The Rapid Response Team Essentials Online Learning Programme (RRT ELP) is geared to members of RRTs, RRT managers, RRT trainers and mentors.

Based on an all-hazard approach, the RRT Essentials Online Learning Programme aims to equip members of RRTs with the essential knowledge, skills and abilities (KSA) needed to early detect and provide an effective public health response to events. Besides, this programme introduces how to function effectively as an RRT member, perform a variety of tasks based on the nature of the emergency and contribute to the RRT to perform its mission.

The programme is composed of twelve short interactive modules of approximately 30 minutes duration each. Upon successful completion of each module, you will be able to download a Certificate of Completion.

This programme is a component of the Rapid Response Teams Training Implementation Package for Member States.

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## Introduction to the Emergency Response Framework

The **Emergency Response Framework (ERF)** was developed by WHO to provide its staff with essential guidance on how the Organization manages the **assessment, grading and response** to public health events and emergencies with health consequences, in support of Member States and affected communities.



While the ERF focuses primarily on acute events and emergencies, it also introduces WHO's new **grading process** for protracted emergencies.
