With the rapid trend toward an aging society today, Guri City is an aged society with 16.3% of the population aged 65 or older as of the end of September 2023, and a super-aged society is expected to be 27% of the population in 2025.

We have promoted many welfare policies to respond to aging-related needs and preferences. Now, we are striving to further meet the needs of our senior citizens and to promote healthy and active aging and a good quality of life for our senior citizens.
