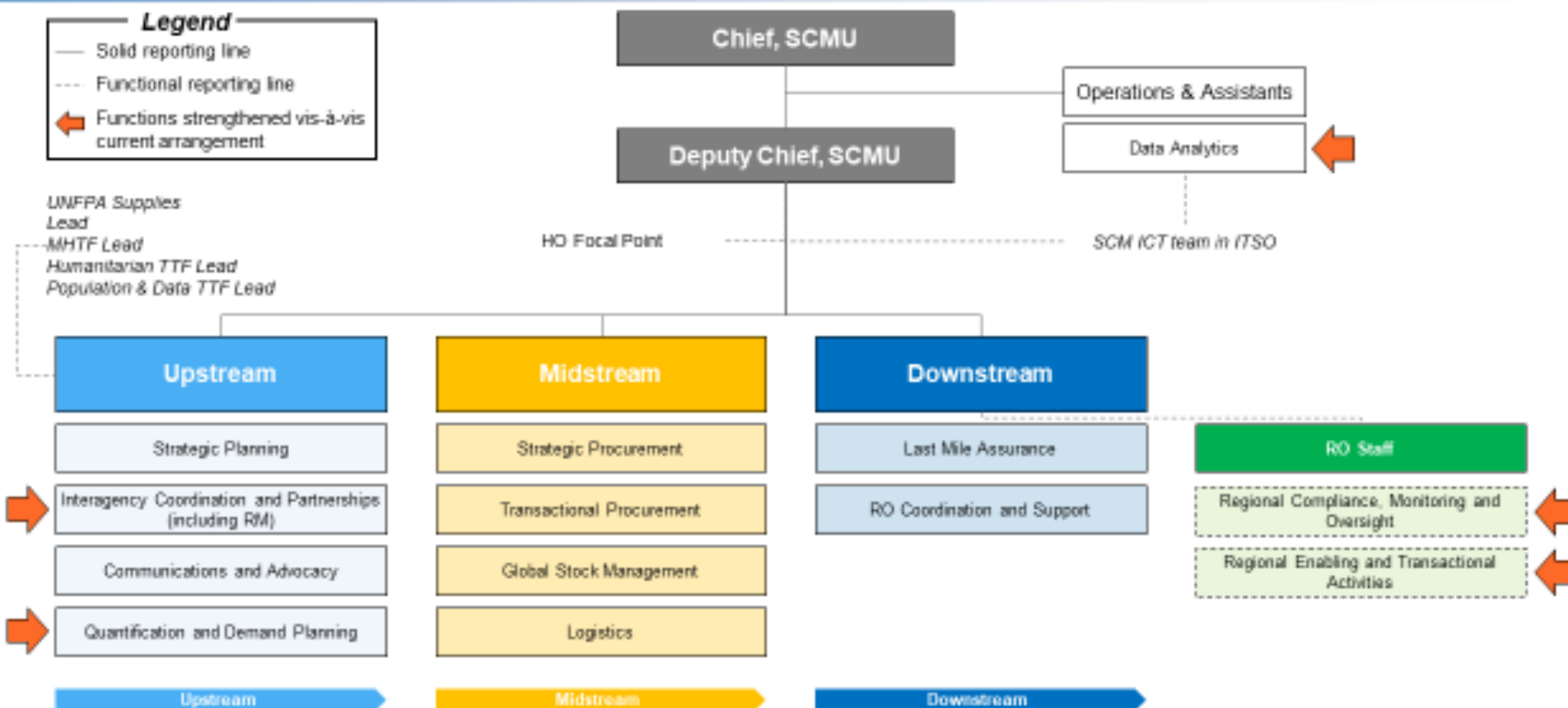


The Big 3

- **Strategic direction and Guidance:** (Framework / Enabling environment) Core corporate policies, procedures and guidelines; Tools and technical support; Preparedness; Strategic partnerships
- **Transactional functions:** Forecast, supply and demand planning; Procurement and contracting; Global stockpiling management; Quality assurance; International logistics; Advisory services to COs and ROs.
