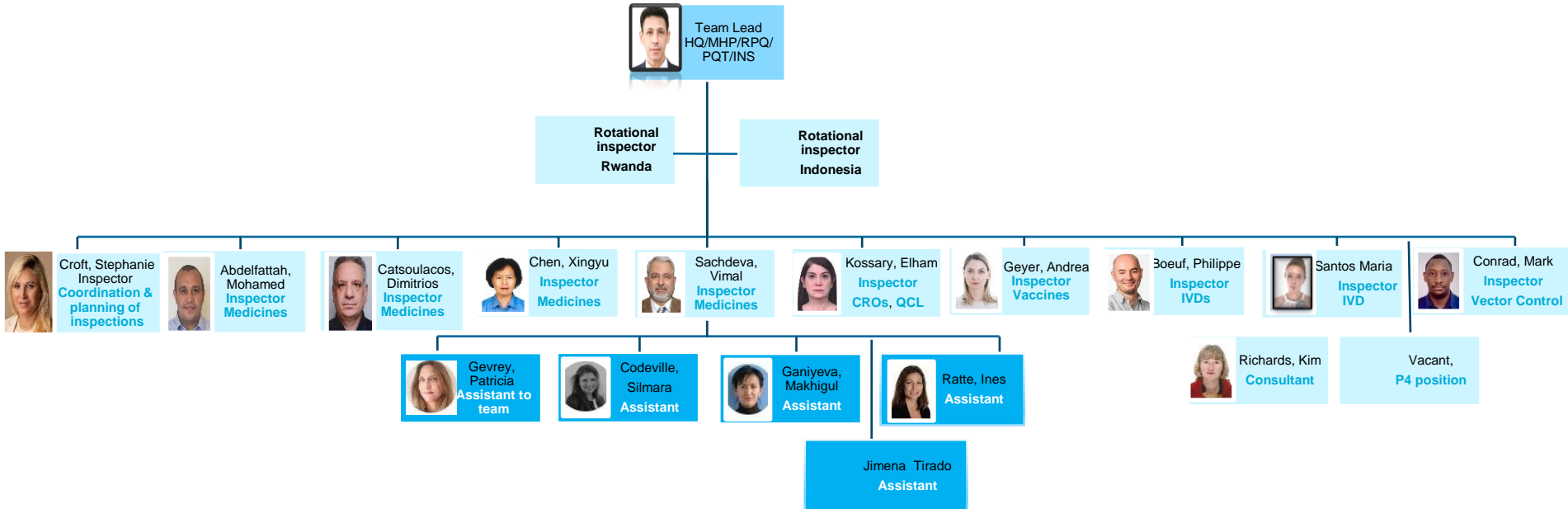

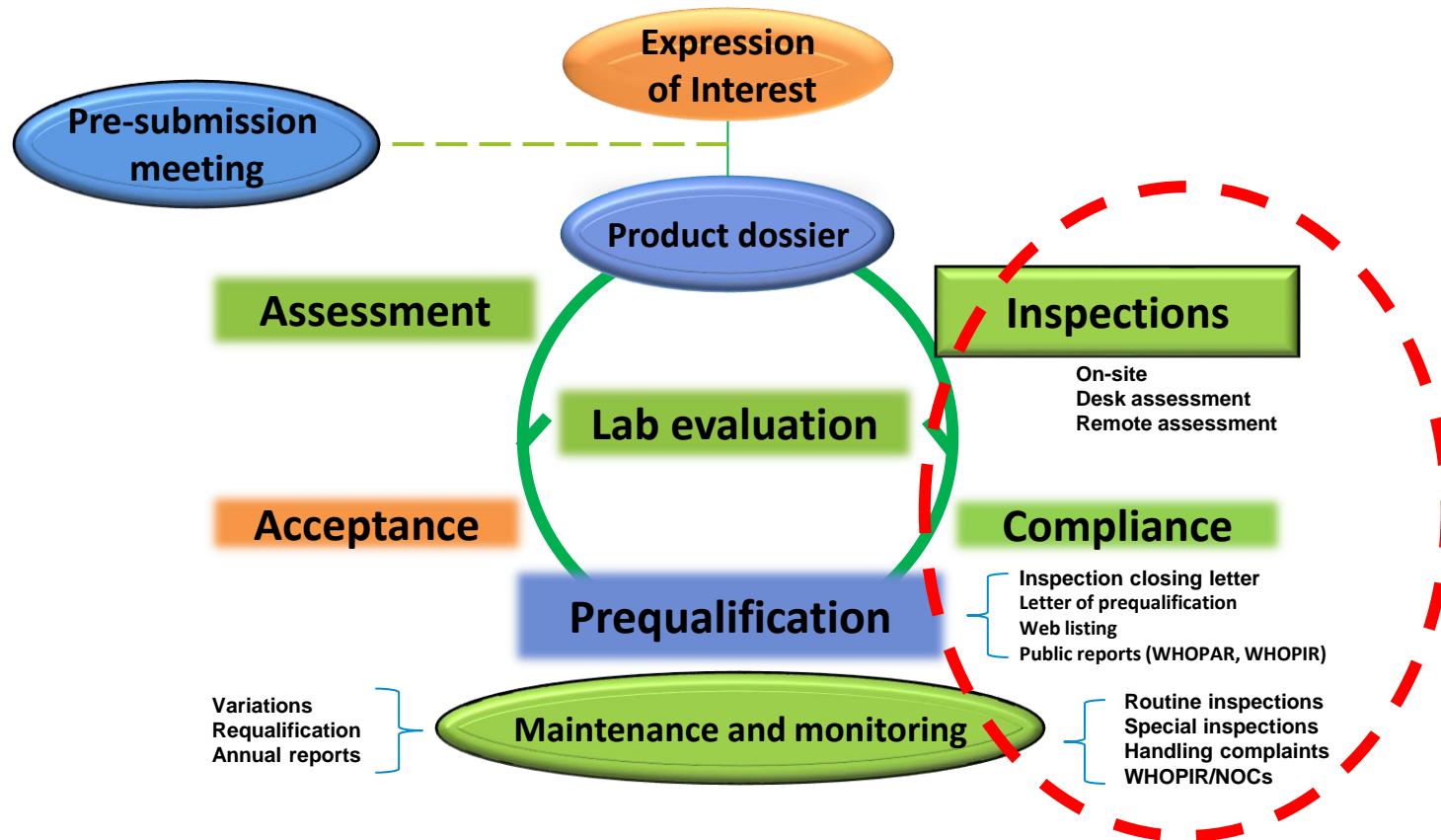

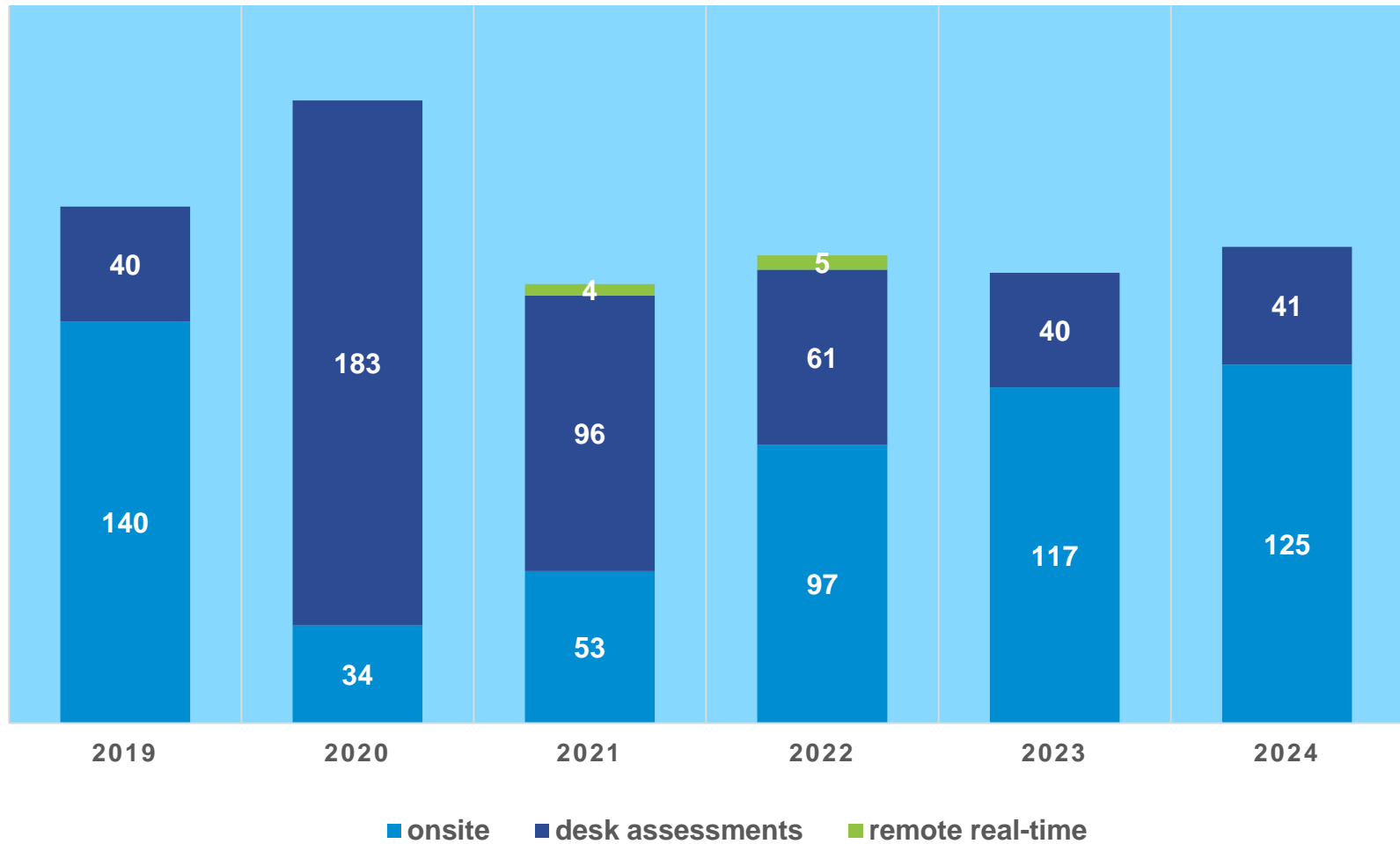

