As a result of examining the overall perception of Guri City, "welfare facilities are close by, so they can be easily used," "The opportunity to receive regular health care (health checkups, vaccinations, etc.) is being provided," and "The driver makes concessions for pedestrians to pass safely at intersections or crosswalks."
