1 Guideline of Gimje-city

1.1 Guideline derivation processy

- o To establish guidelines for creating an elderly-friendly city in Gimje City, guidelines were derived for each of eight areas through surveys, resident meetings, and expert advisory meetings.

1.2 Guidelines by area

1) area 1 : outdoor spaces and buildings

2 Vision and Strategy

2.1 Vision of age Friendly City Gimje-city

- o Based on the top eight WHO guidelines, opinions of Gimje-city residents, and the Declaration of Age-Friendly City, the vision of age-friendly city Gimje-city is set as a 「Gimje, a 100-year-old city where adults can live」.
- o According to the vision, the goal of promoting an age-friendly city in the future is to create a social participation city with happy after-retirement, a safe and convenient environment, and to establish a communication foundation for respect.
- o The guideline of the age-friendly city Gimje-city consists of 4 major goals, which are safe and convenient city, healthy and energetic city, senior job and volunteer work city, and respect and communicative city with the elderly and 8 major areas, and 40 detailed promotion tasks.

 - area 8 : communication and information

1) outdoor spaces and buildings(existing 3, new 1)

1-1 (existing) Crime prevention and streetlight and security light replacement and new construction projects

(agent in charge : Urban Department)

■ background and necessity

- o Elderly people are vulnerable to crime and have difficulty moving around, so safety accidents frequently occur.
- o In addition, when the lighting on streets and alleys is dark, the risk of crime and accidents increases, so it is necessary to install or replace crime prevention CCTV, street lights, and security lights.

■ performance goal

- o Securing a safety net for citizens, seniors, and drivers by installing CCTV for crime prevention
- o Strengthening street and alley safety by replacing old street lights and security lights.

■ project contents

- o Securing a social safety net
 - CCTV, street lights and security lights: Vulnerable crime prevention areas in 19 towns, villages and districts within Gimje City
 - Creation agency: Gimje City, Korea Electric Power Corporation, Korea Electrical Safety Corporation.

■ background and necessity

- o There are many areas with weak security in Gimje City, so there is a high risk of crime occurring.
- o In particular, it is necessary to install safety facilities in vulnerable areas to prevent crimes against the elderly, women, and children.

■ performance goal

- o Prevent crime in areas with weak security
- o Installation of safety facilities to protect the socially vulnerable
- o Relieve citizen anxiety and reduce social costs by creating bright streets

■ project contents

- o Business basis: Article 4 of the Framework Act on Disaster and Safety Management
- o Project target: Gimje-si jurisdiction
- o Business details: CCTV, security lights, projectors, etc. 1~2 per year

■ background and necessity

- o Due to recent climate change, the urban space of Gimje City is experiencing high temperatures even at night due to the heat island phenomenon caused by imbalance in atmospheric movement.
- o In addition, there is insufficient space to provide shelter for seniors who move during the day.

■ performance goal

- o Expansion of green rest areas in urban areas to improve urban ecological health and landscape
- o Create beautiful street-scapes and strengthen air pollution purification functions
- o Utilization of green rest areas and youth natural learning spaces for residents

■ project contents

- o Urban forest creation
 - Target area: Inside and around the city of Gimje-si
 - Composition: planting trees and installing convenience facilities

- o Improve quality of life by creating a clean living environment
- o Create an outdoor park atmosphere for citizens by providing a beautiful environment

■ project contents

- o Creating a green forest
 - Target location: Gimje City Library, near Baekgu-myeon Administrative Welfare Center
 - Construction contents: planting of trees and flowers, installation of rest facilities, etc.

▣ **background and necessity**

- o Gimje City is a combined urban-rural city, with rural areas occupying most of the administrative district and many narrow villages where bus service is difficult (narrow road width, small population).
- o Therefore, convenience of transportation is needed in areas vulnerable to public transportation.

▣ **performance goal**

- o Improving convenience for residents in transportation-vulnerable areas
- o Realization of transportation welfare in Gimje City by improving equity in public transportation services

▣ **project contents**

- o Business basis: Article 4 of the Passenger Transport Business Act
- o Project target: Gimje-si area
- o Project details: Introduction of 3 demand response (DRT) vehicles with a seating capacity of 15 or less

▣ **implementation plane(schedule)**

- o Therefore, it is necessary to provide services to public transportation vulnerable areas such as transportation remote areas.