- **Field monitoring and oversight:** Compliance (policies, standards); Internal control across all layers (incl. IPs); Risk monitoring and mitigations

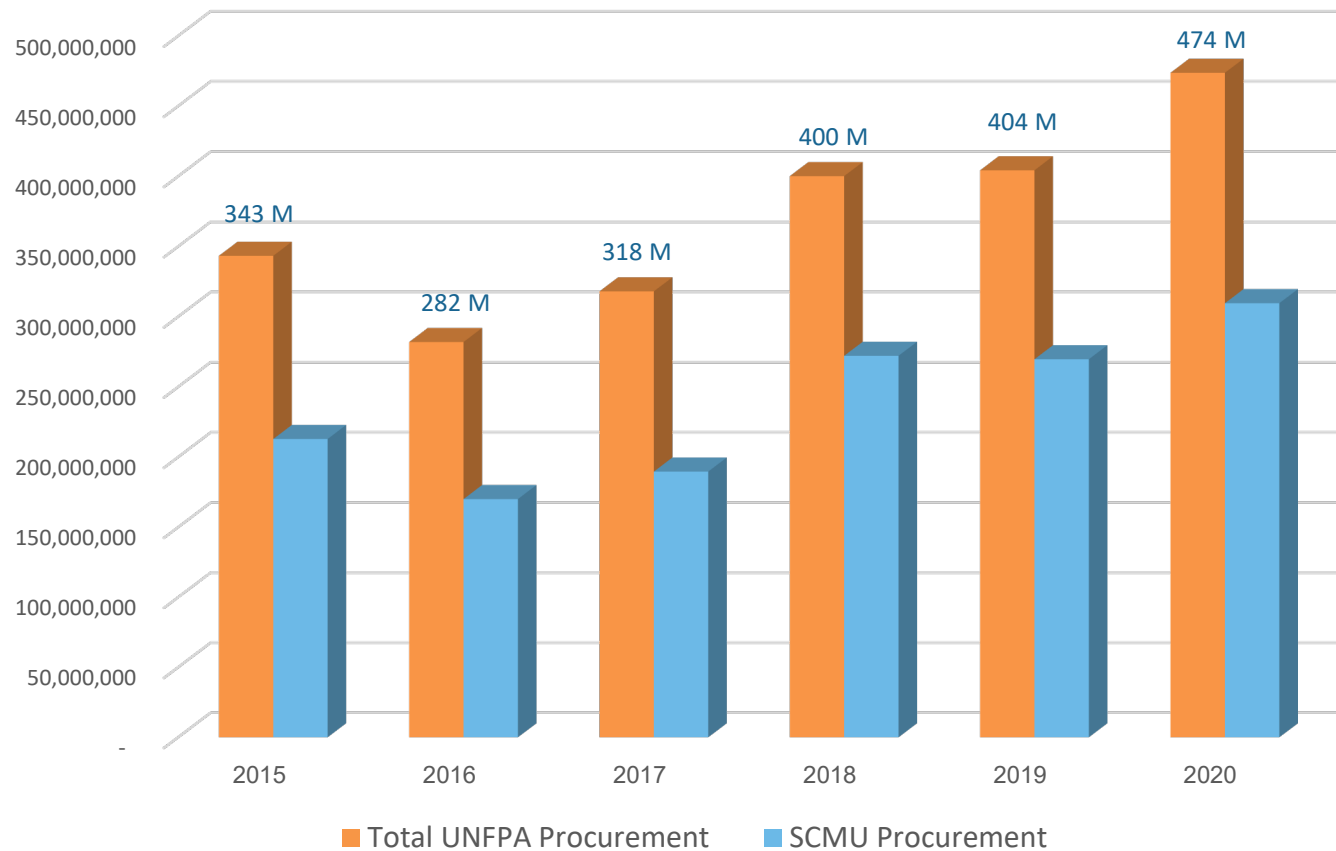

