

Baseline Assessment for Age-Friendly City in Jongno-gu

- Task Assessment for 57 tasks will follow in quantitative measurement. In accordance with their accomplishment, and the assessment grade will be given on every task.

- 3 Survey on Policy Recognition
  - The Survey on Policy Recognition will be done as external assessment. The target will be residents and the aged in Jongno-gu.
  - The measurement has 7 divisions and 63 components. The questions are measured by 5-point Likert scale; Very dissatisfied, Somewhat dissatisfied, Neither satisfied nor dissatisfied, Somewhat satisfied, and Very satisfied.
  - The survey will be conducted once every two years and it should be possible to compare and review long-term trends by conducting a questionnaire similar to the panel survey.
