The letter of the head officer of Wanju-Gun



Wanju-gun, Jeollabuk-do www.wanju.go.kr Dear World Health Organization,

I am Park Sung-il, governor of Wanju-gun, located in the center of Jeollabuk-do, where tradition and future are together.

Wanju-gun has a higher passion and strong will for "creating an age-friendly city" than anyone else to realize the value of "The best welfare for respect and love, health and happiness for older people" through the creation of an age-friendly city.

As of the end of May 2017, Wanju-gun entered the <code>super-aged</code> society with a ratio of older people aged 65 or over at 20%, and it is still making the following efforts as an increasing trend, judging that it is necessary to create an 'aged-friendly city'.

In order to create an age-friendly city, [the Ordinance on the Creation of an Aged-Friendly City in Wanju-gun] was

enacted, and the creation of an age-friendly city was stipulated as the responsibility of the county governor.

- 2. We emphasized the need to create an age-friendly city by continuously promoting education and public relations activities for local residents and civil servants.
- 3. We have established a public-private cooperation system centering on a special TF team to promote the creation of an elderly-friendly city and prepared to promote an elderly-friendly city in three dimensions.
- 4. The age-friendliness level in Wanju-gun was analyzed for older people aged 65 or over through a survey of the eight major areas of age-friendly cities.
- 5. As an action plan for an aged-friendly city, 69 projects were selected through 1) 3

meetings of the public-private expert TF team 2) 2 times of deliberation by the 'Age-friendly City Creation Committee', based on the eight major areas proposed by World Health Organization.

- 6. The composition of the core projects to realize the value of creating an age-friendly city of the WHO is as follows.
 - In order to realize the value of WHO's 'lively old age', it consists of the best welfare policy for respect and love, health and happiness.
 - 2) In order to realize the value of WHO's 'continuing to live in the community', it consists of the policy to create the best safe city for a safe and pleasant resident life.
 - 3) In order to realize the value of WHO's 'generational integration', it consists of

the policy to create an age-friendly environment that is good for all generations, including older people.

- 7. Wanju-gun plans to actively develop and promote action plans in which residents can feel satisfied with the project to create an age-friendly city in cooperation with the public and private sectors.
- 8. In addition, based on efforts to create an age-friendly city so far, Wanju-gun will join the 'WHO Global Network for Age-friendly Cities and Communities' to proactively respond to aging issues, share various information with the world's age-friendly cities, and actively exchange with the domestic age-friendly cities.
- 9. Wanju-gun promises to make efforts to create an age-friendly city where all generations of local residents, including older people, live well together through

the creation of an age-friendly city.

Wanju-gun applies for joining the WHO Global Network for Age-friendly Cities and Communities.