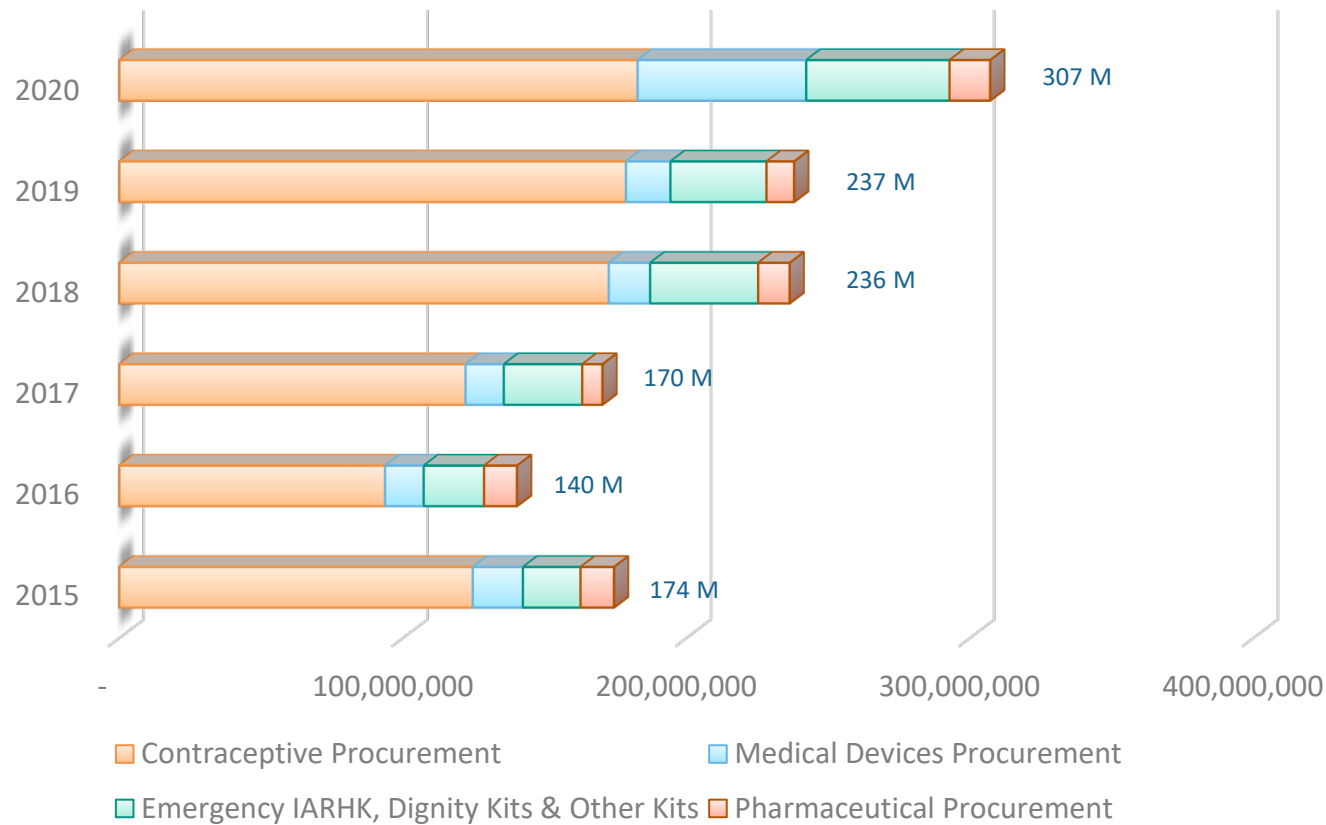


Total UNFPA Procurement vs SCMU Procurement

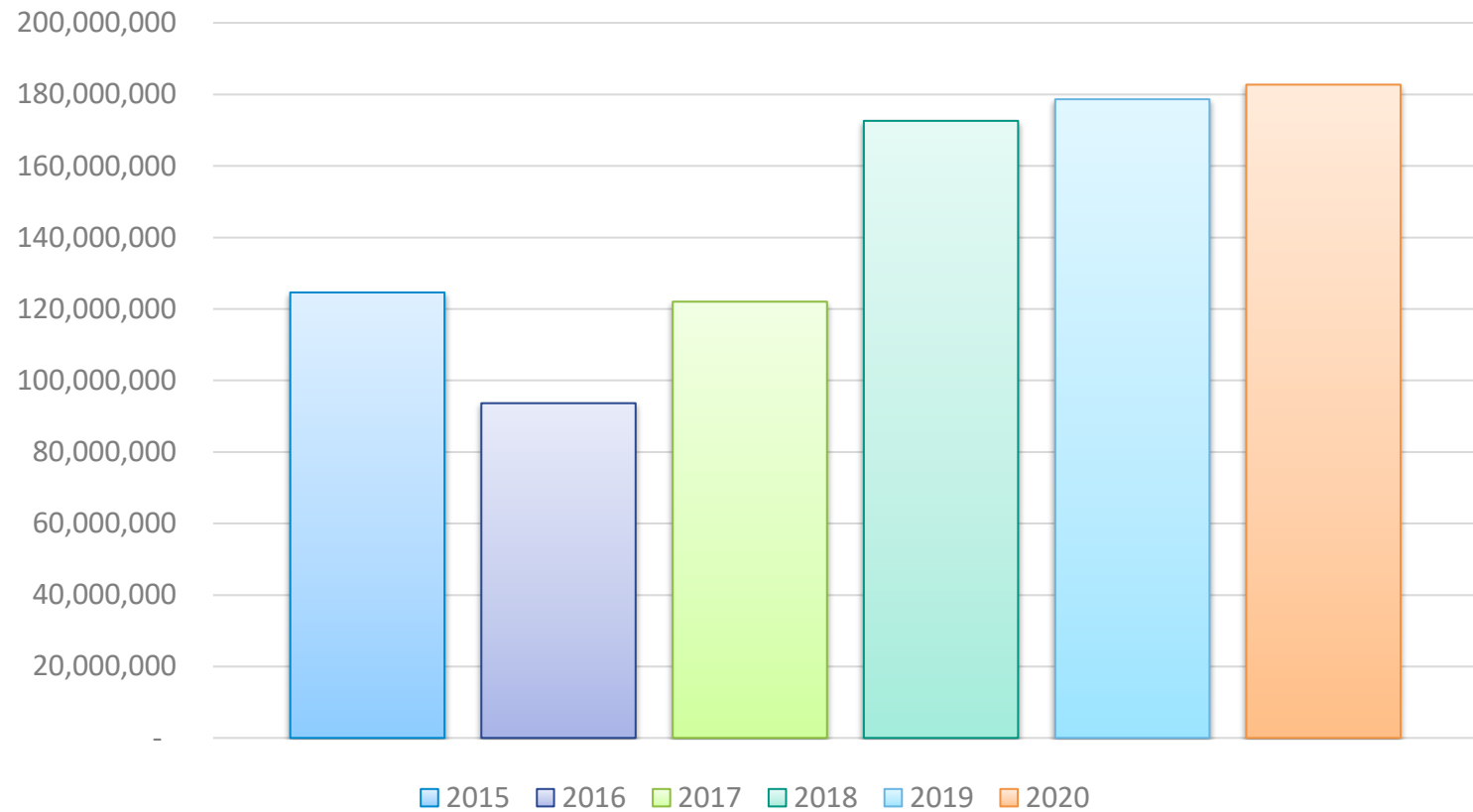




