

■ The vision of 1st Suncheon-si age friendly city was “100-year-old life, Smart ecological city of Suncheon where aged life is happy and comfortable”

- The plan for the 1st age friendly city is based on an analysis of WHO’s 8 areas as well as a survey on the citizens
- 3 goals for the plan for the 1st age friendly city are ‘A pleasant and safe ecological city’, ‘An inclusive city of diversity’, ‘A healthy city of sharing and care.’ There are 50 projects in the plan as of 2024
 - Vision : 100-year-old life, Smart ecological city of Suncheon where aged life is happy and comfortable
 - Period : 2022 ~ 2024
 - Projects : 3 goals/3 strategies/8 areas/50 projects
- As of 2024, 23 departments are in charge of 50 projects
 - Senior welfare department oversees the greatest number of projects(12), followed by Health department(5)