• Around 1'700 products are either prequalified or recommended for Emergency Use Listing (EUL)

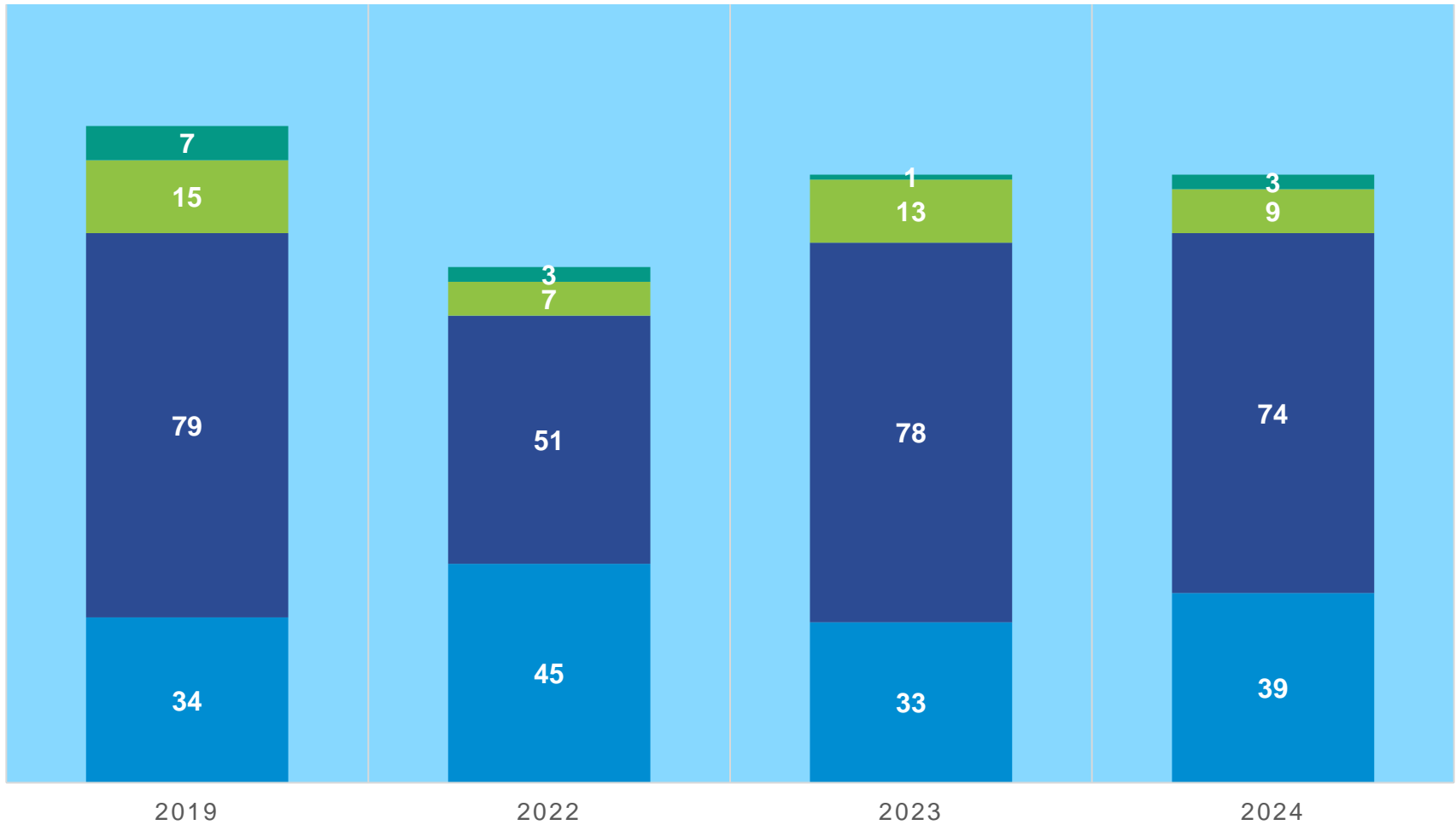

ONSITE INSPECTIONS VS DESK ASSESSMENTS