SCMU Procurement Expenditure in USD: 2015-2020

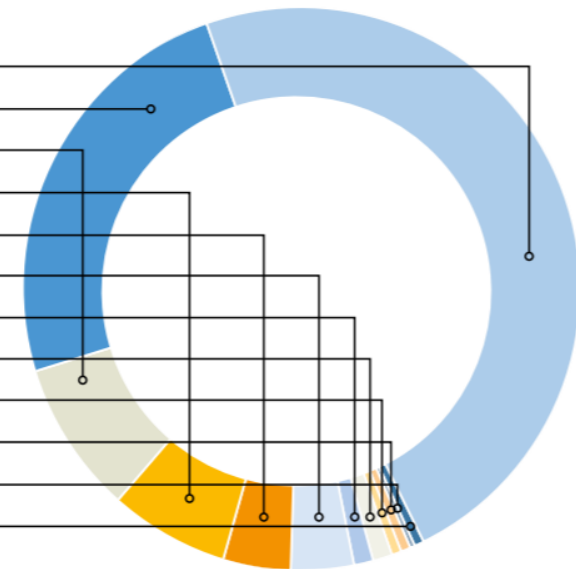

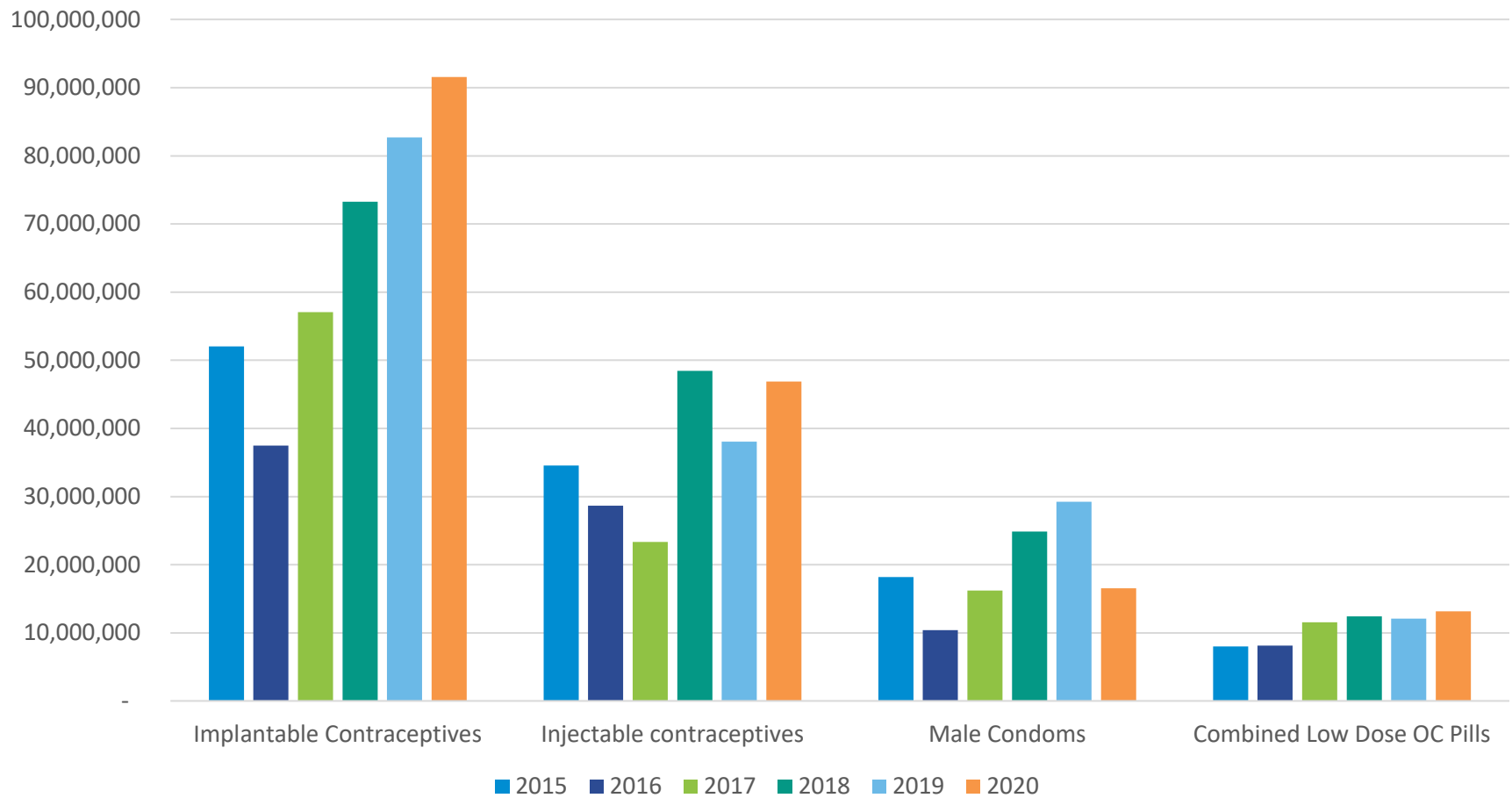

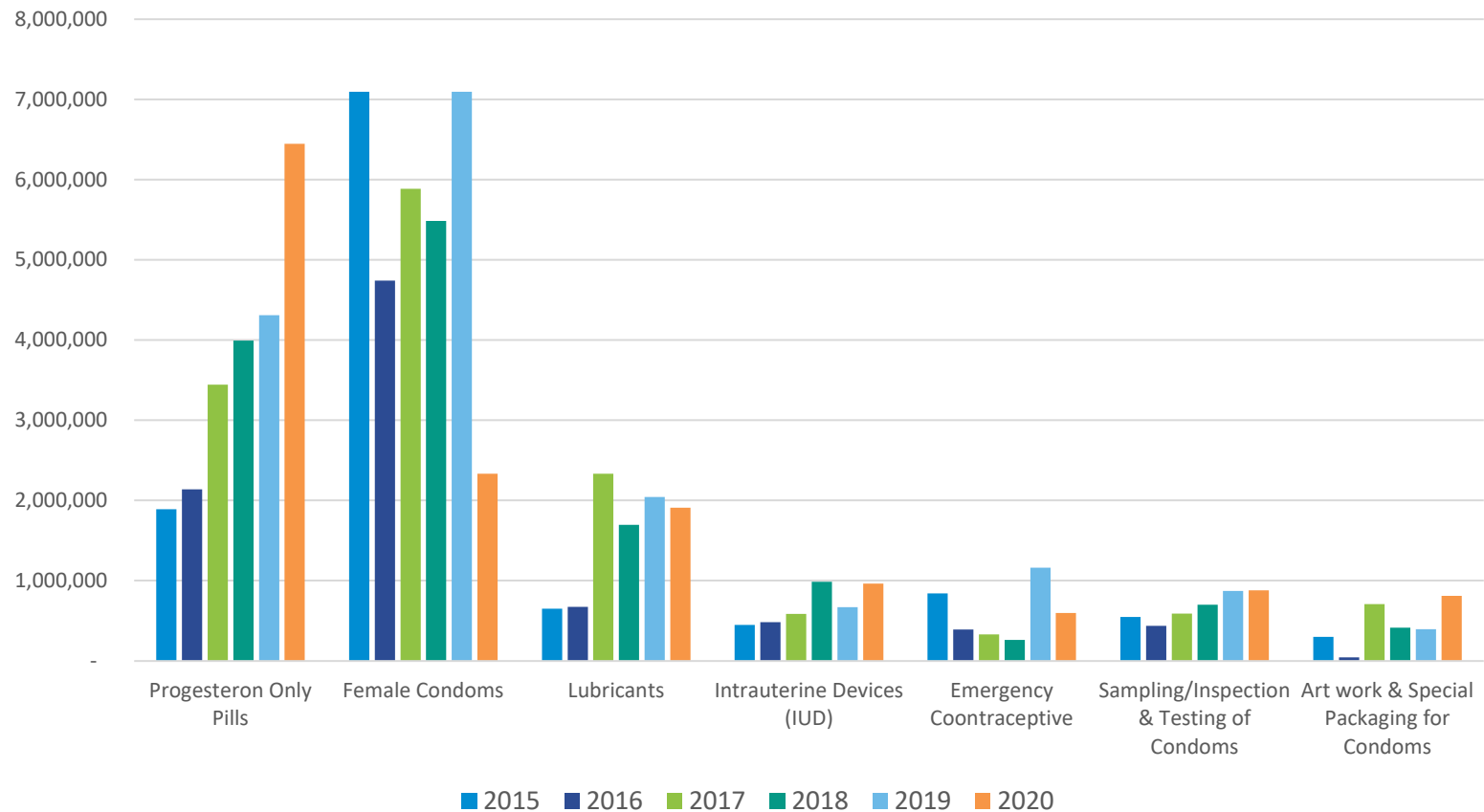

Contraceptives Breakdown: 2015 - 2020



