- Local Fund Agents in each country monitor the implementation of grants.
- The Global Fund's Office of the Inspector General conducts audits and investigations.
- The Secretariat reports information to the Global Fund Board and the wider public.



Where the Programs Are

Global Fund invests in more than 100 countries worldwide. Approximately 74% of disbursements currently go to countries in sub-Saharan Africa, where HIV and malaria are most graphically concentrated.

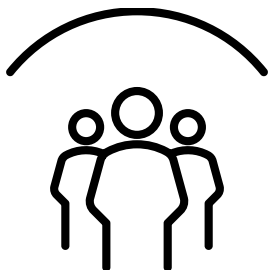

In countries where the Global Fund invests, AIDS-related deaths have been **reduced by 72%** since 2002.

24.5 million people were on lifesaving antiretroviral therapy in countries where the Global Fund invests in 2022, up from **17.5** million in 2017.



1.5 million People exposed to TB received preventive therapy in 2022.

TB treatment coverage increased from 44% in 2010 to **59%** in 2021, and the TB treatment success rate reached 86% in 2020.

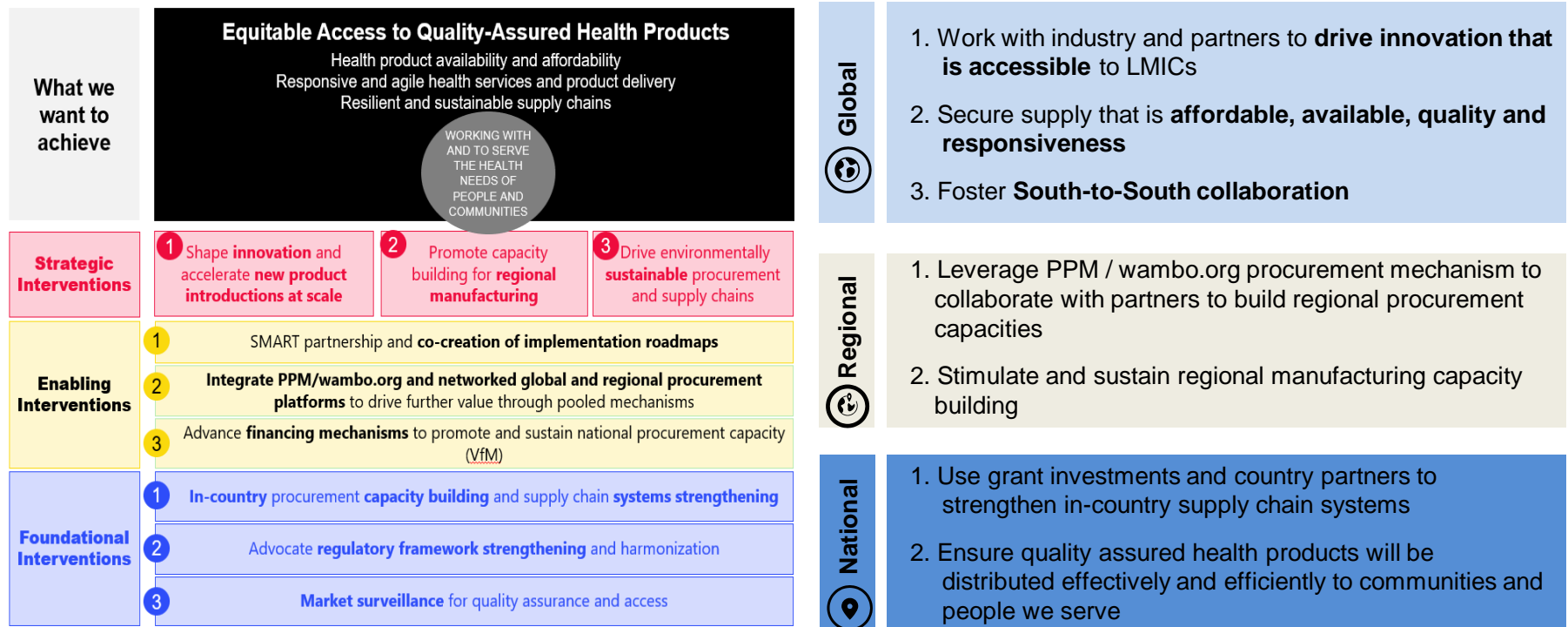


321 million **suspected cases** of malaria were tested in 2022.

