

UHC Partnership Live Monitoring Platform - Instructions

The **UHC Partnership** supports WHO teams at country, regional and headquarters levels to provide coordinated, country-led support to Member States in strengthening health systems through a primary health care approach to advance universal health coverage and health security. In line with **GPW14**, this support contributes to WHO's mission to promote, provide and protect health by strengthening essential health system capacities, improving service coverage and financial protection, and building more equitable and resilient health systems.

The **Live Monitoring Platform** is a key accountability and learning tool for tracking the implementation of **UHC-P supported Country Support Plans**. It helps WHO teams capture progress, bottlenecks, technical support needs and results across the three levels of the Organization. It also feeds into adaptive planning, knowledge sharing, partner alignment and better visibility of WHO's contribution to country-level impact.

The following instructions guide WHO staff on how to access the platform and update country and regional information, including activities, progress updates, notes, support requests and documents.

Login with WIMS

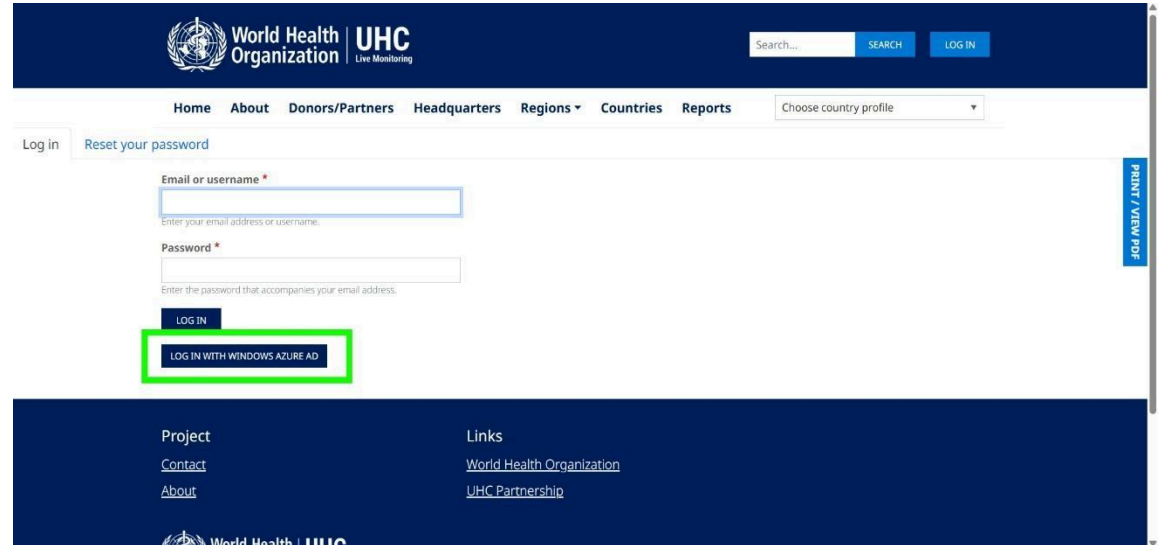
Step 1: Go to the UHC Partnership Live Monitoring Platform: <https://extranet.who.int/uhcpartnershiplivemonitoring>



