









## POPULATION AGEING IN KOLBUDY COMMUNE

60 years and more: + 2 124 persons






## **DEMOGRAPHIC DATA AND ITS IMPLICATIONS**






The age structure of the commune's inhabitants is relatively favourable

The local society is ageing - the number of older adults is growing much faster than the number of young people

The process of population ageing is happening faster than the average population ageing rate in the Pomeranian Region Women dominate among seniors

The number of persons aged 85 and over is significantly increasing





Increase of the number and share of persons aged 60 and over among the inhabitants of the commune - up to 34% of the total population in 2050

Decline of the youngest age group share to approx. 20% of the total population

Decrease of "prime age" (20-44) group share to 26% of the total population

## Portrait of Kolbudy Commune inhabitants aged 60+

sociological research conducted among older adults living in Kolbudy Commune (questionnaire interview method): 183 respondents – representative sample of 8% of the commune's population aged 60+


The main issues surveyed:

- · senility and loneliness,
- self-assessment of health condition.
- access to different types of care services,
- economic and social activity,
- security,
- availability and seniors' interest in services dedicated to older adults offered by the Kolbudy Commune.

12% of seniors live alone and more than 50% in a two-person household with another person aged 60 and over

16% of seniors "often" or "always" stay at home alone

over 80% of seniors receive the suport and care services from family members or relatives, when its necessary (13% remain without any support)

## SENIOR AT HOME: PROVIDING CARE SERVICES

- Home healthcare services (home visits of doctor or nurse)
- Social services (including home care and companionship for seniors) provided at seniors' homes by local government, NGOs and the CARITAS – Catholic Church institution
- Home telecare ("life alert" and telecare assistant)
- Trainings and psychological support for seniors' carers
- Respite care as the support/relief for seniors' usual caregivers
- Official celebrations of seniors' bitrhdays (those aged 90 years and over)









## CREATE AND PROMOTE POSITIVE IMAGE OF OLDER ADULTS

- Promotion of the seniors' artistic achievements and activities
- Cooperation with schools and kindergartens building intergenerational relations
- Intergenerational activities like intergenerational sightseeing tours
- Building and maintaining outdoor gyms enabling the activity of seniors
- Construction and renovation of public infrastructure within the principles of universal design
- Installation of benches along the pedestrian paths
- Lighting pedestrian crossings






