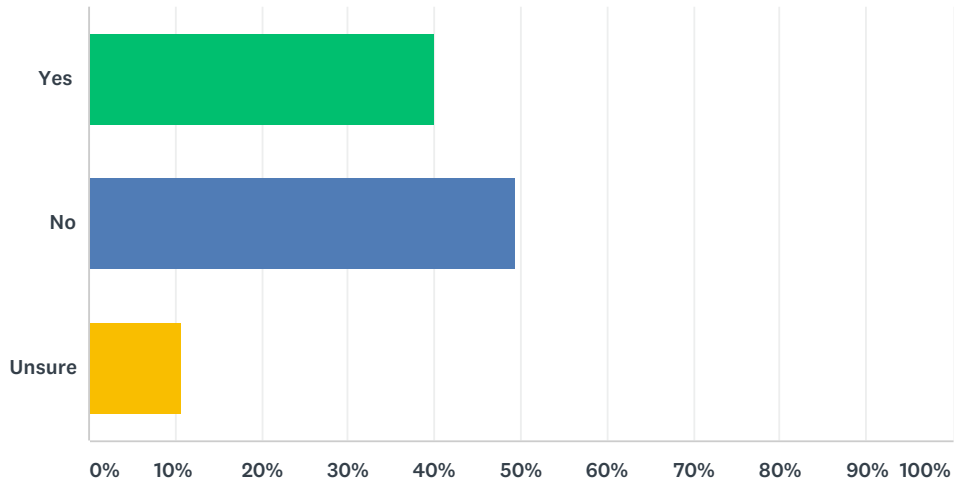


Q1 Have you heard about the Age Friendly Communities initiative?

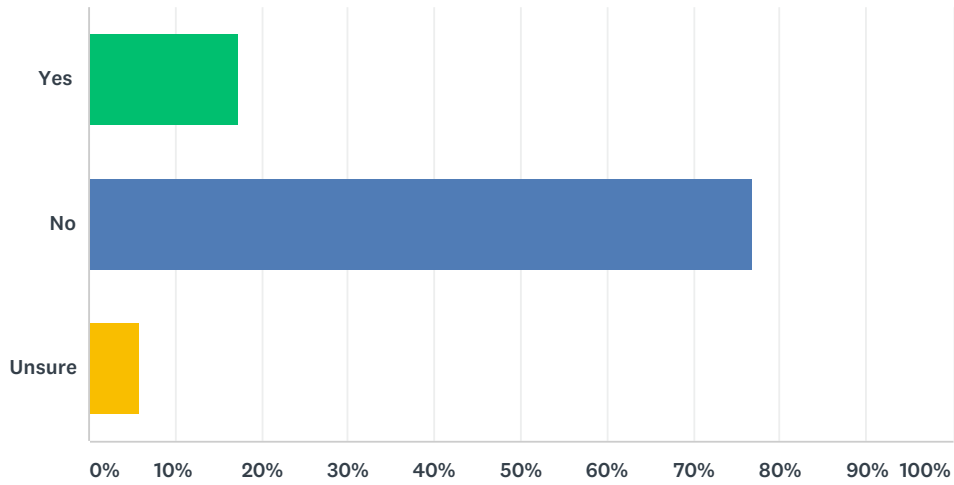

Q2 Have you heard about the Melville Age Friendly Accessible Businesses (MAFAB) Network?