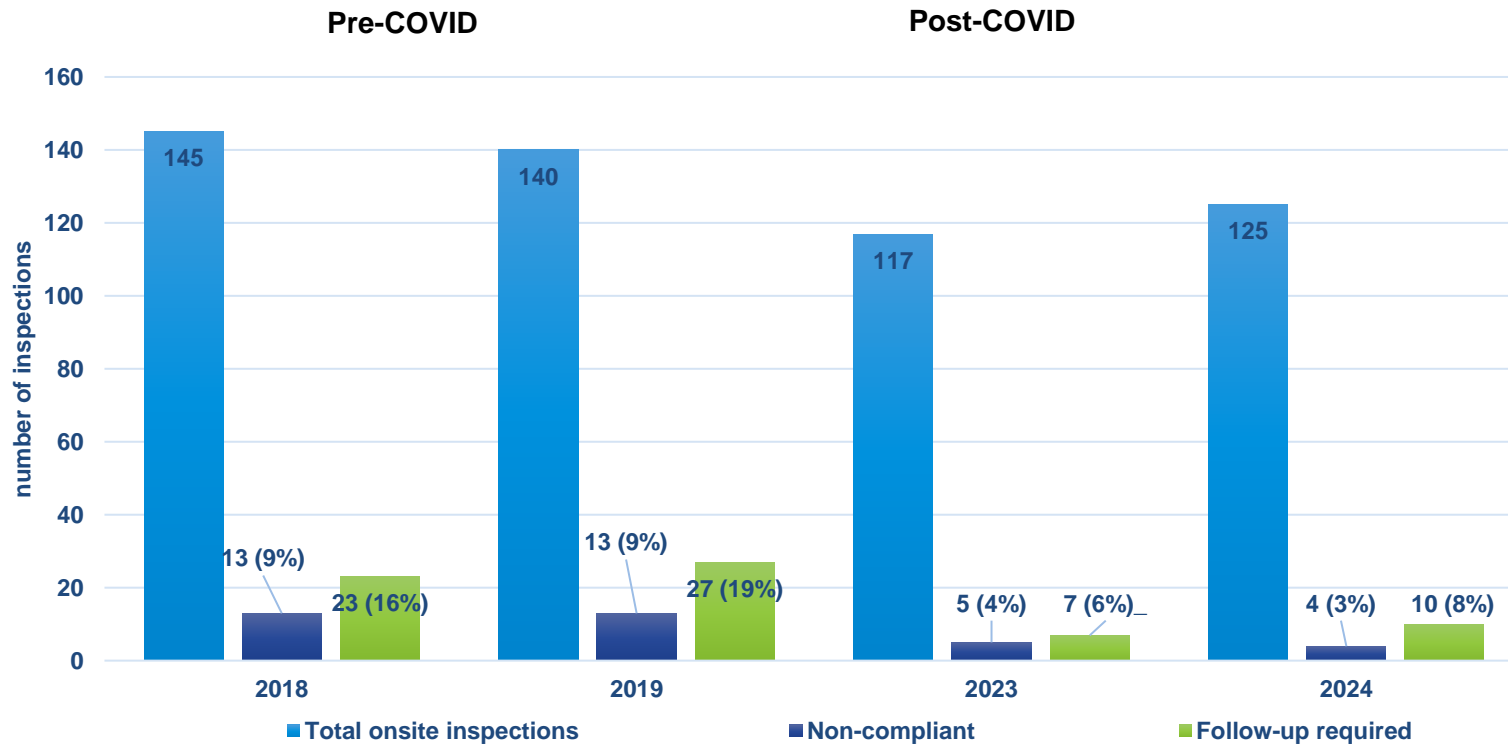


TYPE OF INSPECTIONS (ALL STREAMS)

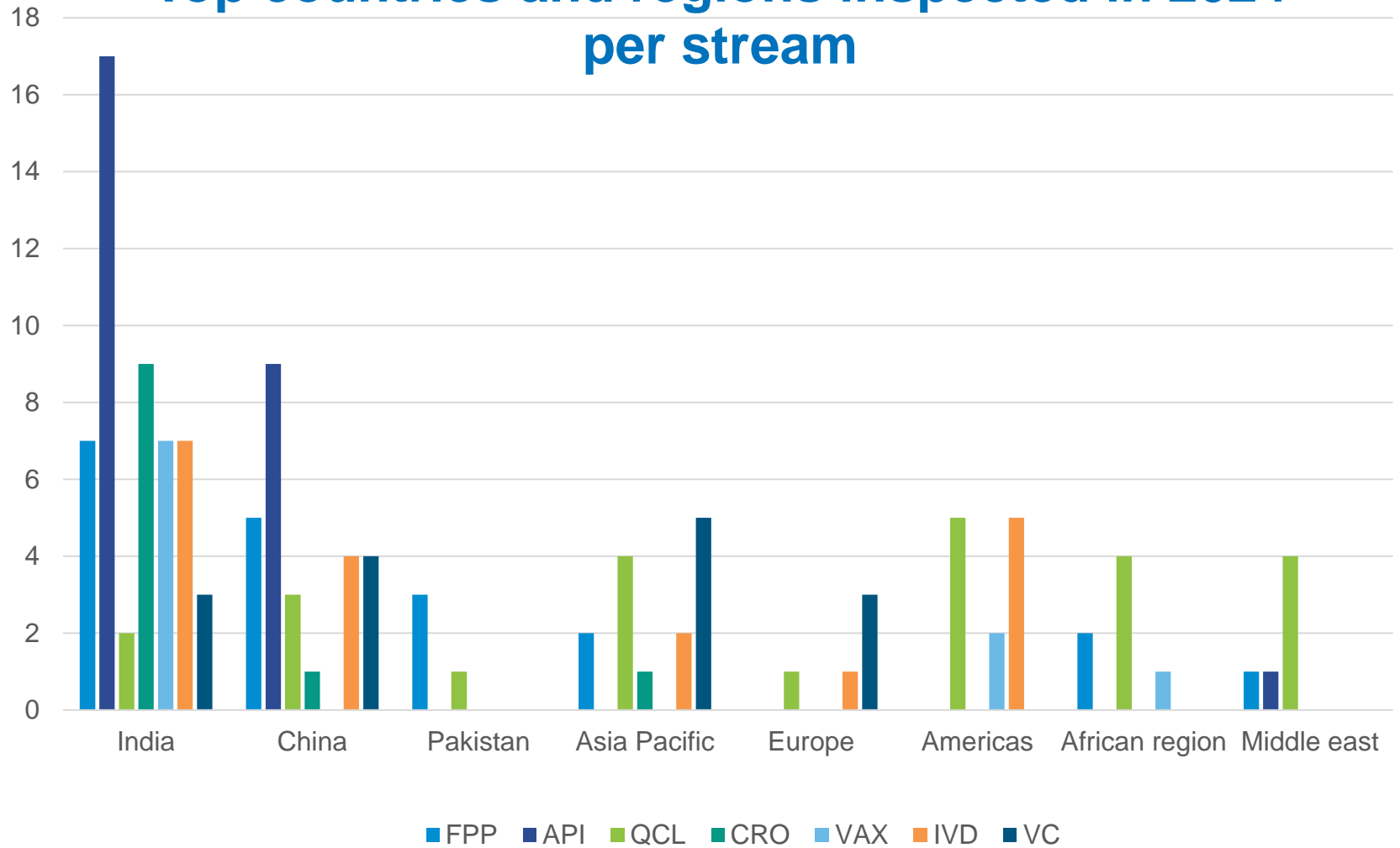
