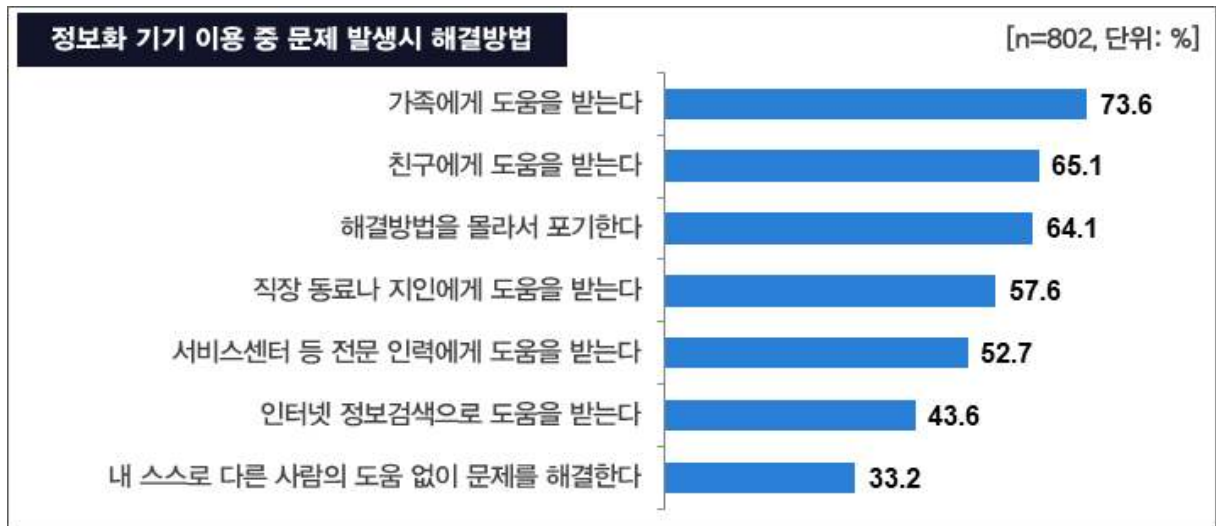




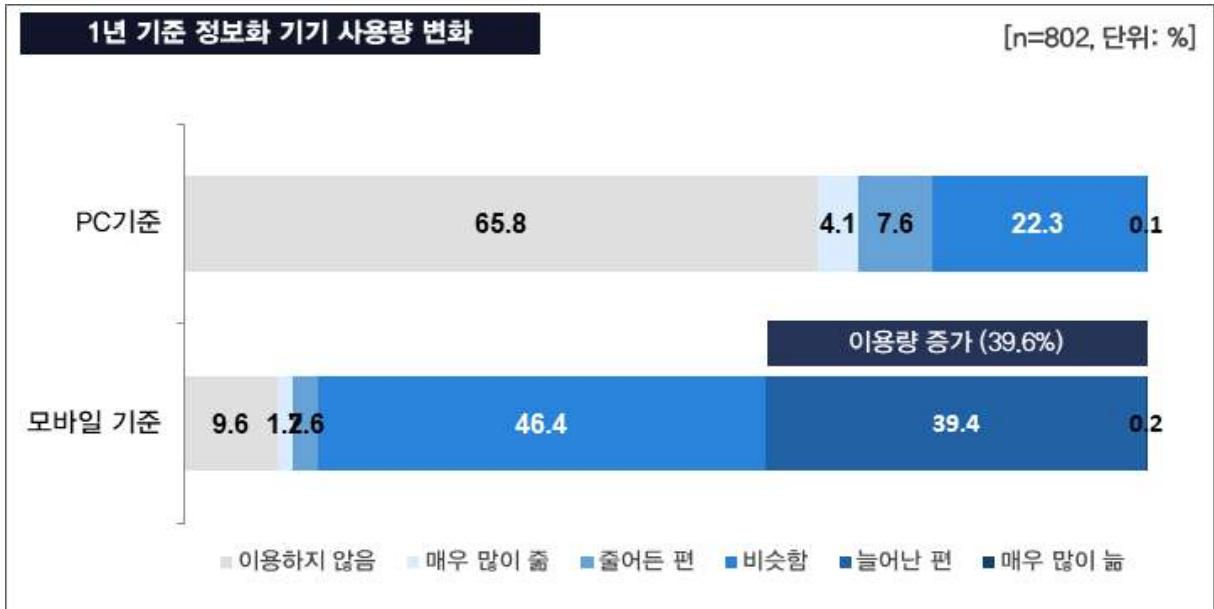
[Figure 35] Difficulties on Technical Development in Daily lives