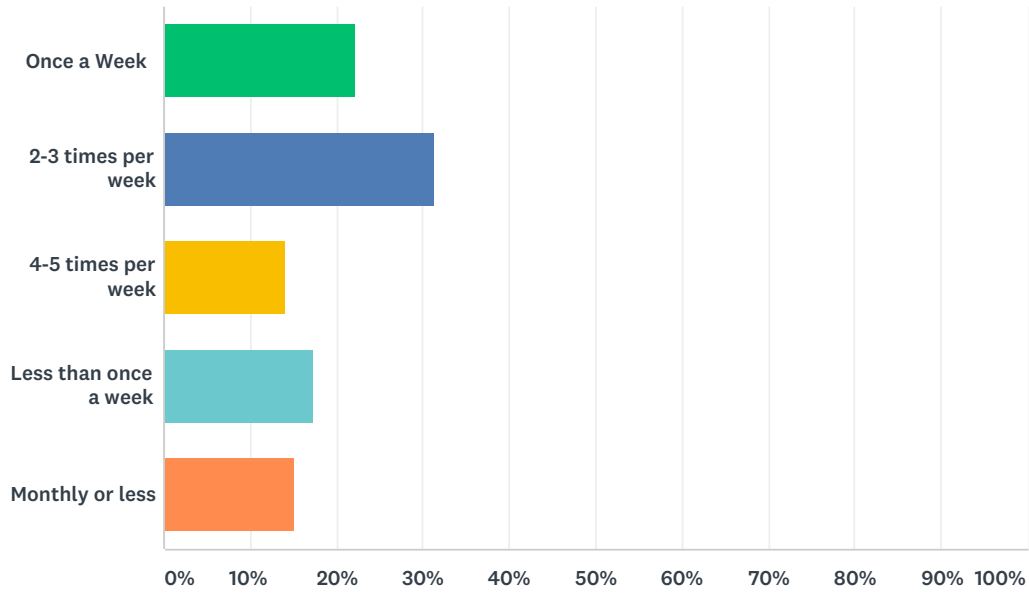

Q3 How often do you shop at Garden City?

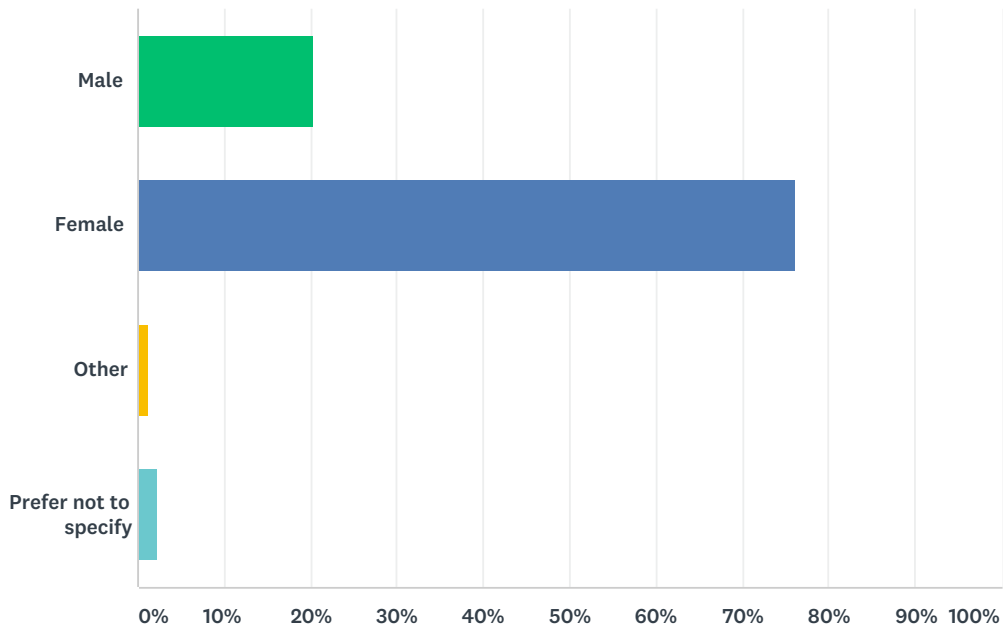

Q4 Gender?

