Innovation and Collaboration

- PQ continues to facilitate equitable access to quality assured health products, it has also expanded scope and provided updated guidance
- New initiative to align WHO normative and prequalification is expected to facilitate timely access to innovations.
- Opportunity with the WLAS
- Leveraging other fora: actions from the WLPF
 - Tackle info gaps: Development of global/regional mapping
 - Collaborate with countries to create/strengthen
 - Conducive financial environment

New projects

- HP manufacturing support platform (with partners)
- Platform to map tech transfer & local capacitates
- Innovation in Partnerships for local African Vaccines manufacturing
- UNICEF TRVST System innovations to avoid falsified medicines







Innovation and Collaboration (II)

- Innovations being considered across tracks: e.g
 - The Female Condom generic specification recommended for adoption
 - Post Market Surveillance SOPs for PQ manufacturers in development.
 - Standardizing Technical support
 - Evolving technologies for non-systemic contraceptives and STI barrier prophylactics
 - Digitalization of supply chains
 - •
- New modalities for work: e.g. collaboration with external partners on supply management
- New initiatives such as the global platform for access to Childhood Cancer Medicines
