### CORE and EXPANDED: Cervical cancer (expanded questions are shaded)

The following topics refer to cervical cancer prevention. Cervical cancer screening is carried out with the help of Pap-test/ cytologic analysis/swab. To carry out Pap-test/ cytologic analysis/swab a physician or a nurse wipe vagina with a tampon, by this taking a cervical smear, and send it to a laboratory. It's possible that you were offered to take a smear from vagina yourself. The laboratory examines the presence of atypical cellular changes.
