# An action plan to make age-friendly city in Daejeon

- 1) Vision, goals and strategies
- O The vision for Daejeon City as an age-friendly city is to "Build a premier age-friendly city together with everyone" reflecting the meaning of citizens of all generations coming together to build an age-friendly city.
- O Based on the vision, the plan of Daejeon City's Age-Friendly City initiative have been established with 4 main goals and 12 strategies and 60 projects, aligned with the 8 areas defined by the World Health Organization (WHO).
- O The first goal, "Comfortable Living Environment," includes 12 projects under three strategies: "Promotion of housing convenience" "Safe housing environment," and "Convenient outdoor space." The first goal is related to the housing, outdoor spaces and buildings among the 8 areas.
- O The second goal, "Facilitate movement and communication," includes 14 projects under three strategies: "Enhancing convenience of movement" "Safe transportation," and "Enhancing communication." The second goal is related to the transportation, Communication and information among the 8 areas.
- O The third goal, "A City where everyone comes together," includes 21 projects under three strategies: "The community of mutual respect" "Everyone's local community," and "Optimized jobs and volunteerism." The third goal is related to the Respectd social inclusion, Social participation, Civic engagement and employment among the 8 areas.
- O The forth goal, "A vibrant community," includes 13 projects under three strategies: "Enhancing infrastructure in community" "Support for the socially disadvantaged," and "Enhancing community care." The forth goal is related to the Community support and health services among the 8 areas.
- O The above contents are schematized as shown in the table below:

#### 3 Residential convenience services

# Support for common facilities

- Support for improvement costs of common facilities in aging common homes(flat)
- Installation and maintenance of facilities such as children's playgrounds, community centers, and small libraries

# (5) Improvement for Senior Safety Zones

- Installation of road safety facilities within Senior Safety Zones
- Safety signage, speed bumps, guardrails, road markings, etc.
- Project target: Senior Safety Zones in Daejeon
- Assessment indicator: Number of completed improvement cases

### 6 Safety Zone maintenance

- Maintenance, including installation of traffic signal in Safety Zone(Children and Senior)
- Installation of unmanned traffic enforcement devices and signals
- Project target : Safety Zones in Daejeon

### 7 Streetlight brightness improvement

- Replacement and improvement of streetlights for enhanced illumination in roads with widths of 20m or more

- Project target: Roads with widths of 20m or more in Daejeon

#### 8 Safe pedestrian environments

- Creating pedestrian—friendly environments
- Prioritizing consideration for vulnerable road users, Elimination of pedestrian hazards etc.

- Assessment indicator: The length of maintained pedestrian paths(m)

### 9 Project for public toilet

- Improvement of aging public toilet
- Installation of emergency call buttons for crime prevention
- Project target : Public toilet in Daejeon
- Assessment indicator: Number of completed improvement cases

# Maintenance of bicycle paths

- Facilitating convenient and safe bicycle usage through the connection and maintenance of residential bicycle paths
- Project target : bicycle paths in Daejeon
- Assessment indicator: Length of improvement bicycle paths

# Darrier-Free walkways and urban forests

- Establishment of Barrier-Free walkways for pedestrian vulnerable groups (people with disabilities, elderly, pregnant Women, etc.)

- Free public transportation (Bus) support for citizens aged 70 and above
- Project target: Citizens aged 70 and above
- Assessment indicator: Monthly average number of users

# 2 Public taxi in Daejeon

- Taxi costs support for residents in transportation—disadvantaged areas in outskirt
- Project target: Citizen in transportation—disadvantaged areas
- Assessment indicators: Number of users

# 3 Transportation Assistance Center

- Ensuring mobility rights for transportation vulnerable groups
- Operation of special transportation services, provision of mobility support Information, and administrative assistance etc.
- Project target: Transportation vulnerable aged 65 and above
- Assessment indicators: Number of special transportation services users

#### 4 Daejeon Metro Line 2

- Expansion of urban subway network, Tram(Metro Line 2) construction for alleviating downtown traffic issues
- Project target : All citizens

- Safety education for vulnerable groups and training of Middle-aged and Elderly Safety Leaders

- Vulnerable groups : Under 13 years old, over 65 years old, disabled people, etc.
- Project target : All citizens
- Assessment indicators: Number of safety education/ Safety Leaders

# Disaster prevention promotion

- Creating and distributing promotional materials for citizen guidelines in the event of natural disasters such as typhoons, heatwaves, heavy snowfall, earthquakes, etc.
- Project target : All citizens
- Assessment indicators : Number of promotional materials production and distribution

# (3) Promotion of safety culture movement

- Promotion of safety culture for seasonal accident prevention
- Media promotion: local newspaper advertisements, featured banner ads, and planned coverage etc.
- Media promotion: billboards, subway, bus etc.
- Project target : All citizens
- Assessment indicators : Number of promotional materials production and distribution

#### 4 Public awareness on traffic administration

- Early establishment of New Regulations through promotion of major traffic management and change
- Media promotion: Promotion of Key Policies, such as new traffic policies

- Recording the life and achievements of senior artists
- Establishment of foundational data for local cultural and artistic history research
