

I BACKGROUND INFORMATION ON THE PROCEDURE

1. Submission of the dossier

The company McNeil Sweden AB submitted in 2024 an application for Nicorette Peppermint 4 mg medicated chewing gum ¹ (TD002) to be assessed with the aim of including Nicorette Peppermint 4 mg in the list of prequalified medicinal products for treatment of disorders caused by use of tobacco.

Nicorette Peppermint 4 mg was assessed according to the ‘Procedure for Assessing the Acceptability, in principle, of Pharmaceutical Products for purchase by United Nations Agencies’ by the team of WHO assessors. The assessors are senior experts, mainly from National Authorities, invited by WHO to participate in the prequalification assessment process.

2. Steps taken in the evaluation of the product

February 2024	The quality data were reviewed by the assessment team and further information was requested.
March 2024	The company’s response letter was received.
March 2024	The quality data were reviewed and found to comply with the relevant WHO requirements.
04 April 2024	Nicorette Peppermint 4 mg medicated chewing gum was included in the list of prequalified medicinal products.
