### Age-friendliness Level Survey Overview

#### 1. Design of age-friendliness level survey

The purpose of age-friendliness level survey is to identify the living conditions of the elderly, diagnose the community environment surrounding the elderly through the indicators of 8 major areas for creating an age-friendly city of WHO, and use them as basic data for creating an age-friendly city and establishing a basic plan based on the results.

#### 2. Subject of survey

 830 senior citizens aged 65 or over livng in Buk-gu district, Gwangju Metropolitan City

#### 3. Method of survey and analysis

- The survey was conducted from June 5, 2023 to July 4, 2023.
- The entire response data of the collected questionnaire was verified, and the questionnaire with poor response content was excluded from the final analysis. The results of age-friendliness level survey were analyzed excluding data from survey subjects with poor responses.
- Of the total 830 questionnaires collected, 806 copies were confirmed and analyzed as the final valid sample, excluding 24 questionnaires that were inappropriate for use due to unfaithful responses and omission of response items.
- The data analysis used the SPSS 22.0 program to determine the age-friendliness level through frequency analysis and average of responses to each question in the age-friendliness level evaluation questionnaire.