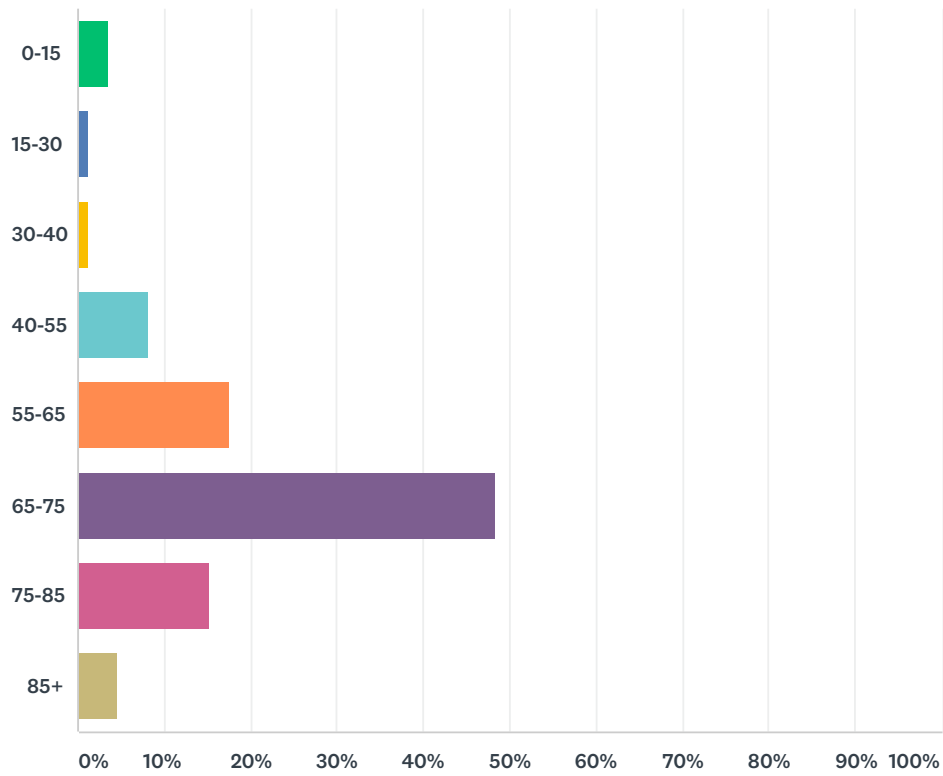

Q5 What is your age?

