With support from WHO, Point of Entry (PoE) screening established at Addis Ababa Bole and Dire Dawa international airports, as well as Dewele train station (at ETHIO - DJIBOUTI border)

Ethiopian Airlines is flying to five cities in China (not Wuhan, the epicenter of the current outbreak) and operates about 35 flights per week

60 Rapid Response Teams (RRT) members trained to serve as first-line responders to any suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19