■ Initial ■ Routine ■ Follow-up ■ For Cause



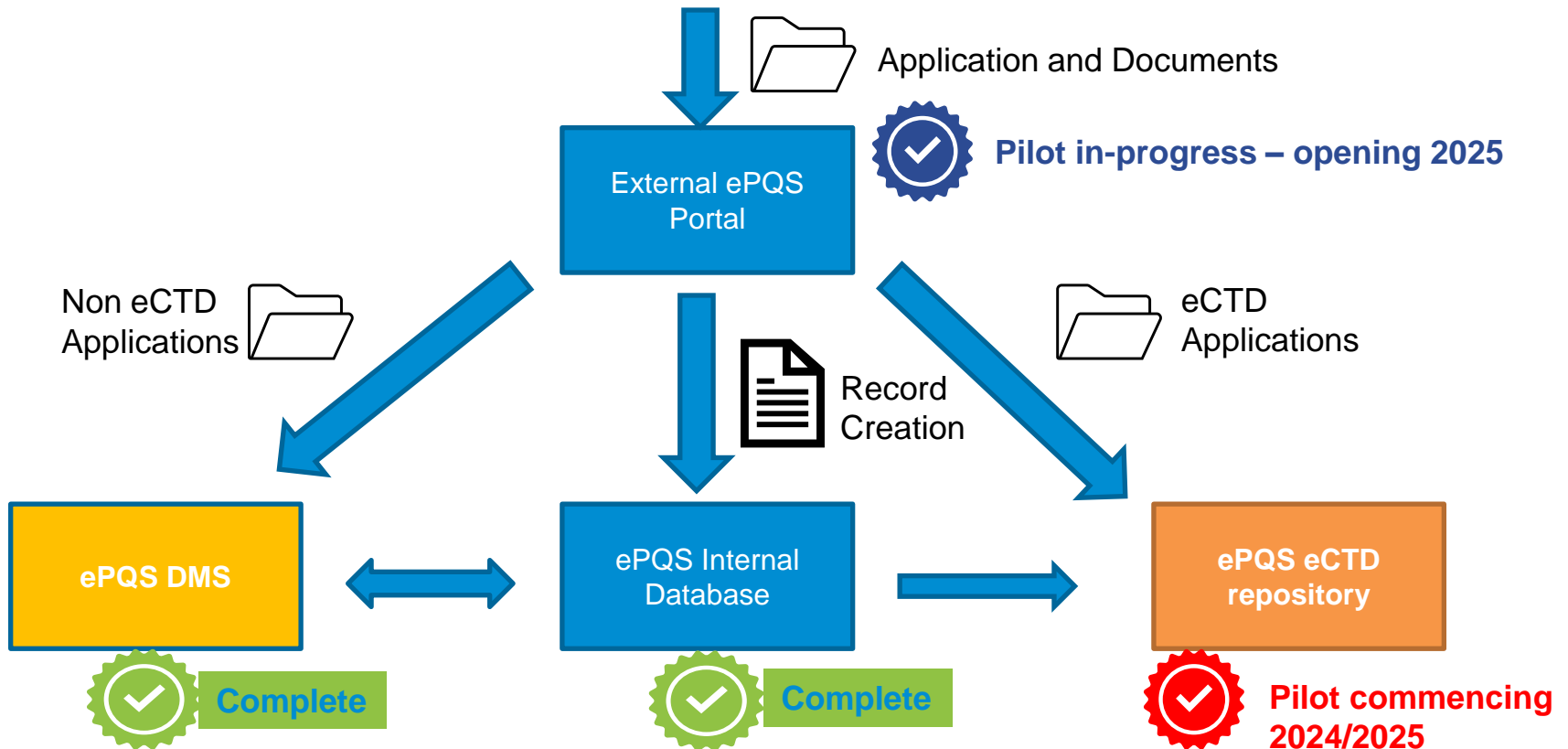
Inspection outcomes vs. Total onsite inspections (all streams)

