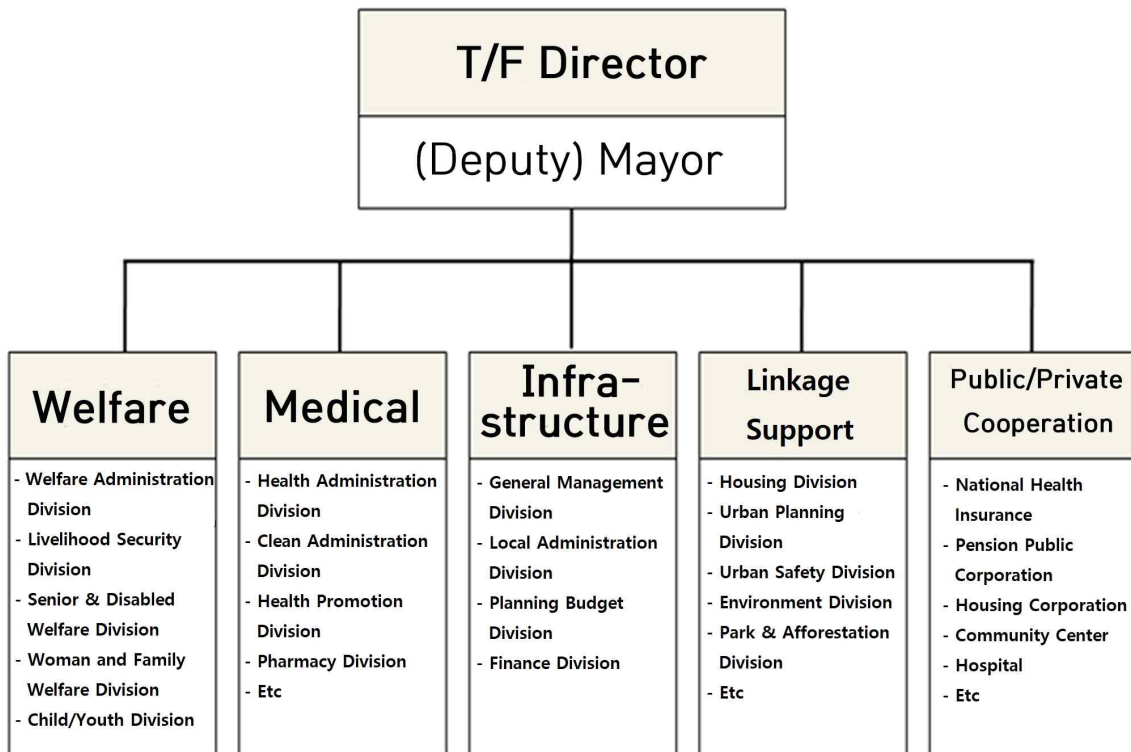


Action Plan for Age-Friendly City in Mapo-gu

1. Establishing a Private/Public Task Force team for Age-Friendly City

- In order to secure continuous interests and driving force to create a Mapo-type age-friendly city, to strengthen public-private cooperation and to establish cooperation system with individual departments, it is recommended to operate a representative conference body directly under the (Deputy) Mayor.

- Mapo-type age-friendly city creation T/F operation plan shall be established and regular meetings shall be held once a quarter and occasional meetings shall be held if necessary.
- In the long term, implementing a plan connected with community care(regional society integrated care) or "Mapo-gu dementia Community Care Network" should also be considered.

- The T/F team consists of 5 divisions; Welfare, Medical, Infrastructure, Linkage Support, and Public/private Cooperation.
 - The head of each department should be the head of T/F team for each five divisions. In case of private institutions, it should be decided after internal consultation.
 - The main role of public-private T/F team is to cooperate and set goals for the creation of an age-friendly city. Discussions to link resources from local community should also be conducted to create a sustainable age-friendly city.
