

# Algeria

## 2011 Fact Sheet

The **2011 Algeria GSHS** measured dietary behaviours; drug use; hygiene; physical activity; tobacco use; and violence and unintentional injury.

The 2011 Algeria GSHS was a school-based survey of students in grades 2<sup>nd</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup>. A two-stage cluster sample design was used to produce data representative of all students in grades 2<sup>nd</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> in Algeria. At the first stage, schools were selected with probability proportional to enrollment size. At the second stage, classes were randomly selected and all students in selected classes were eligible to participate. The school response rate was 100%, the student response rate was 98%, and the overall response rate was 98%. A total of 4532 students participated in the Algeria GSHS. Students self-reported their responses to each question on a computer scannable answer sheet. For comparison purposes, only students aged 13- 15 years are included in the analyses for this fact sheet.
