

- Adopted the vision of Hwasun, ‘a city of inter-generation solidarity where you can live an energetic aged life’ for the first age-friendly city
  - The 1<sup>st</sup> Hwasun-gun Basic Plan for Age-Friendly City sets five goals: "Creating a Sustainable and Flexible Welfare City," "Strengthening a Productive Social Safety Net," "Reinforcing Social Welfare Infrastructure," "Creating a Society of Inter-Generational Solidarity," and "Building an Integrated Region-Centered Welfare System."
  - Planned a total of 46 projects over 3 areas and 8 domains as of 2023
    - Three goals: A safe and happy Hwasun, a city of happiness where all generations participate and share, and a healthy and lively Hwasun.
    - Timeframe: from 2021 to 2023
    - Projects: 3 Goals / 8 Areas / 46 Projects (as of 2023)
- The first basic plan for an age-friendly city of Hwasun-gun was highly praised for continuous and systematic review, modification and supplementation of projects through annual evaluation and planning.
- As the evaluation of each project in the annual plan is conducted by each department, it is necessary to develop a systematic evaluation system.
- At the same time, the projects of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Basic Plan should focus on identifying the actual needs and wants of the citizens and promote the project through public-private partnerships.

- Conducted a matrix analysis (IPA) based on the results of a Delphi survey on experts

- Analyzed the importance of each project and the need for improvement by project using IPA (Importance–Performance Analysis) for 46 projects of the first period.