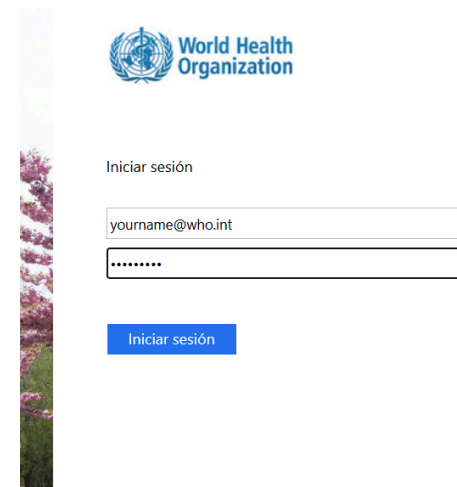
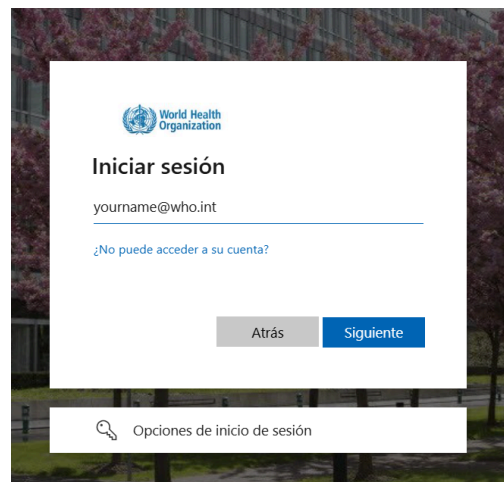
Step 2: Select Login in the upper right hand corner



Step 3: Choose Login with Windows Azure AD



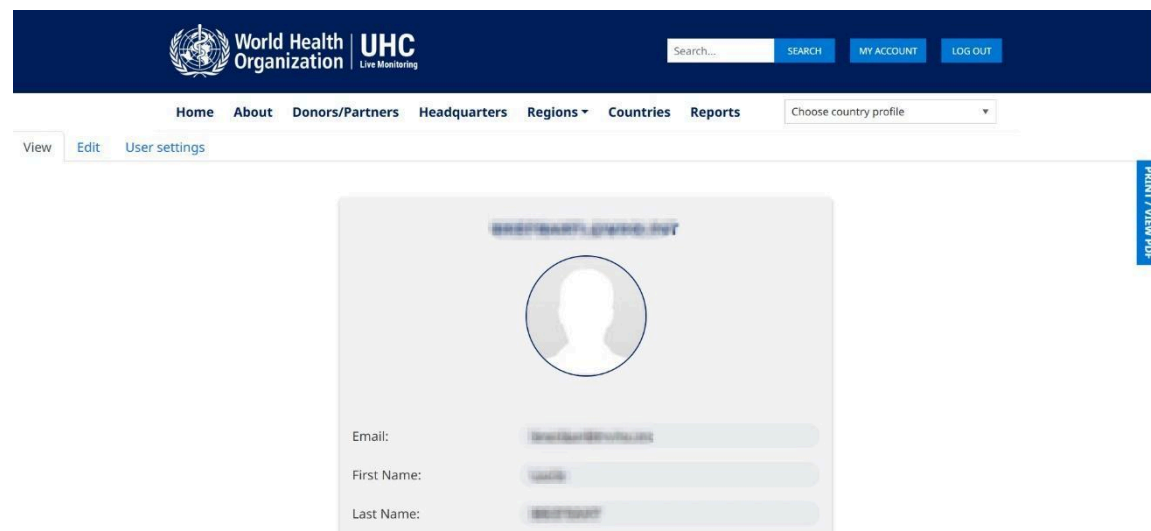
Step 4: Enter in your username and password for your WIMS account. This step will only be needed for the first time accessing the site.



Important: Please note that first time users will not have the access permissions to create/edit content on the site. As each user enters the site for the first time with their WIMS account, we will assign security permissions.

As you wait for your permissions to be approved, please start to update **your profile** and **user settings**.

Note: If you are waiting more than 24hours to receive security permissions or if you have a question, please contact shaha@who.int. Once you have access, you can enter the secure UHC Country Support area on the site to create/edit content as needed.

