2009 Fact Sheet



The **2009 Anguilla GSHS** measured alcohol use; dietary behaviours; mental health; sexual behaviours; tobacco use; and violence and unintentional injury.

The 2009 Anguilla GSHS was a school-based survey of students in grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6. A census was used to produce data representative of all students in grades 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6 in Anguilla. The school response rate was 100%, the student response rate was 84%, and the overall response rate was 84%. A total of 951 students participated in the Anguilla GSHS. Students self-reported their responses to each question on a computer scannable answer sheet. For comparison purposes, only students aged 13- 15 years are included in the analyses for this fact sheet.
