1. Did not need health care

Definition

The proportion of respondents who reported that they did not need health care.

Numerator : Number of respondents who reported that they did not have health problem or did not need health care.

Denominator : All respondents

2. Met health care need

Definition

The proportion of respondents who reported that their need for health care was met.

Numerator : Number of respondents who reported that their demand for health care service(s) (including medical visit, dental care, mental health care, prescription/medication, examination, and surgical care) was met.

Denominator : Number of respondents with health care needs

3. Unmet health care need

Definition

The proportion of respondents who reported that they needed health care but did not receive it.

Numerator : Number of respondents who reported that they needed health care service(s) (including medical visit, dental care, mental health care, prescription/medication, examination, and surgical care) but did not receive it.

Denominator : Number of respondents with health care needs.

Definition

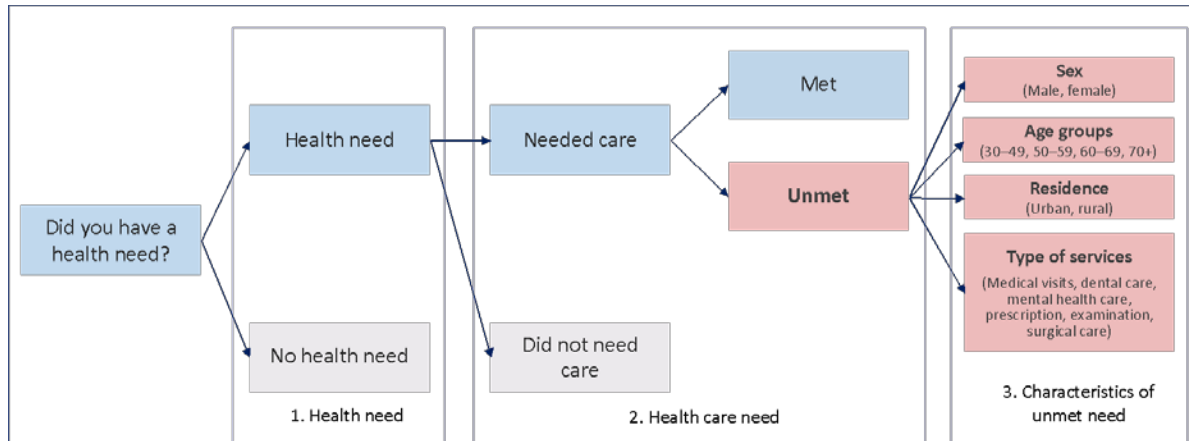

Coverage: Respondents with health care need (irrespective of age – 16+)

- Prevalence (%) with health care needs refers to respondents who met all the needed health care service(s).
- Prevalence (%) with unmet health care needs those who indicated they needed health care services(s), but did not receive one or more services.

ii. Table B: Unmet need by selected respondent characteristics, by country.

Coverage: Respondents aged ≥ 30 years with health care need.

- Prevalence (%) of unmet health care need among respondents with specific characteristics (sex (male, female); age groups (30–49 years, 50–59 years, 60–69 years, 70+ years); residence (urban, rural)).