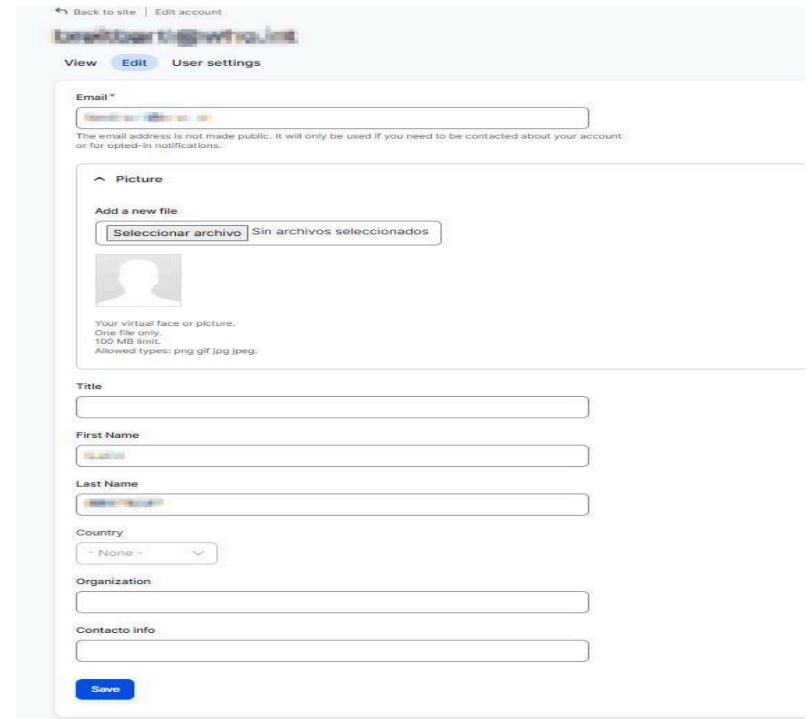
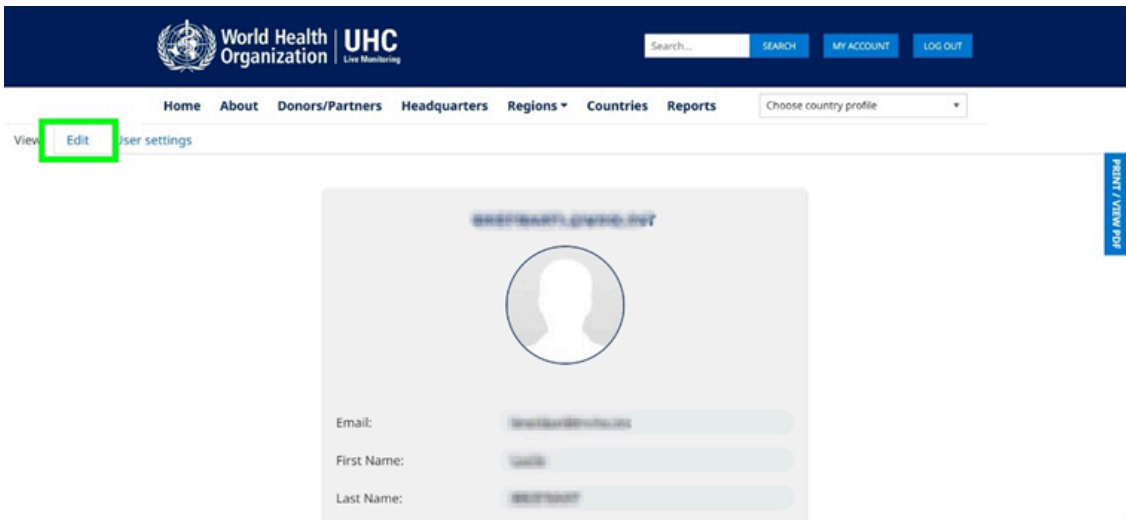
Step 1: Select **MyAccount** the top right corner of the site