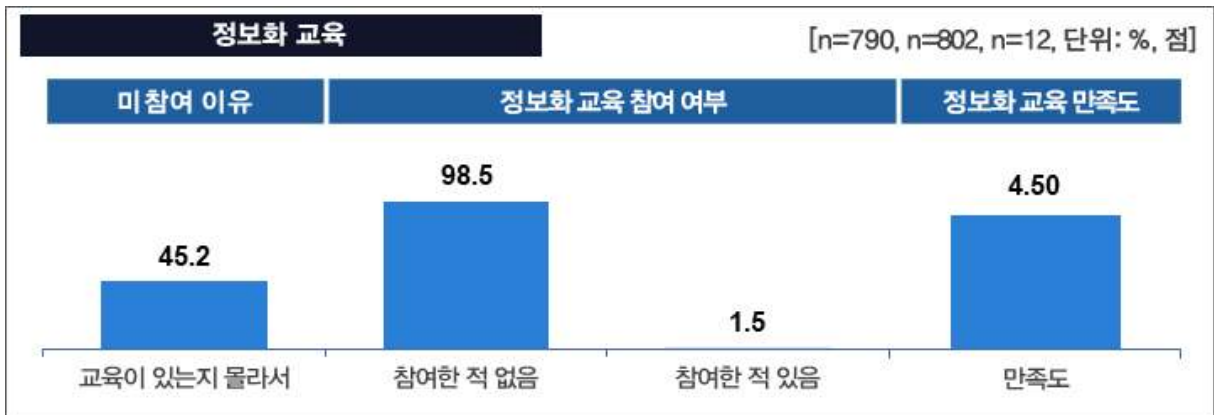
[Figure 36] Solutions for Difficulties by Using Devices



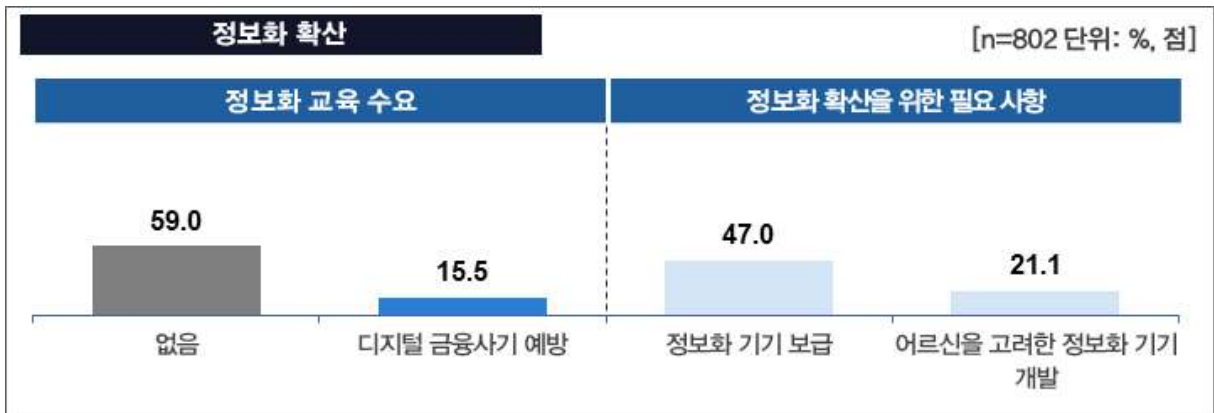
[Figure 37] Changes in Internet Usage of Devices on a Yearly Basis

