The Reproductive Health Supplies Coalition

- RHSC is a global partnership of public, private, and nongovernmental organizations dedicated to ensuring that all people in LMICs can access and use affordable, highquality supplies to ensure their better reproductive health.
- RHSC's membership is made up of over 550 organizations, about 20% of which are private sector organizations, including manufacturers.
- RHSC has a Manufacturer Representative (MR) seat on our Executive Committee. This seat is filled for a 2-year term by a manufacturer member of the Coalition. Our current MR is Frank Strelow of Bayer AG.





Discussion paper

- On an ongoing basis, manufacturers discuss their priorities and concerns for doing business in LMICs within our forum.
- In 2023, RHSC also conducted 10 individual, confidential interviews with manufacturer members of our RHSC Manufacturers Group.
- We discussed more in-depth each manufacturer's concerns in conducting business in a healthy manner with global procurers and in serving markets in LMICs (along with other topics).
- Summarized their priorities and concerns, along with suggested next steps, in a discussion paper.
- Discussion paper was reviewed by the manufacturer members.



Discussion paper (Continued)

MAIN POINTS OF CONCERN



Costs for manufacturers have escalated very significantly, especially since the COVID-19 pandemic.



Global procurers understandably continue to add or change requirements for manufacturers, for reasons such as to increase efficiency and better satisfy the needs of individual countries.



Continual pressure to provide the lowest price possible for global procurers, due to budgetary considerations and financial limitations of recipient countries

POTENTIAL WAYS FORWARD

- ✓ New flexibility considerations
- More measured approach to new initiatives
- Greater discussion in neutral spaces while strengthening relationships
