Some decline (up to 0.3%) in the trend in current smoking prevalence among men population was observed since submission of the last report. No new STEPS survey was conducted from the last reporting period. So the data from last report remains no change. As the prevalence was almost 100 times higher for men than for women, the possibility on underreporting among female cannot be excluded. Therefore, data in "FEMALES" and "TOTAL" need to be interpreted with caution.

On 21 December, 2017 the Decree of the Cabinet of Ministers of Azerbaijan Republic "On Approval of excise rates of goods involved in Excise Tax on the territory of the Republic of Azerbaijan" was amended. This decision came into force on 23 January, 2018. In 17 February, 2020, 5 April, 2021 and 14 March, 2022 the tax rates for imported tobacco products were raised totally up to 40% from previous rates. And excise rates on cigarettes and cigarillos (slim cigars) produced in Azerbaijan and imported cigarillos increased up to 90% in 2021-2022. In the middle 2021 the excise rates for some tobacco products were additional increased in Azerbaijan (on cigarillos - up to 40%; on liquid for electronic cigarettes - up to 5 times per litter), the novel excise has been set up for heated tobacco products (12.9 AZN per 1,000 pieces), and increased to 14 AZN per 1,000 pieces in January 2022, and for disposable electronic cigarettes, hookahs and their substitutes (0.25 AZN per pieces).</p>

For the same purpose, a unified state automated information system Track and Trace, an effective tool for alcohol and tobacco market regulation, is being created in Azerbaijan. The draft law will be prepared in order to regulate the circulation of excise goods and goods with mandatory labeling, as well as ensure tax control over the import, production, sale, and circulation of them. Upon adoption of the draft law, it's planned to create a 'Track and Trace' unified state automated information system, which allows controlling the circulation of said goods, along the entire chain from production and import to the end consumer. Azerbaijan intends to implement international legislation and apply modern mechanisms in the sphere of control over the turnover of excisable products. A number of amendments to the Tax Code, aimed at strengthening tax control over import, production, sale, and turnover of excisable goods are planned. Among other things, the new edition of the Tax Code provides for the formation of a unified state automated information system "Track and Trace" to control the turnover of tobacco products and alcoholic beverages in Azerbaijan. The first steps towards the creation of this mechanism were taken several years ago within the framework of the action plan approved by the head of the state on the improvement of the export-import operations control system. About a year ago the Main Department for Control over Circulation of Excise and Labeled Goods of the State Tax Service engaged TT Technologies Ltd for the development of hardware-software solutions and implementation of legal mechanisms of the Track and Trace system under the legislation of Azerbaijan. The new mechanism was recently submitted to the Parliament for discussion. The creation of a unified state automated information system is aimed to ensure effective control over the turnover of excisable and mandatory labelling of goods along the entire chain - from production and import to the end consumer.
