# 1 Vision and Strategy

## 1.1 Vision of Age-Friendly City Yesan-gun

- Based on the top eight WHO guidelines, opinions of Yesan-gun residents, and the Declaration of Age-Friendly City, the vision of age-friendly city Yesan-gun is set as a 「Lively and healthy age-friendly city Yesan」.
- According to the vision, the goal of promoting an age-friendly city in the future is to create a social participation city with happy after-retirement, a safe and pleasant environment, and to establish a communication foundation for confident participation.
- The guideline of the age-friendly city Yesan-gun consists of 3 major goals, which are active social participation, healthy and pleasant city, and inter-generational sympathy living together, and 8 major areas, and 50 detailed promotion tasks.

    - area 8 : social respect and integration

- Most of the entrances to senior citizen halls built before 2010 are terraced, which is inconvenient for the elderly. So it needs to be improved

- Improvement of environment and welfare through renovation of senior citizen hall slopes and safety handles

- Article 8 of the Act on the Guarantee of the Promotion of Convenience for the Disabled, the Elderly, and Pregnant Women (Standards for the Installation of Convenience Facilities)

- budget : 200 million Won(local expense 100%)
- major contents : The senior citizen halls with terraced entrance are to be equipped with ramps and safety handles to provide convenience to enter and exit such as push-carts (walkers)