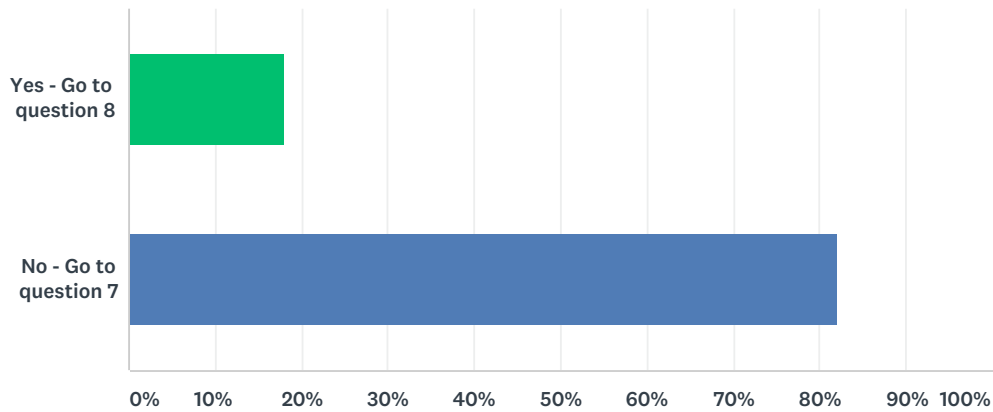

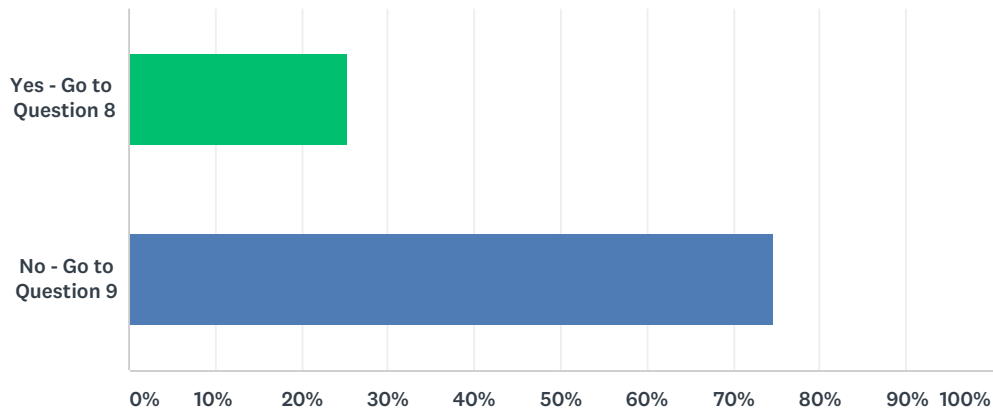

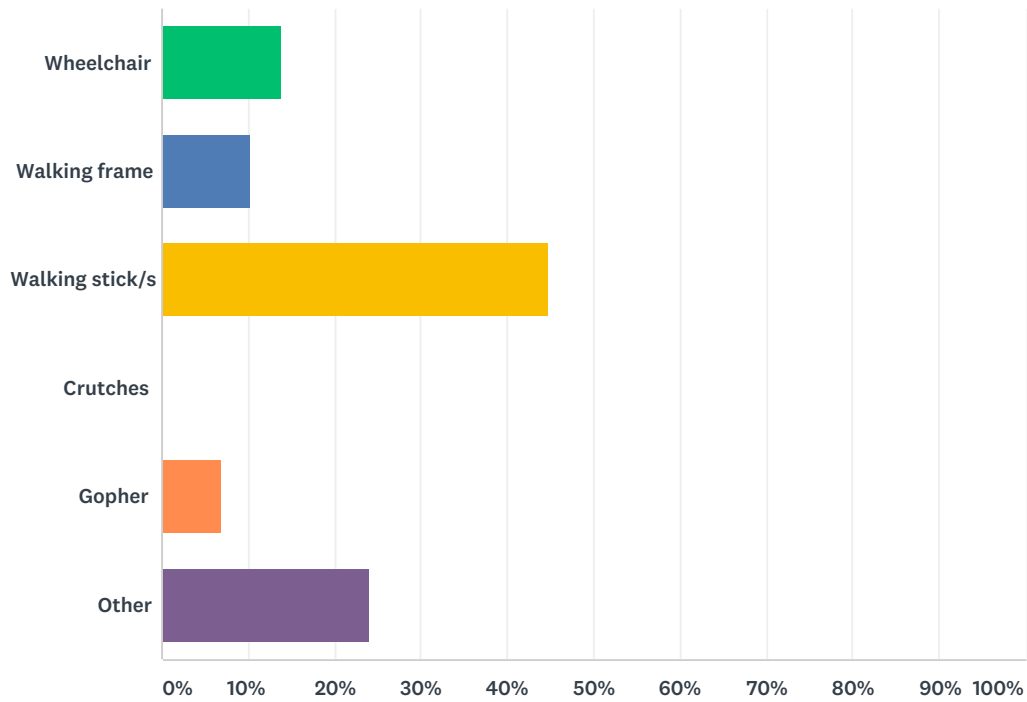

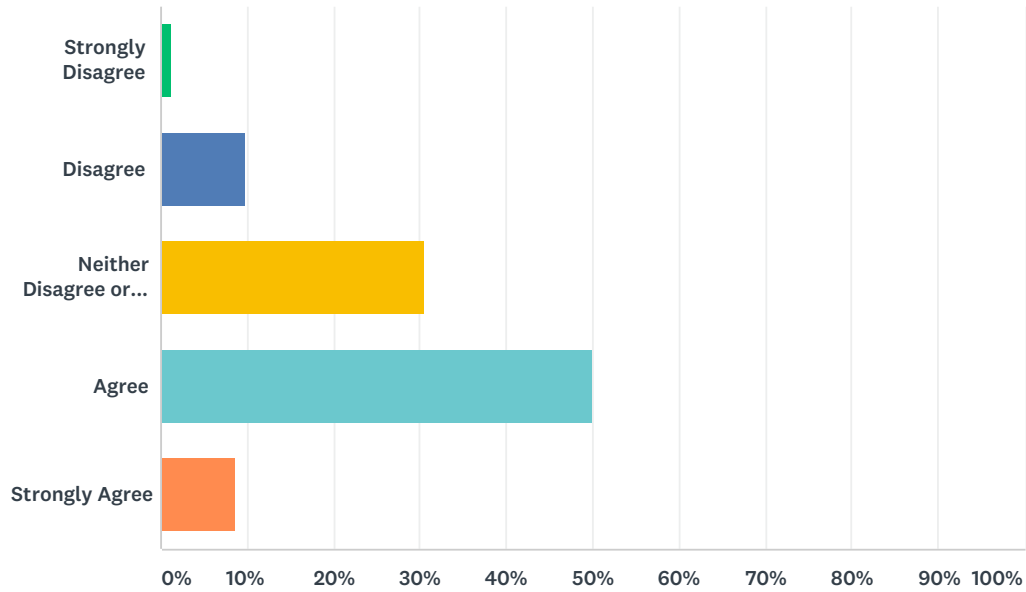