165 million cases of malaria were **treated** in 2022.

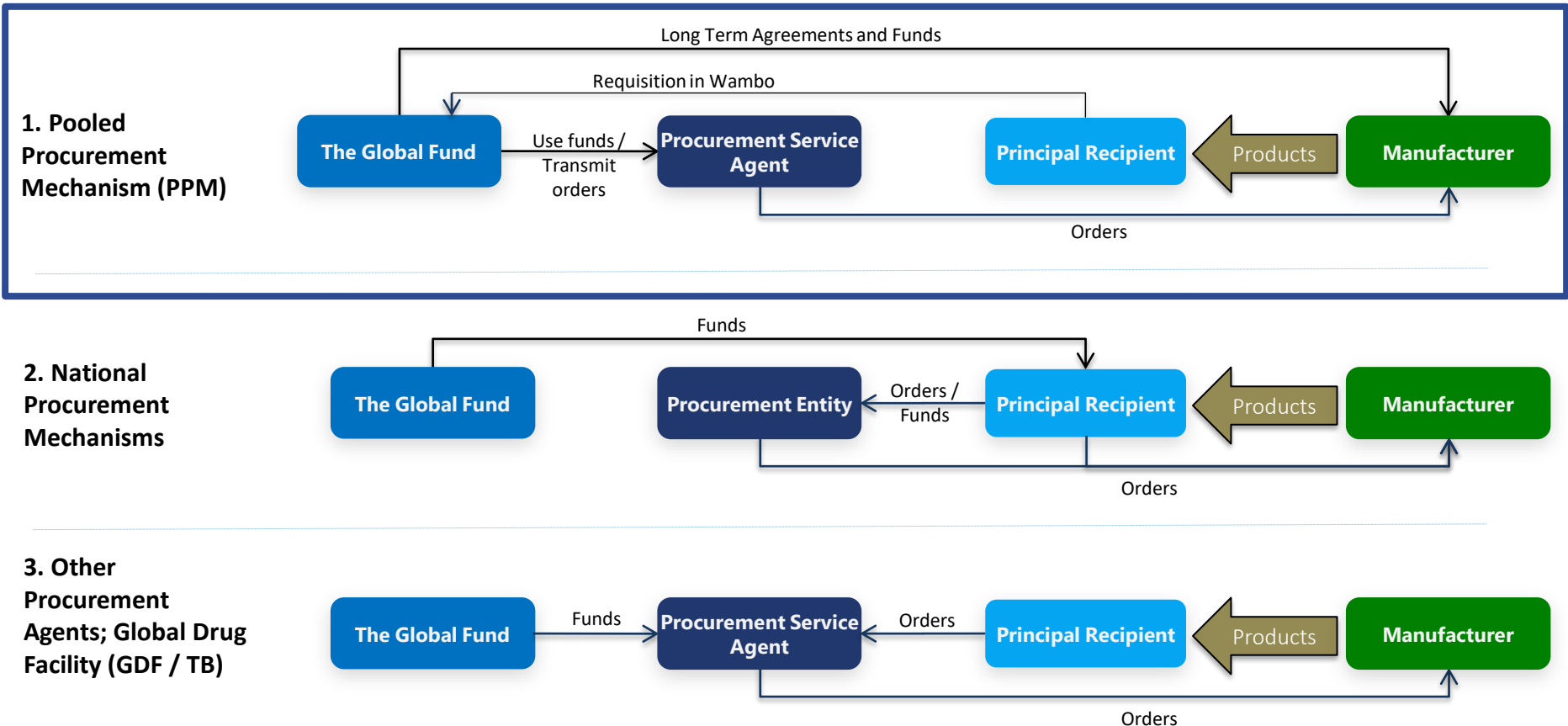
In 2022, **220 million** mosquito nets distributed to protect families from malaria – a 17% increase compared to 2019 despite COVID-19.