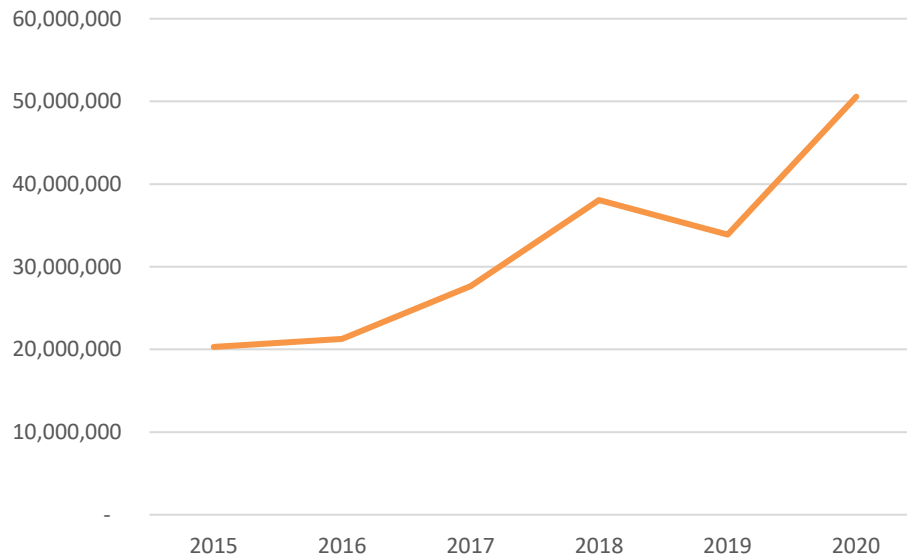
Contraceptives Breakdown: 2015 – 2020