Q11 I find it easy to find what I need?

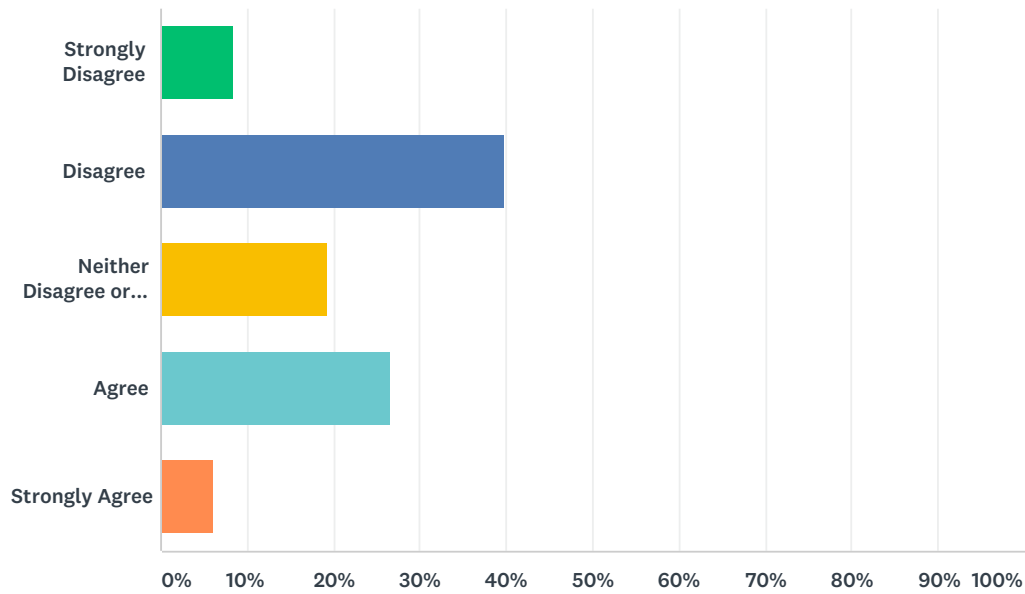

Q12 There is adequate seating available in Garden City for my needs?

