

Chapter 5 Planning for the Creation of an Age–Friendly City in Cheongyang–gun

Section 1 Vision and Strategic Objectives

- ☐ The vision of Cheongyang-gun's 8th elected administration is 'Creating Cheongyang together, for a happy future together'. The five major goals that the administration wants to attain are the following:
 - Rural areas that farmers can be proud of;
 - Strong regional economy;
 - Warm community of hope;
 - An attractive city that must be visited; and
 - Participation in an administration where citizens are partners.
 - O Among the five major pledge areas, the goal for health and welfare is 'to achieve the best condition in health and create a 100-year welfare model.' This shows that continuous efforts are being made to create elderly-friendly conditions.

 \Box In this study, the vision and goals for creating an age-friendly city are set as follows.

- Among the goals of the 8th elected administration, 'Everyone Creating Together' means that all generations communicate, integrate, and unite with each other, so it is set as "Building Happiness Together: 100-year old Cheongyang" to create a 100-year-old city Cheongyang by generational integration.
- O The four strategic goals consist of:
- Creating a physical environment for a pleasant retirement;
- Creating a cultural and economic environment for an active retirement;
- Creating a social environment where everyone can get along; and
- Supporting health services for a healthy retirement.

- O Matching the 8 areas presented by WHO with the 4 strategic goals would be the following:
 - Creating a physical environment for a pleasant retirement: outdoor spaces and buildings, transportation, housing
 - Creating a cultural and economic environment for an active retirement: civic participation, employment, and social participation
 - Creating a social environment where everyone gets along: communication and information, respect and social inclusion
 - Supporting health services for a healthy retirement: community support and health services.

 - These buses will pass through Cheongyang-gun Health and Medical Center 1-2 times a day, depending on route.

- \Box Project details
 - In response to the needs of village residents in areas where rural buses in Cheongyang-gun are not operated, this project will provide a demand-responsive transportation service that operates at public health centers, markets, administrative agencies, intercity bus terminals, etc.
 - Villages subject to operation : A village designated by the Cheongyang-gun governor as a public transportation-excluded area with more than 5 households and the distance from the bus stop to the village center or household dense area (if there is no community center) is more than 800m.
 - Number of operations: 10 times per month per household
 - Fee per user: KRW 1,500

- □ Background : As a result of analysis of public transportation accessibility for 114 villages in the 2021 Community Security Survey, 80 villages (70.2%) had inconvenient transportation and 17 villages (14.9%) had no transportation. Thus indicating that transportation environment needs to be improved.
- □ Purpose : To establish a medical and market-type circulation bus operation system to facilitate local residents' basic living maintenance activities such as health care services and market visits, as the elderly needs tight policy support for movement or going out.

- Deroject target: 9 myeon in Cheongyang-gun
- □ Project details
 - Operation of a medical and market-type circulation bus with the following route: Bae-hu village myeon location public health branch. This aims to improve the transportation convenience of those who are vulnerable and to improve the medical care and welfare of residents.

 - Provide traffic safety education to seniors through on-site educational programs and two-way education through communication through questions and answers about related topics.
 - Viewing of traffic safety campaign video.
 - Understanding the 3 principles of crossing defense walking (stand, look, walk)
 - Explaining the Chamanson (Raise your hand to communicate when you encounter a car)
 - Awareness of safety precautions, such as wearing bright clothes at night, etc.

- Project target: Cheongyang-gun residents aged 65 or older (9 locations including 3 self-catering locations and 6 lodging locations)
- □ Project details
 - Support for seniors living alone in using idle spaces such as senior centers, community halls for communal cooking and lodging with their homes at the center
 - ✤ Co-residential facility registration criteria
 - The area must be an area with facilities to accommodate at least 5 elderly people living alone who wish to reside there.
 - It must be an area with common facilities such as a senior center and village hall.
 - It must be a remote area with difficult transportation and far from administrative offices or medical facilities.
 - It must be an area recognized as necessary for the protection of seniors living alone.
 - Range of support
 - Minimum facility renovation and supplementation costs required for co-residence
 - Electricity and various utility bills
 - Minimum expenses required for operation, such as heating and cooling costs, fuel costs, grocery costs, insurance premiums, etc.
 - Program operation costs required for leisure activities for seniors living alone
 - Expenses deemed necessary for operation and activation

- □ This project aims to provide support in giving opportunities to the elderly so that they may participate in social and economic activities, which can lead them to live a comfortable retirement in a super-aging society.
 - According to Article 23 of the ^rElderly Welfare Act₁ (Support for Senior Citizens' Participation in Society), in order to expand the elderly's participation in society, the national or local governments must expand opportunities for local volunteer activities for the elderly and develop and disseminate occupations suitable for the elderly. Efforts must be made to provide work opportunities to seniors with work ability as a priority.
 - According to Article 11 (Employment and Income Guarantee) 1 of the Framework Act on Low Birth Rate and Aging Society, the national and local governments must create an environment in which elderly people, who are willing and capable, can work as much as possible.

Implementation plans

- □ Project period: 2024 onwards
- Der Project target: Cheongyang-gun residents aged 65 or older
- □ Project details
 - Project contents are largely divided into public type(public interest activities), social service type, and private type(market type project group, job placement type, senior internship, age-friendly company).