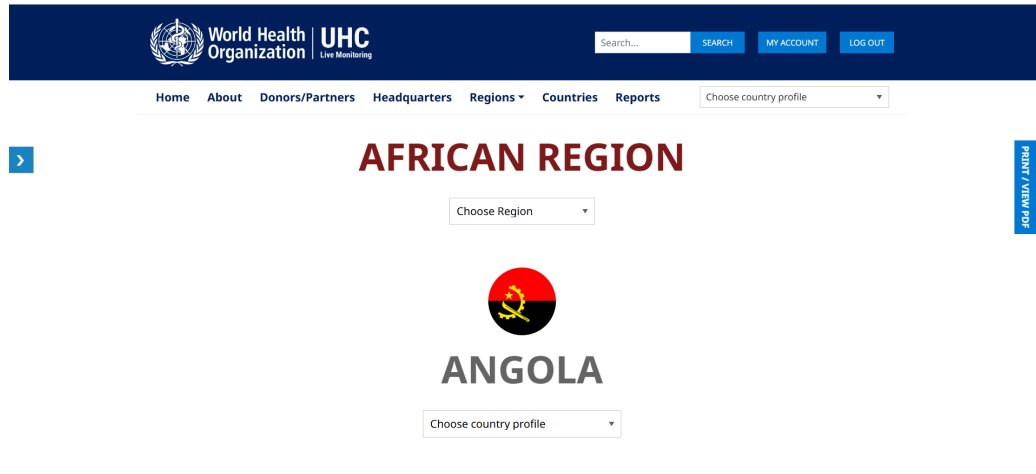

Step 2: Select the **Edit tab** and complete and save the online form.

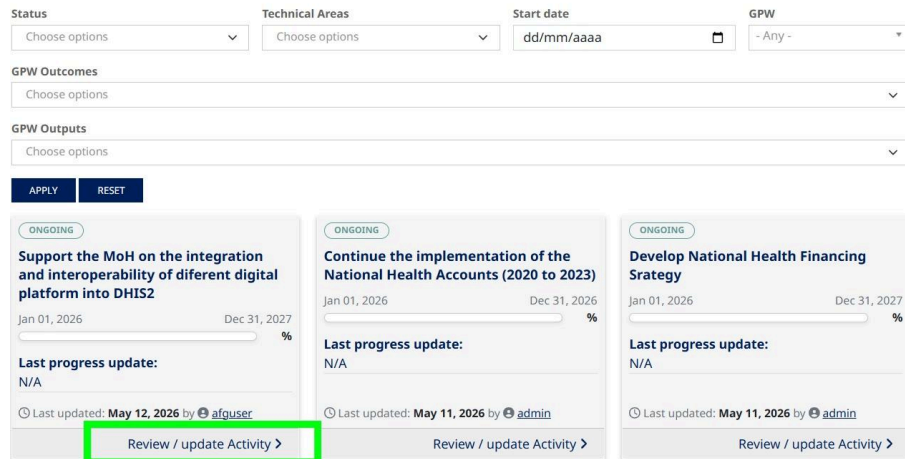

Adding/Uploading Documents

Each country has a file repository for **public** and **private** documents.

The **Public File Repository** for each country is a public collection of policy documents and can be viewed by the general public.

The **Private File Repository** is a collection of **private documents** that are produced with the support of the UHC Partnership and other related material. Private files **can only be seen by registered users**. You can add reports, assessments, agenda, communication materials, videos, photos etc. The repository supports all file types.

Step 1: Scroll down to the public files section and click on the title to display all the public files

Step 2: Select the **Add New** under the **Public files** section. Choose the file to upload and complete the online form to save the document to the repository.

Note: A publishing workflow will be activated and a screening process will occur before the document is posted onto the site.

Important: Please remember that all public files uploaded can be seen by the general public.