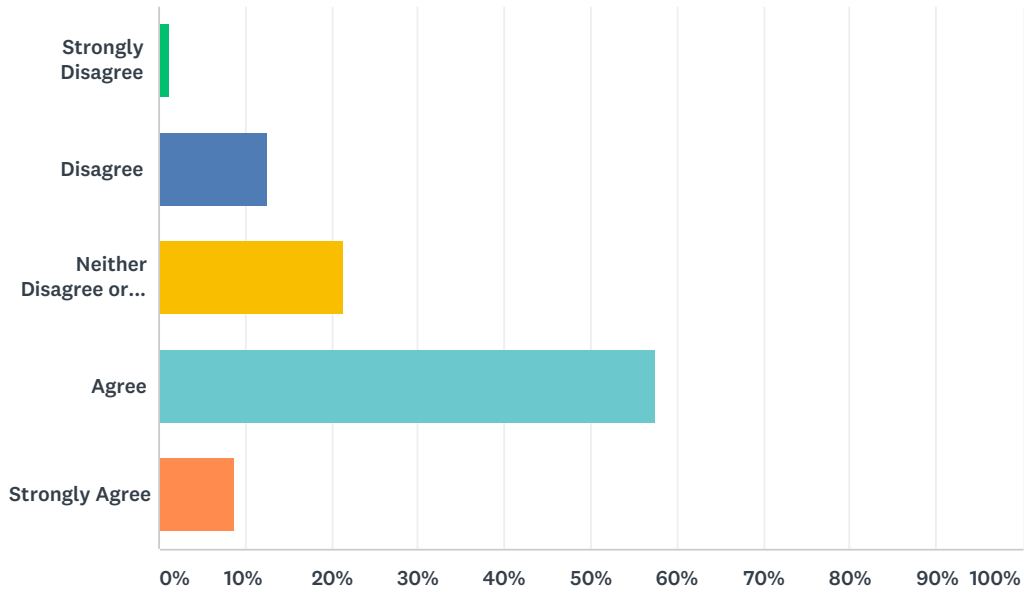

Q13 I find it easy to read shop information (signs and advertising).

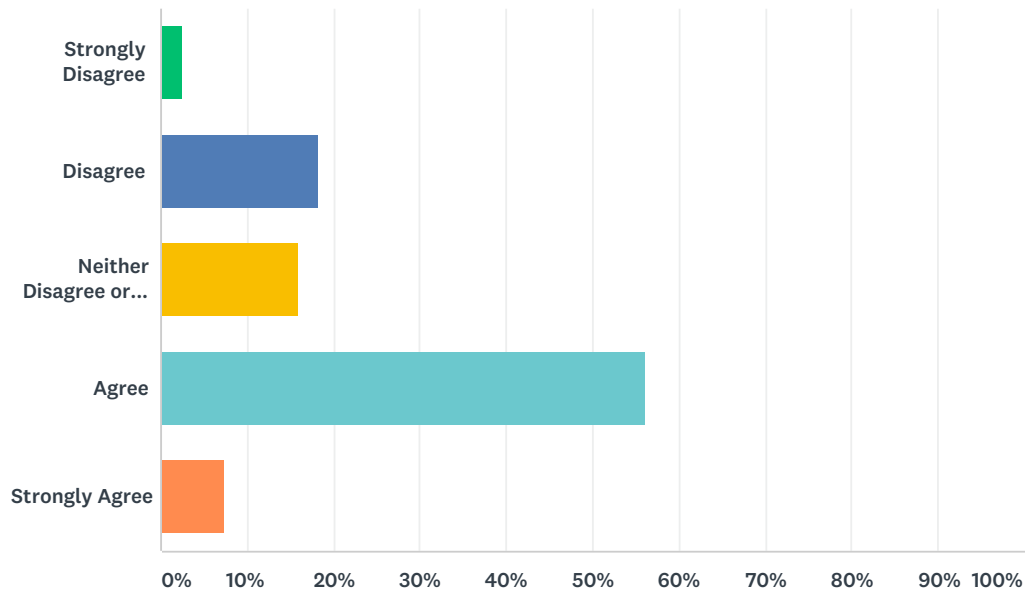

Q14 I find it easy to access toilet facilities.