ePQS Overview



- A secure platform for external users
- It uses WHO's Microsoft Azure Active Directory, which ensures only authorized users with the right username and password are granted access to the ePQS portal and all related systems
- Applicants, NRAs, External experts each have different visibility of records
- Permits filing of applications, responses and general tracking of applications
- Secure document transfer to and from WHO

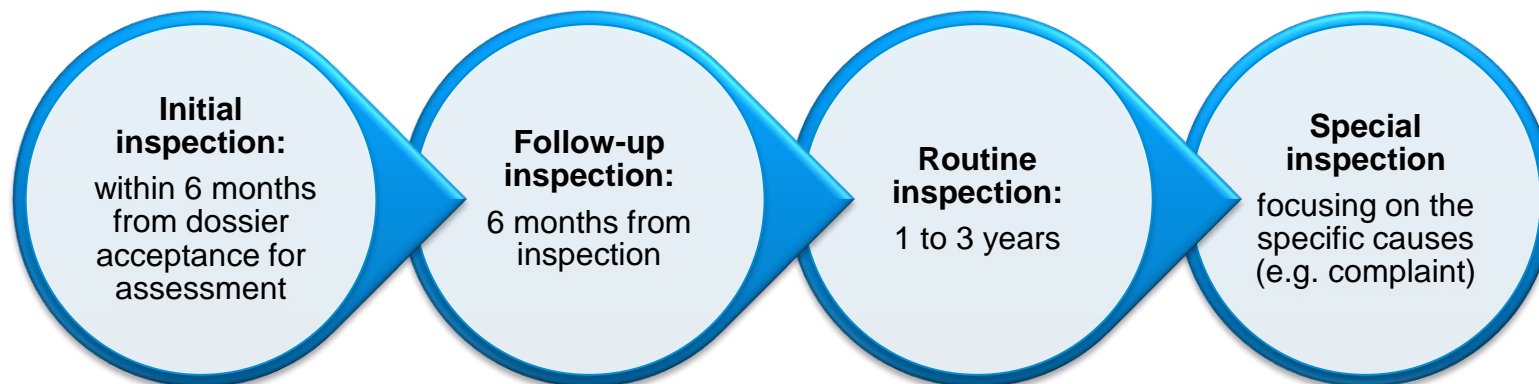
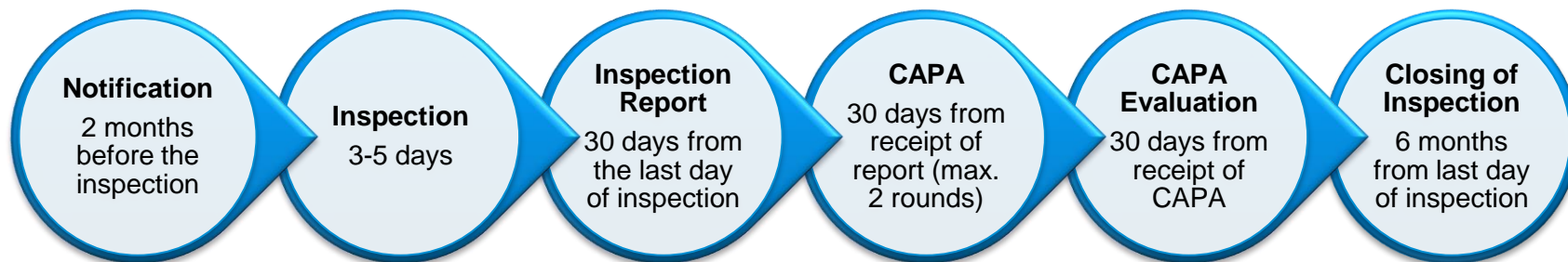

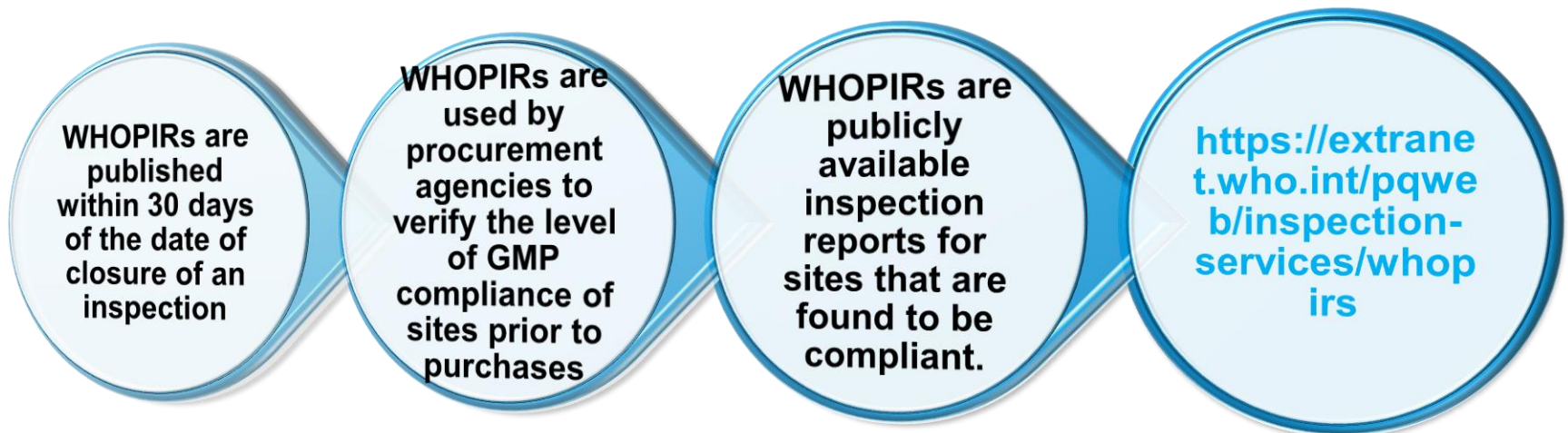