■ performance goal

- o Promoting safety and convenience for the elderly in Gimje City in their daily living environment
- o Forming consensus on the need to create a safe and convenient environment for the elderly

■ project contents

- o Business basis: Article 4 of the Passenger Transport Business Act
- o Project target: Gimje-si area
- o Project details: Introduction of 3 demand response (DRT) vehicles with a seating capacity of 15 or less

- o Gimje City needs road maintenance and the opening of new pedestrian roads as the pedestrian roads are very curved and the opening rate is not high.
- o There is a need to secure the safety and convenience of pedestrians, including the elderly, through the maintenance of these pedestrian roads and the improvement of new pedestrian roads.

■ performance goal

- o Creation of pedestrian road environment in Gimje City
- o Securing pedestrian space by opening new pedestrian roads

■ project contents

- o Pedestrian road maintenance and new construction
 - Target: Unopened sections of pedestrian roads and existing pedestrian routes
 - . Number: 2 sections

3) residential environment(existing 4, new 0)

3-1 (existing) Slate processing support project for old houses

(agent in charge : Cleaning Resources Department)

▣ background and necessity

- o Gimje City is a mixed urban-rural city, and the houses were built very old, so their exterior appearance is not very good.
- o In addition, the roofing material is made of slate containing asbestos, a carcinogen, which can have a negative impact on the health of elderly people with weak immune function.

▣ performance goal

- o Replacement of asbestos slate, which is an environmental hazard (carcinogen)
- o Prevent damage to citizens' health and improve residential environments

▣ project contents

- o Business basis: Asbestos Safety Management Act, Slate Processing National Treasury Subsidy Business Processing Guidelines, etc.
- o Project target: slate buildings within Gimje City
- o Project details: Slate roof demolition and roof improvement
 - Demolition of 658 households per year

3-2 (existing) Residential environment improvement project for seniors living alone

(agent in charge : Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Department)

▣ **background and necessity**

- o Gimje City Senior Center is used as a meeting place for local residents during the day, but is used as a residence for some seniors living alone at night.
- o However, many elderly people living alone live in poor residential environments, so environmental improvements are needed.

▣ **performance goal**

- o Improving the poor residential environment of seniors living alone
- o Promoting convenient daily life by providing a comfortable living environment

▣ **project contents**

- o Basis for the project: Article 7 of the Gimje City Ordinance on the Promotion of Elderly Welfare
- o Project target: Self-owned senior citizens living alone
- o Support details: Support for home repair costs (roof repair, toilet repair, insulation and window replacement, kitchen construction, etc.)

▣ **implementation plane(schedule)**

3-3 (existing) Rural and fishing village disabled housing renovation project

(agent in charge : Agricultural Technology Center)

■ background and necessity

- o In the case of low-income disabled people, there are limits to additional expenditures other than living expenses due to lack of income-generating activities.
- o Support for convenience facilities is needed to improve the living and mobility of people with disabilities.

■ performance goal

- o Promote convenience of living and movement for low-income disabled people
- o Promoting safe daily life by installing residential convenience facilities

■ project contents

- o Basis for the project: Article 15 of the Act on Support for the Housing Disadvantaged, including the Disabled and the Elderly
- o Project target: Among those eligible for Article 2 of the Welfare of Persons with Disabilities Act, the monthly income of urban workers is below
- o Project details: Support for facilities for the disabled in houses (maximum KRW 3.8 million per unit)
 - Repair and installation of house entrances and ramps, remodeling of external toilets, internal facilities such as floors

■ background and necessity

- o The houses of the low-income class in Gimje City are old and in poor condition.
- o There is a need to improve the residential environment by installing convenience facilities and crime prevention facilities in target houses to support energy-saving green houses.

■ performance goal

- o Support for remodeling of old and defective houses of low-income people
- o Promote improvement of residential environment by supporting energy saving home renovation

■ project contents

- o Business basis: Article 18 of the Framework Act on Housing, Article 13 of the Lottery and Basic Lottery Act
- o Project target: low-income people such as basic livelihood recipients and the next-lowest class
- o Project details: within the range of 5 million won per unit (however, roof and bathroom are supported up to 7.5 million won)

4-1 (existing) Construction of a lifestyle-friendly national sports complex
 (agent in charge : Sports Promotion Department)

▣ background and necessity

- o Gimje City is unable to provide sufficient services for citizens’ health management activities due to a lack of public sports facilities for citizens.
- o There is a need to build a national sports complex on the site of an old youth training center swimming pool to meet the diverse sports needs of citizens, including the elderly.

▣ performance goal

- o Respond to citizens’ demand for sports by supplying public sports facilities for various sports
- o Promoting leisure and health promotion for citizens, including the elderly

▣ project contents

- o Construction of National Sports Complex Center
 - 1 floor underground and 2 floors above ground (total floor area(4,783 m²)