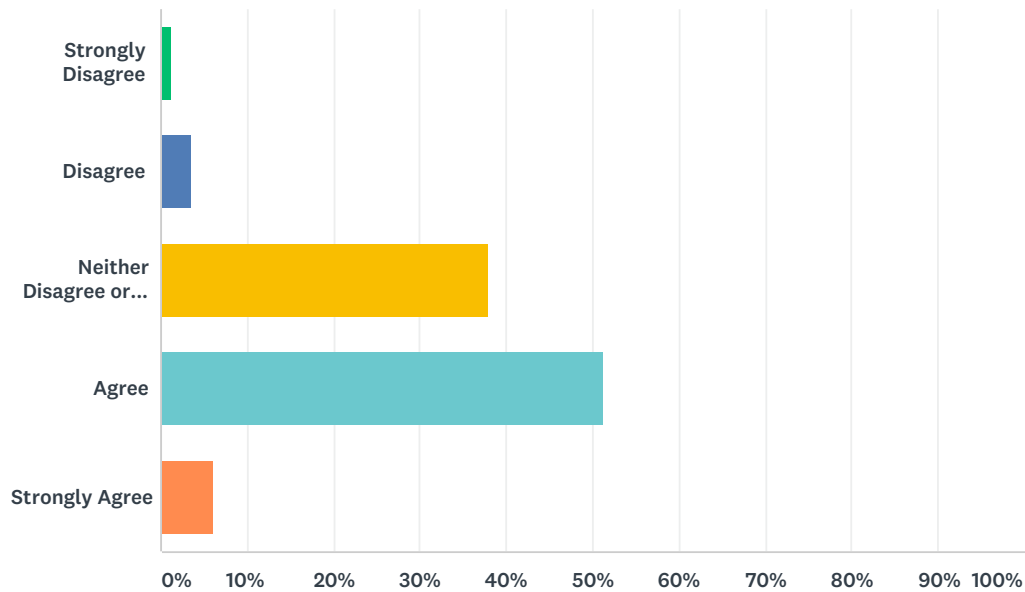

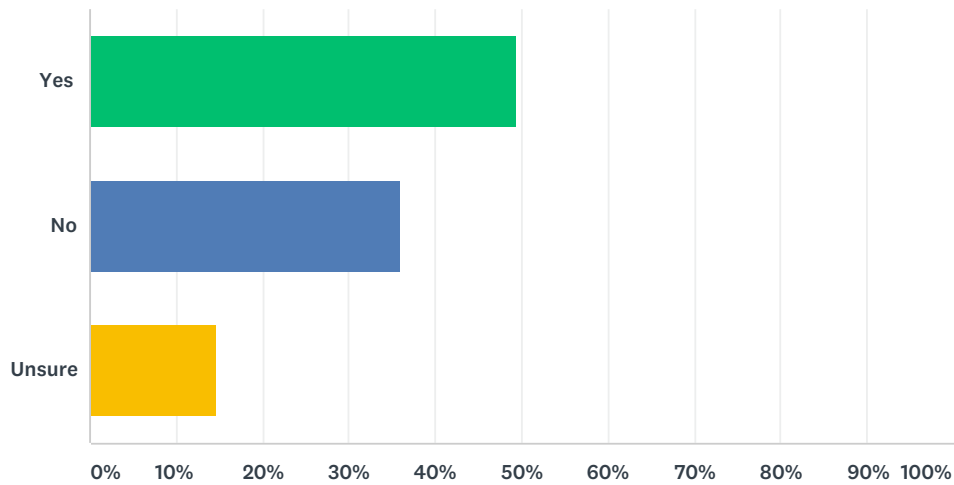