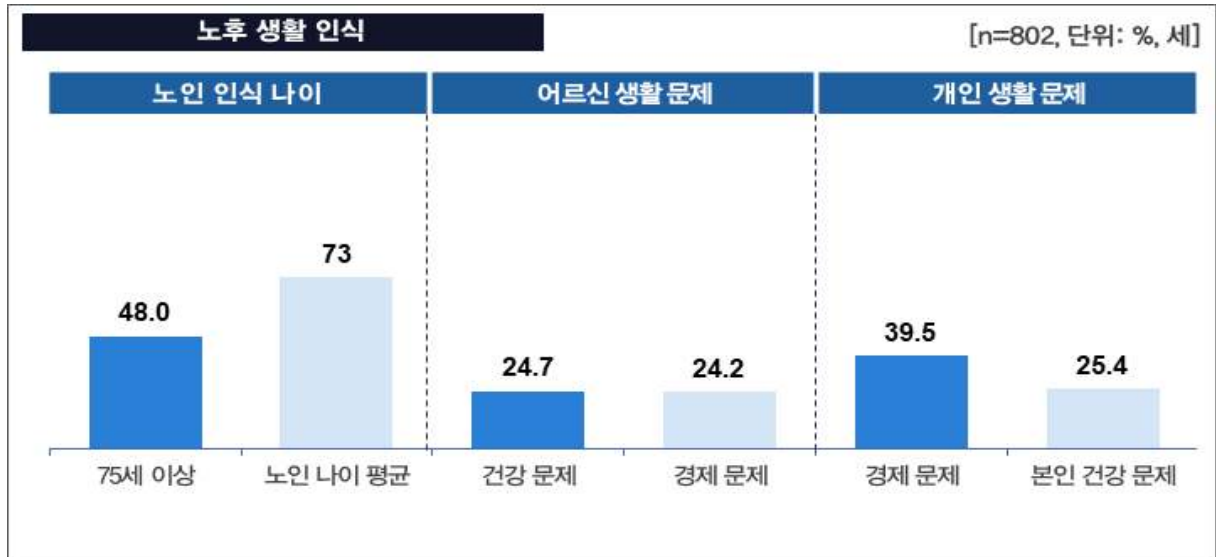


[Figure 39] Demands for Education Programs on Informatization

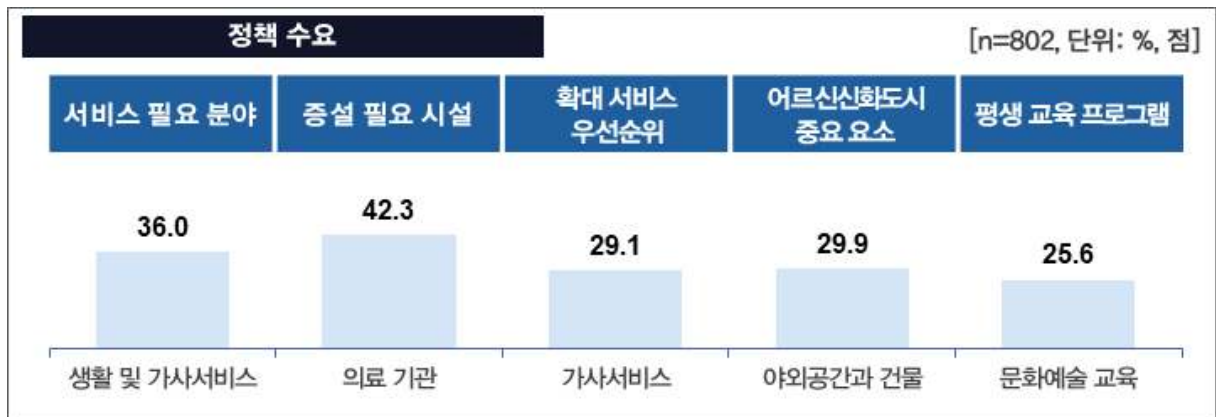

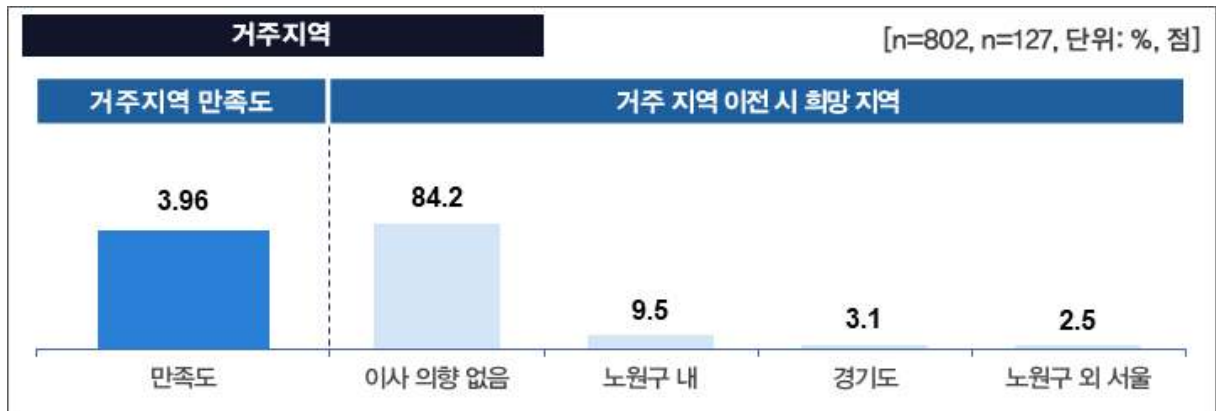
[Figure 40] Recognition of Living Aged Life
