Chapter 3. Establishment of a plan to create an aged-friendly city

Section 1. Basic directions

- As the aging society progresses, it is necessary to cope with various areas such as health and medical support, economic and social participation, activity and safety in the outdoor spaces, and it is important to see aging as an opportunity rather than a problem.
- Improvement of policies to make them more suitable for senior citizens by allowing them to participate and contribute in policymaking.
- The elderly-friendly city is not just a policy to support the elderly, but to restore the vitality of the elderly and lay the foundation for the elderly to live together with all members of society, so that they can continue their lives as proud citizens in the society.
- Activation of political and social participation and establishment of partnerships with various civil societies is required so that senior citizens can not only function as economic producers but also serve as emotional mentors and social volunteers to the younger generation.
- Based on the guidelines presented by the WHO, the government draws up feasible strategic tasks through gathering opinions from citizens and experts, such as analyzing the current status, diagnosis of age-friendliness, and roundtable discussions.

Section 2. Vision and strategy

- The vision is to create a successful aged-friendly city where the elderly can have rejuvenating retirement, without leaving the place where they have lived, by selecting the vision “Successful Goseong, city where the elderly are comfortable and happy.”

- The implementation strategy is to set the creation of a safe and convenient life, provide means of participation and communication with the community, and provide a rejuvenating and healthy retirement based on the sectors of the physical, socioeconomic environment, and social services

- The action plan is to improve the quality of life of the elderly and revitalize the city through participation of the elderly in local activities, by utilizing their rich knowledge and experiences
