I BACKGROUND INFORMATION ON THE PROCEDURE

1. Submission of the dossier

The company Ethypharm UK Ltd. submitted in 2025 an application for Caffeine Citrate 10mg per ml Oral Solution ¹ (AP001) to be assessed with the aim of including Caffeine Citrate in the list of prequalified medicinal products for prevention and treatment of apnoea in preterm infants.

Caffeine Citrate was assessed according to the 'Procedure for Assessing the Acceptability, in principle, of Pharmaceutical Products for purchase by United Nations Agencies' by the team of WHO assessors. The assessors are senior experts, mainly from National Authorities, invited by WHO to participate in the prequalification assessment process.

2. Steps taken in the evaluation of the product

October 2025	The quality data were reviewed by the assessment team and further information was requested.
November 2025	The company's response letter was received.
November 2025	The quality data were reviewed and found to comply with the relevant WHO requirements.
05 December 2025	Caffeine Citrate 10mg per ml Oral Solution was included in the list of prequalified medicinal products.
