|         | In 2006, Azerbaijan implemented Demographic and Health Survey (AzDHS). Data from this show that smoking is common among men aged 15-49, with about half of them reporting that they are smokers. Among current smokers, over 90 percent reported that they smoked 10 or more cigarettes during the past 24 hours. There is no significant difference in smoking patterns between urban and rural men. The likelihood that a man smokes increases with age. An interesting pattern is observed between smoking and the level of education. Smoking is less prevalent among males with higher and basic secondary education (about 41 percent), while men with a secondary specialized education smoke more frequently than other men (60 percent). |
|         | One of the objectives of the 2006 AzDHS was to provide population-based data on cardiovascular risk factors, e.g., hypertension and smoking, to complement data available from other sources. Hypertension is slightly higher among men who smoke than men who do not smoke (19 percent and 14 percent, respectively). According to the WHO, as many as 20 percent of all deaths among middle-aged men in Azerbaijan in the early 1990s were attributable to tobacco use (WHO, 1997; Peto et al., 1994).  |