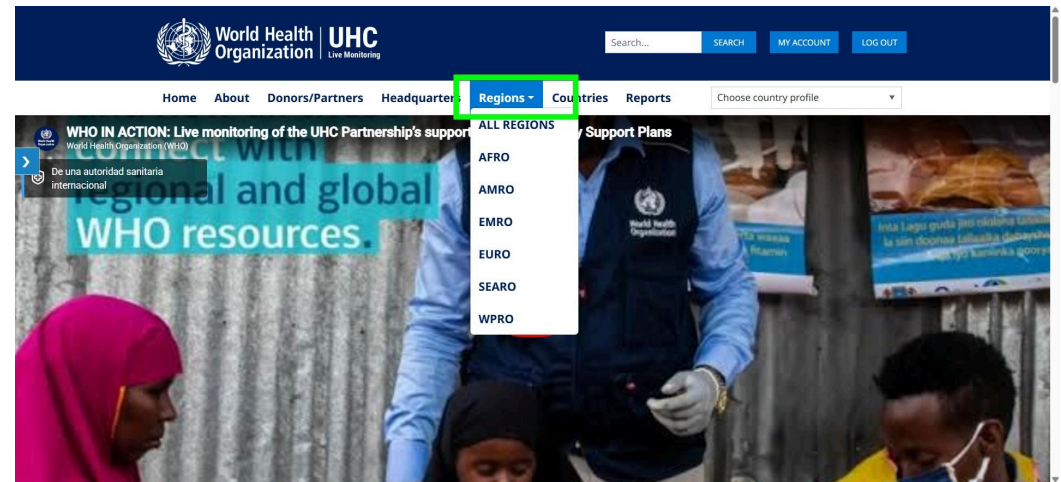

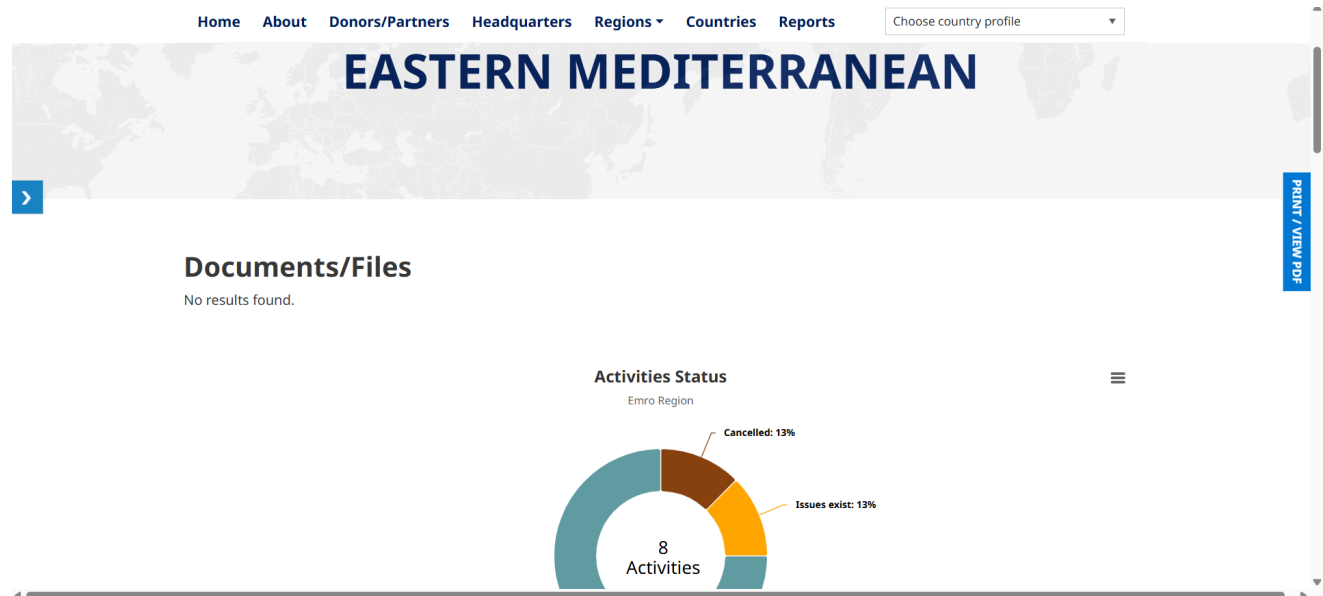