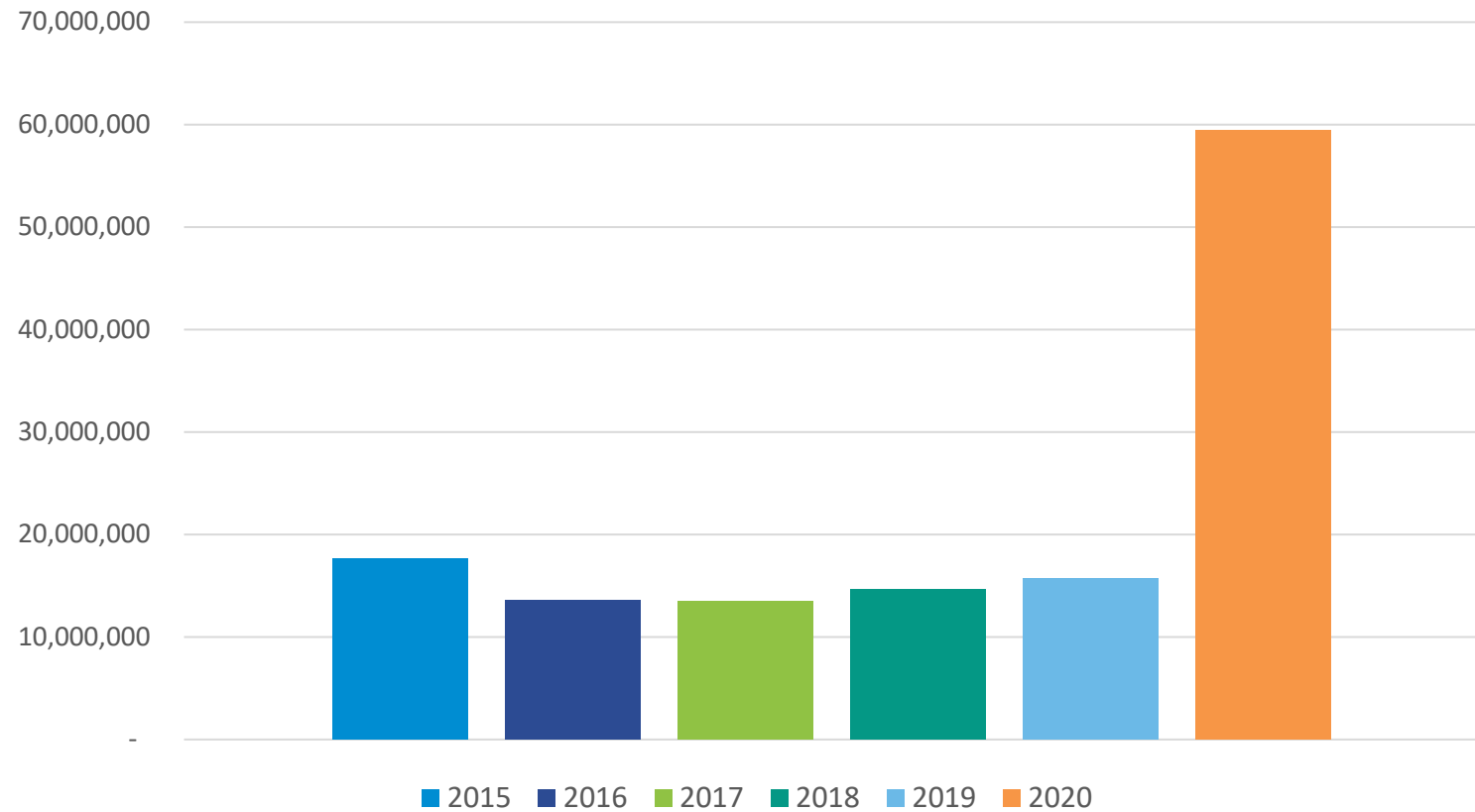
Expenditure in USD: 2015 - 2020



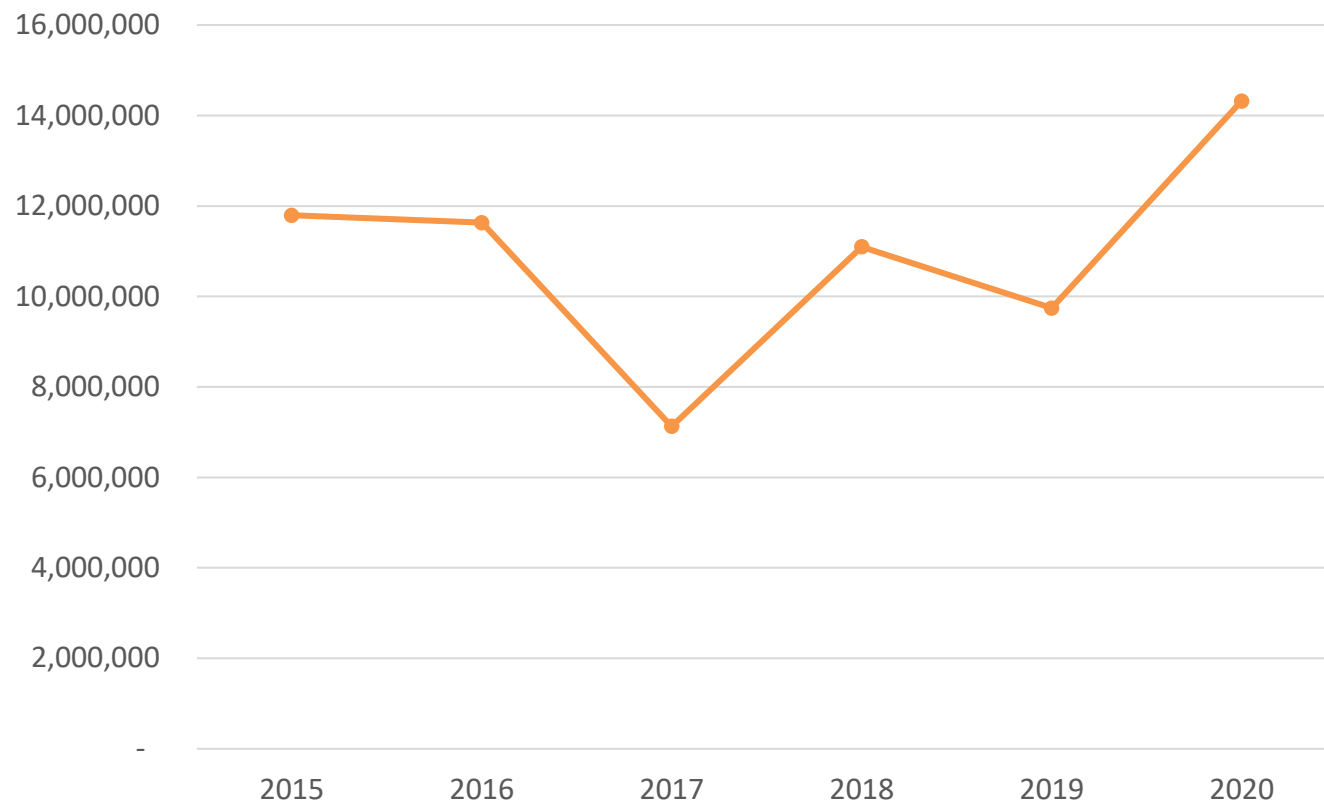