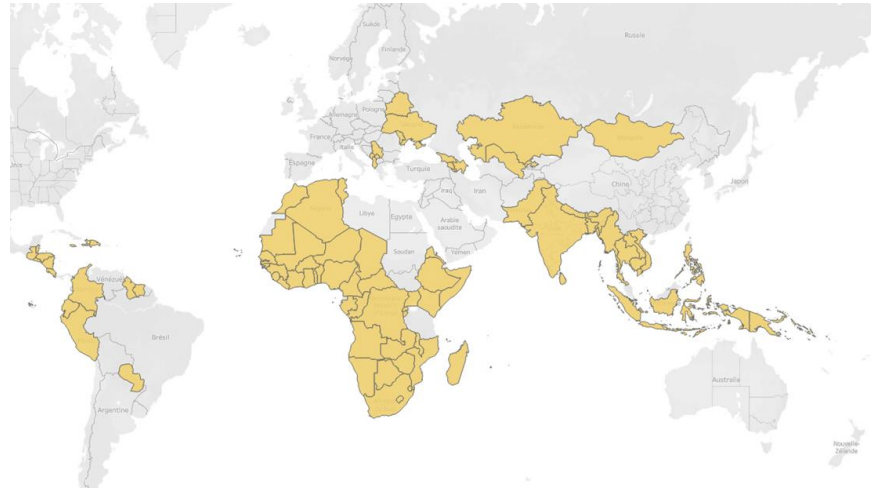
NextGen Market Shaping Approach to support Global Fund Strategy



Procurement Channels and Routes to Market

There are a number of procurement channels - with the Pooled Procurement Mechanism (PPM) representing around 60% total Global Fund health product spend



