WHY WE NEED AN INTERNATIONAL STRATEGIC DIALOGUE

In the Political declaration of the third high-level meeting of the General Assembly on the prevention and control of noncommunicable diseases (A/RES/73/2), governments committed to scale up efforts “as Heads of State and Government, to provide strategic leadership for the prevention and control of NCDs by promoting greater policy coherence and coordination through whole-of-government and health-in-all-policies approaches and by engaging stakeholders in an appropriate, coordinated, comprehensive and integrated, bold whole-of-society action and response”

THEMES TO BE EXPLORED

Championing the NCD agenda as Heads of State and Government
Implementing the most cost-effective and feasible NCD interventions as identified by WHO
Encouraging investment in adequate, predictable and sustained resourcing for NCDs
Integrating the NCD agenda within core health needs and emerging global health threats
Learning from our collaborating partners, including people living with NCDs

RAISE PRIORITY

Raise the priority of the prevention and control of NCDs in national SDG responses in low-and middle-income countries

ENGAGE

Unite actors and partners to exchange knowledge on how we achieve the SDG 3 targets, particularly SDGs 3.4 (NCDs) and 3.8 (UHC)

LEADERSHIP

Raise the political visibility of Heads of State playing a global leadership role in the prevention and control of NCDs
