1. The Normative Instruction RFB nº 2.231/2024 aims to control the customs transit of goods passing through Brazil destined for neighboring countries, with the objective of preventing these goods from returning to Brazil in the form of smuggling. The regulation defines rules for the control and transit of goods in passage, establishing conditions for customs transit to be granted. The Federal Revenue Service seeks to prevent goods that enter Brazil for export to neighboring countries from being diverted and returning to the country illegally.
2. Normative Instruction RFB nº 2.229/2024 aims to suspend the CNPJ (National Registry of Legal Entities) of entities or branch establishments if the carrying out of activities of commercialization, exhibition, storage, safekeeping, or transportation of prohibited products is found, which represent a potential risk to public health, the environment, or safety, such as electronic cigarettes, vapes, smoking products, among others, especially during operations to combat smuggling, tax evasion, international drug trafficking, and money laundering, without prejudice to other applicable sanctions.

THESE UNIQUE CODES ARE REFERRED TO AS UNIQUE IDENTIFICATION MARKINGS (UIM). The information that is monitored is then made accessible to competent authorities, allowing them to recreate the route taken by the unit tobacco packaging.*