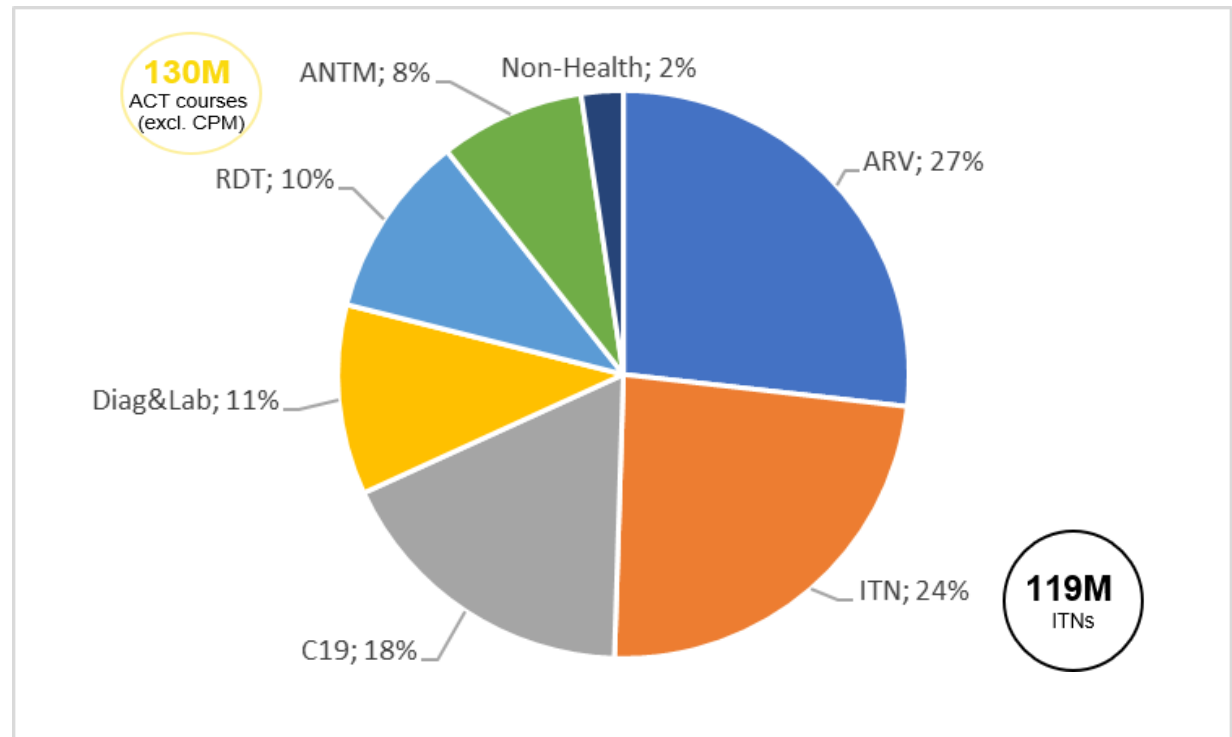


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Overview PPM: USD 1.75 bn orders placed in 2022 through PPM/Wambo

PPM operates at a significant scale – largest LMIC buyer in many HIV and Malaria categories

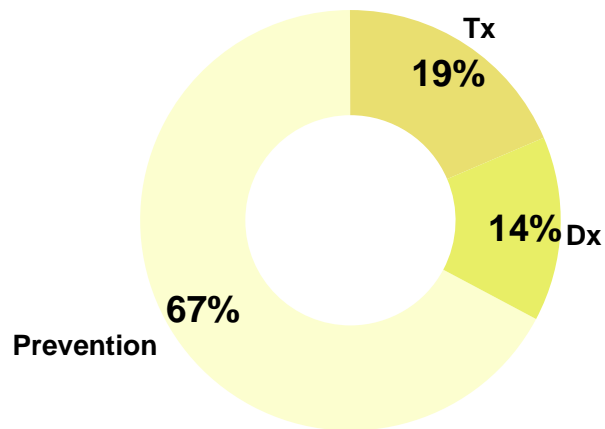
- In 2022, PPM processed 1,611 Purchase Orders **\$1.75 bn** to more than 80 countries in all continents
- Largest category **ARVs** – enough to treat **7,3 million people on 1st line ART**
- **ITNs** –in 2022, PPM procured **119 million bed-nets**
- **Diagnostics** including **Rapid Diagnostic Tests** are a significant spend



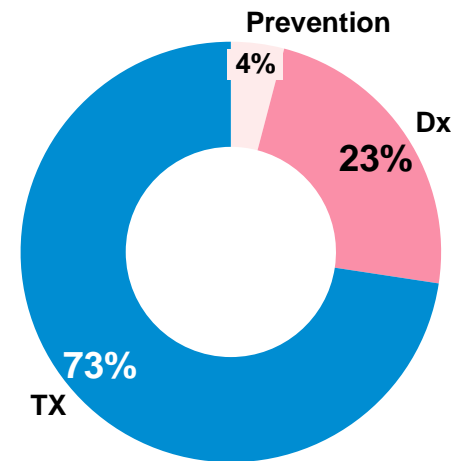
Volume split per Product Category

The Global Funds Request for Proposal (RFP) Key Stages



- **The Global Funds RFP is published every 3 years** but can be extended for a further 2 years if required



- The RFP follows **close consultation with partners and suppliers**



- **Notice is given on the Global Funds website** and the existing supplier base is notified directly in addition



- **Manufacturers are asked to submit offers** for a portfolio of products which are then evaluated by a panel from the Global Fund based on technical and commercial criteria



- Following the evaluation, **eligible suppliers are informed of the outcome and contracts are issued**
